## (From Al-Thawra Baghdad, 27, 3, 74)

News has reached us from Teheran that the Iranian authorities have been suppressing information concerning two attempts on the lives of the Shah and Qabus, Sultan of Oman, during his recent visit to the Iranian capital on the 3rd of March.

The report said that Iranian revolutionaries had placed a bomb with a timing device in the hall where Qabus was to be given the key to the town of Tirzz. However, the bomb exploded a few minutes before his arrival and the celebration was cancelled.

The Report added that Iranian revolutionaries prepared a number of ambushes, along the route to be used by the Shah and the Sultan. But Iranian security forces notices unusual movements in the road and changed the route for the procession. There followed a widespread search operation in the area.
