

# IN A GOLDEN FREE ZONE

The establishment of the U.A.E. in December 1971 was followed by rapid and COMPREHENSIVE PROGRESS. Significant accomplishments have been realised in building a modern society.

The U. A. E. has established an excellent relatioship based on constructive co-operation, mutual respect and reciprocity, with most countries of the world. Standards have been raised in all fields including the ECONOMIC, CULTURAL, HEALTH and SOCIAL sectors. Similarly, the Emirate of Fujairah has successfully undertaken various INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL AND TOURISM projects.



The United Arab Emirates is well served by its modern infrastructure, excellent road connection first class National and international communications, schools, hospitals, community facilities and reliable supplies of electricity. Fujairah Emirate is endowed with natural resources and primary materials which make the potential for investment full of promise.

THE GOVERNMENT OF FUJAIRÄH encourages economic development by providing the necessary channels for FINANCIAL FACILITIES. This helps the expansion and diversification of investment opportunities. There is a branch of the U.A.E. CENTRAL BANK, 12 Commercial BANKS, several finance companies and foreign exchange bureaus. These BANKS work closely with local and international banks inside and outside U.A. E.

The application of a sound monetary policy has enabled these banks to perform successfully, FREE FROM CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS, and under the guidance and directives of the U. A. E. Central Bank.

A federal public corporation, ETISALAT, provides a high standard of TELECOMMUNICATION services including, telephone, facsimile and telex. These services are truly effective and connect the U. A. E. with more than 154 countries. Telephone services within an Emirate are free of charge.

The Central Post Office provides an express service (Mumtaz Post) as well as regular Air Mail services for delivery of parcels and letters. International courier companies are active and competitive.

THE ESTABLISHMENT of the FUJAIRAH FREE ZONE AUTHORITY by the Government of Fujairah has eliminated the necessity of having local partners. Being a Government establishment, Fujairah Free Zone Authority can act as The nominal employer of staff whom companies wish to hire. This procedure helps to simplify the formalities involved in obtaining work permits for staff.













The U. A. E. Government has always adopted a policy of the free flow of capital and profits. The Fujairah Free Zone Authority continues this policy by providing the most commercialised trading atmosphere within its Zone. Firms within Fujairah Free Zone are exempted from paying import and export duties and corporation tax for a minimum of 15 years, and above all the firms and their employees are not subject to any INCOME TAX or local taxes.

BECAUSE OF THE IDEAL Strategical location of Fujairah, an investor in the Free Zone has access to a worldwide market of consumers, through reaching an intermodal transport system (Road-Sea-Air), Consumers from the Gulf, the Indian Subcontinent, North and East Africa as well as Europe and America.

FUJAIRAH FREE ZONE proudly provides international standard services through its modern infrastructure. The Port of Fujairah, one of the top two ports in the region, with its modern equipment can provide the most efficient services in all kinds of cargo handling such as, general cargo, bulk and container shipments.

The recently built FUJAIRAH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT with its MODERN airfreight and passengers handling capability provides excellent facilities for any investor within Fujairah Free Zone.

The newly built LABOUR CAMP, which is located next to Fujairath Free Zone and Fujairah Port, provides high standard labour accommodation. The accommodation can be divided to segregate labour by nationality, seniority, etc. Fujairah National Catering provides meals at the camp, offering a variety of loods to meet the needs of the multinational workforce in Fujairah.



# STARTING PROCEDURES

Investors wishing to establish projects in Fujairah Free Zone should follow the procedures set out below to obtain the necessary approval:

- Submission of a completed questionnaire available from the Fujairah Free Zone Authority, together with the legal status of the firm, an application for the utilities required (water and electricity), and planning documents.
- 2. After receiving the questionnaire and meeting its requirement, Fujairah Free Zone Authority will provide approval in principle, provided it meets its requirements.
- Once initial approval is granted, a Licence Application together with supporting documents and application for entry permits should be submitted.

Once these are approved, the Free Zone Authority will call the Company's representative to Fujairah to sign the lease agreement and to pay the agreed rent and licence costs. At this stage evidence of insurance as per the agreement should be provided for the Authorities inspection.

4. Companies must submit to the Authority a detailed building plan for the final approval before construction.



#### Free Zone Licences

Fujairah Free Zone Authority will issue accepted firms with an operational licence . Firms have the choice of either a "Special" or "General" licence

renewable annually as long as the lease agreement is in force. Firms may request the issuing of both licences to enable them to operate inside and outside the United Arab Emirates.



#### PORT OF FUJAIRAH

Situated on the United Arab Emirates East Coast, the Port of Fujairah is at the centre of a consumer market of over 1 billion. Within a few days sailing, goods from Fujairah can be distributed to Arabian Gulf, Red Sea, East Africa and Indian Sub-Continent ports.

The port facility itself is multipurpose, with emphasis on Container Handling. The 780 Mtr. deep. water quay (12.5 metres) is equipped with 3 shipto-shore Gantry Cranes, one of which is the only post-Panamax specification crane in the Middle East. The Container Storage Yard has recently been expanded, and can now stack in excess of 12,500 TEUS. The yard is serviced by 5 RTG cranes with a further 2 RTG'S being ordered.

Besides container traffic, the port regularly handles Bulk Aggregates, Car Carriers, Livestock ships and other General Cargoes.




#### FUJAIRAH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

#### LAND OF THE EMIRATES







The United Arab Emirates is A federation of seven Emirates, or shelikhdoms, that extends from the base of the Qafar Peninsula across the Arabian Peninsula to the Gulf of Oman.

It is a land of palm trees, cloudless blue skies, pearlwhite beaches and turquoise ocean vistas that attracts large numbers of visitars every year.

Various every year, one of the most scenic of the Emirates, is on the North-East coast facing the Indian Ocean and offers a varied landscape of beaches, plains, lush agricultural oasis and majestic coastal and inland mountains.

The other Emirates are Abu Dhabi (the capital), Dubai (the busiest commercial centre), Sharjah, Ajman, Ras al Khaimah & Umm al Qalwain.

The total U.A.E. population is around 1.7 million with a large community of expatriates, mainly of Indians, Pakistanis, Northern Arabs and Europeans.

The official language is Arabic although English. Farsi and Urdu are also widespread.

The climate is pleasant throughout most of the winter temperatures ranging from 15 C to 25 C but July and Augest temperatures can reach 40 C and humidity is relatively high all year round.

Most shops, offices and residences are air - conditioned.

The country's economy, which improved considerably during the Seventies, depends on oil revenues. The economic progress has been reflected in the development of various infrastructure projects throughout the Emirates including social services, education and industry.

The state has witnessed major developments since it was founded in 1971 under the leadership H. H. Shalkh Zayed Bin Sultan Al-Nahyan, the president of the U.A.E. . These developments cover essential services and utilities, including vouth care and social welfare.

The United Arab Emirates is situated in a strategic location and has gained great intermitional prominence in such areas as trade, banking and investment, as well as other vital fields which contribute to development projects in each fimitate.

The State has enjoyed rapid progress in the agricultural sector, encouraging the expansion of fertile lands especially in places watered from the mountains such as Fulgirah.

Other important activities include fisheries and cultivation of date palms and other traditional crops in nonoil-producing Emirates.

The state provides every possible facility to promote culture and sports among young people in acknowledgment of their role in the development of the State In the future.

Fujairah's main products are aggregate, marble, ceramics, rockwool, cement, mineral water, fish and agricultural products ranging from fresh chicken to fruit, vegetables and flowers. The business week is from Saturday to Thursday

with Friday off and the port closes for the major Muslim holidays, Id-al-Fitr and Id-al-Adha. The Islamic holy month of Ramadan is ob-

served throughout the U.A.E. every year, Islam being the principal religion of the area.

The monetary unit is the dirham. One dirham equals one hundred fils and one SUS dallar equals 3.67 dirhams .

Nates are issued in denominations of 5, 10, 50, 100, 200 and 500 and coins are issued in denominations of 1 fils, 25 fils, 50 fils, 1 dirham and 5 dirhams.

There are no restrictions on the import or export of currency and international credit cards like American Express and Diner's Club are accepted in most of the major hotels, restaurants and shoos.

Fujairah is connected to the rest of the Emirates by a well - developed network of roads and highways and there are several car hire companies to choose from.
