Iranian Forces On New Offensive Against Liberated Areas

Reports reaching Saut Al-Thawra from liberated area state that invading Iranian forces are making wide scale feverish moves which cover:

1) Reinforcement of the centres at the Red Line and consolidation of these centres with

equipment and men;

-2) Latest Phantom planes arrived at Thumret air base which was established recently by these forces.

3) Reinforcement of their naval base at Khasb in Roos al-Jibal area.

4) The Iranian army command and in Dhofar prevented members of the other forces taking part in the war against our people from entering the centres of their forces. This prohibition, also, extended to some senior officials in the Qaboos Sultanate.

EDITORIAL

Admiral William Littlemore, Commander of the American Navy, paid several visits to Teheran, Riyadh and Bahrain during the past weeks. He announced in Saudi Arabia that the United States is taking care of building up the Saudi Navy.

Such visits come at a time in which the United States is launching a heavy propaganda campaign against the alleged military bases of the Soviet Union in this area, the propaganda wanted to justify and camouflage the aggressive acts carried out by the United States and its bids to establish more military bases in the waters of the Indian Ocean and to reinforce and strengthen its military bases in Iraq, Bahrain and Saudi Arabia.

The statements made by William Littlemore in connection with America's intention to build up the Saudi naval force mean that an American naval base, which might not be 100% in form but might be in kind, will be established to serve the same aims served by the American naval base at al-Jufair in Bahrain which the officials in Bahrain claimed last year to have asked for its clearance. Moreover, it is certain that the United States will not endeavour to knock down Israel but is endeavouring for the opposite of this. Therefore, the establishment of a Saudi Naval force means strengthening of the naval military power of imperialism.

Such visits by the American Naval Commander and his intention to the attention paid

by the USA for building up the naval power of Saudi reaction also came at a time in which Saudi Arabia is making extensive moves for performing the filthy role undertaken by Iranian reaction in our country, the role which finds every backing and support from the Arab reactionary countries. Furthermore, it appears that the statements made by this American official came as an indication for American approval of the ambitions of Saudi reaction as America wants to give the chance for this reactionary force to play a certain role in the American strategy and to make this force establish its roots and ability. As such there is no objection from the Persian Emperor to abdicate to Saudi reaction even part of the dirty role being carried out by him at present in our country and in the area of the Gulf.

Emanating from this we are observing a stand of alertness and preparedness to frustrate such new conspiracies woven by American imperialism and its reactionary allies against our people and their revolution and against the forces of progress in this area. Accordingly, we are placing this picture in front of the Arab democrats and patriots and all forces of progress and peace in the world for undertaking their role in confronting the conspiracies of American imperialism and its reactionary allies and to stand by the side of our Omani people, who are the target of these conspiracies in the first place.

4) At a time in which these Iranian forces are undertaking this series of feverish military preparations, the British Royal Air force and the Iranian aircraft are launching heavy air raids against the masses of the people in the liberated areas aiming at destructing the houses of the citizens and their livestock and farms and destruction of all their properties in a bid to demolish the morale of the masses.

One of the comrades in the People's Liberation Army commented on these moves by saying:-

"Such moves come during the course of the rainy season in which usually the military activity of the enemy is frozen. Therefore, it is possible to describe these moves as an operation to restore life to the forces of the enemy."

"These moves indicate to the launching of wide-scale military operations on the liberated areas. In other words, the enemy forces will launch new military campaign aiming at compensating the outcome of the first campaign which took place at the start of the invasion. Perhaps the most significant signs of these moves are the exaggerating statements made by some officials of the traitorous regime in Muscat, which say:

"The revolution will not be existing by the end of Ramadan."

This campaign will be a move for restoring respect to the invading Iranian forces whose reputation was dumped by the

Military Report

PLA Directs Striking Blows At Enemy Forces

Within the period from 13th September to 28th September, the fighting concentrated in the Western Region and to a lesser extent in Al-Mamar.

WESTERN REGION:

The People's Liberation Army accelerated its attacks against the enemy forces where it launched 8 Gun and mortar attacks and two sniping operations.

The PLA inflicted heavy losses among enemy ranks. After several attacks, the enemy has been seen clearing his casualties with helicopters and deserting towards its fortifications. The total enemy losses are the following:-

1. Destruction of 64 fortifications.
2. Ten casualties within two operations in addition to unestimated casualties within eight operations.
3. Destruction of a heavy machine-gun with crew.
4. Destruction of Land Rover jeep.
5. Destruction of a machine-gun post.

The enemy retaliated with barbaric raids against the civilian targets (civilian cottages, water resources and caravans) with the aim of exterminating the population of the Liberated Zone. These raids amounted to 13 air raids where several civil-

Commando Organisation of Iranian People Declares Solidarity With Oman Revolution

The statement added: "Therefore, our Arab youth union must direct its utmost attention for increasing the energies of the youth and for creating the atmosphere in which their legitimate ambitions are flourished and protected against the danger of the calls made by coloni-

PFLO Warns Against 'The Double Game' Played By Saudi Reaction

Reports confirmed that the Saudi regime notified some of the rulers of the Gulf countries and some other Arab rules about its anxiety over the increase of the Iranian military and political influence in Oman and that such anxiety is springing from the fact that this Iranian influence is posing threats to Saudi influence in the area.

As a matter of fact, the Saudi Arabia meets with Iran on the necessity of crushing the progressive regime in Democratic Yemen and knocking down the Omani liberation rifles as the Saudi regime does not see utter danger in the Iranian expansion and influence inasmuch as it sees danger in the Omani revolution and the progressive regime in Democratic Yemen. However it does not agree with Iran that it should represent the American tool implementing its liquidatory plan, still it is for the reality that Iran is to play an American-Arab tool especially that there are many reactionary regimes which remarkably proved to be disturbed by the growing revolution tides in this area and that they want to get rid of such situation.

Further, the Saudis do not want the Jordanian regime to be one of the parties playing the role of American-Arab tool because they are very disappointed by the close cooperation between puppet Hussein and the Shah of Iran.

The recent Saudi contacts and the partial settlement of its problems with some regimes in the Gulf are all steps on the road of erecting a reactionary Arab front for undertaking the task of liquidation and, in other

words, drawing the justifications form the Iranian reaction putting them as a cause for keeping 'toughening and increasing its military presence in this area. The Saudi regime is keeping, 'toughening and increasing its projects with the aim of proving its ability to American imperialism and its respect by the rulers of the Gulf as such respect was weakened following the Iranian interference and occupation of Oman.

In such a way the Arab reactionaries understand the

matter of safeguarding the Arab rights and the Arab national interests.

Certainly, such unity will pour its efforts at the end beside those made by the Shah-in-Shah regime because they meet with him in aim and principle. Therefore, there is no justification for a clash between them as all treasures will be divided later.

It remains for the Arab patriotic and progressive forces and regimes to give serious consideration to such suspicious move-

ments because they are an object of these moves, too.

Therefore, it is the duty of these forces and regimes to unite in one national and progressive front from Palestine to Oman and Morocco in order to check off this utter danger threatening our nation and to frustrate the schemes of the plotting reactionaries and their imperialist masters. She was threatened by the Savac agents of being harmed if she does not cooperate with them. This is a specimen of the activities of the Iranian diplomats who are in fact officers in the Savac intelligence.

Jordanian Regime Caught Red-Handed In Collaborating With Apartheid Rules

The British Foreign Office confirmed reports on the sale by the Hashemite regime of British weapons to the racial regime in South Africa. A spokesman for the British Foreign Office said that some of the equipment owned by Jordan previously are now existing with South Africa. He said that these weapons include a missile network of the Tiger-Cat type fired from the ground to the air, and about forty one Centurion tanks. This was revealed by investigations carried out by the British Government.

The Jordanian government claimed that it did not sell any British-made weapons to South Africa.

This crime which was committed by the Jordanian regime caused indignation and disappointment within the circles of the African peoples and countries. The Secretariat of the Organisation of African Unity sent a message to the Arab League expressing indignation and described this step as a blow directed against Arab-African cooperation and solidarity.

We have not been surprised by such a stand and such behaviour by the Hashemite regime as this regime did not hesitate to commit the ugliest pictures of plotting and crime against the Jordanian people and the Palestinian people and against our Omani people and other peoples of the Arab nation and their national and progressive regimes. This regime is not expected to be eager about the issues of world peoples friendly to the Arab Nation. Therefore, we ask the Arab League, still has honourable stands towards the issues of African struggle, to adopt a firm stand towards this puppet regime which went too far in its hiring acts. The Arab League is required to adopt firm stands towards puppet regimes which cooperate with the regimes and countries hostile to the Arab nation and to the nations friendly to the Arab nation. The traitors, executionists and plotters must not be allowed to have a place in the galleries of the League which was originally created to be a rostrum for justice and progress and a symbol for Arab freedom and dignity.

Possible Ministerial Changes In Qaboos Cabinet

Reports coming from Muscat said that the British and Iranian has reached a conviction that it is necessary to undertake some changes in the positions of the Qaboos government and that such changes will take into consideration the introduction of new elements holding Ministerial positions for first time and known for their allegiance to the British and Iranians so that they, as well, reach a kind of balance — at least — between the conflicting wings in the traitorous rule of Qaboos.

However, well-informed sources in Muscat confirmed that the Omani Ministers in the Qaboos government are very disappointed by the excessive acts undertaken by the so-called Maqbool Hamid, Under-secretary of the Ministry of the Sultan's Hall, violating by that

and knocking against the wall the jurisdictions of those Ministers.

One of the Ministers says to one of his close relatives: "We became like toys without movement except if moved by anyone as everything is taking place without our knowledge and we have only to implement it." He added, "We know that Mr. London is the one who moves, stops, orders and ends everything and that Maqbool Hamid and others are only trumpets and sincere servants implementing the orders of their masters. He further shrieked: "We come to our Ministries to find written decisions and we are asked to implement them. But for what an how is this taking place is not our concern. We are told that they are supreme orders and we have only to implement them."

Natural Wealths Of Oman Scattered To The Winds

The puppet authority in Muscat gave the concession for the extraction of minerals in the Omani territories to two alien monopolies; the Brosuit Ltd. of Canada and the American Marshall Company.

It has been announced recently about the discovery of copper, tin, chrome, iron and lead in commercial quantities and in very superior quality in the area of Raseel. Other expensive minerals such as gold, silver and diamonds were also discovered in al-Arjiah area.

The said companies carried out explorations in eight places and found that the rate of new copper amounts to 3.45% while the thickness of layer of copper amounts to fifty metres and is very close to the level of earth that in some cases this does not exceed ten metres. To appreciate the value of these places we would like to say that the United States as the biggest producer of copper is having the rate of raw copper varying between 0.55% and 0.6%.

The company also announced that it discovered gold in Places turning out 0.16% - an ounce per ton - and silver at the rate of 0.18%; an ounce per ton.

This was announced by the concerned imperialist monopolists. Undoubtedly, such discoveries are having serious results to our country and people. If these imperialists remained upto now sticking to our country in view of their dream over the existence of a vast mineral wealth in it, such dreams became a visible and remarkable reality. This means that our people have to give the plentifulness of their land along with their sweat and the lives of their sons as cost not for their freedom but for their enslavement and subjugation.

The tragedy of our people is interpreted by one of the citizens in a message to Saut al-Thawra in which he said: "Whenever the wealths of our country increase, along with its exist our misery steps up together with poverty and deprivation."

At a time in which these monopolistic companies announced these discoveries, the Qaboos hiring regime was planning the way for disposing the huge amounts that might be turned up by these new wealths. The puppet found his prey when the British Aircraft Corporation announced that it concluded a deal with the Qaboos regime valued at about ninety million sterling for supplying him with a rocket network of the Rapier type and the Anglo-French Jaguar aircraft. Moreover, the British Cementation International Company also

announced that Qaboos authorised it to build a guest palace costing five million sterling. The same company had obtained a contract for building a town for senior employees at Wadi Roy and for building a huge hotel. The cost of that project amounts to 25 million sterling. By this last deal, the company would have obtained a total of thirty million sterling.

It appears that the French companies also started to get their share from the cows milk. The French Company "Domiz Trainkens France" obtained a

contract worths thirty million Saudi riyals for opening a road between Bud - where the main military centres of the mercenary forces, and some times said to be of the Iranian forces; and Sur town, the town in which the first thing that draws the attention of the visitor is that slogan printed on the walls of its buildings and public houses saying: "Hungry people and corrupt government".

In the face of such lavish spending of the funds of our people and the wealths of our homeland, we find the masses

of our people shout and scream demanding for realisation of the simplest essential requirements and asking for protection against the greed of the merchants who are at the same time officials in the State. They ask for provision of water, for instance, which is very vital for life. The masses want to see electricity and to get rid of the nightmare of breakdown of light and want medicines for getting rid of diseases and epidemics etc. Will this cow remain to give milk until its bossom is hurt?

ARAB STUDENTS WRITE TO ARAB LEAGUE COMMISSION

The League of Arab Students in West Berlin sent a message to the Secretary General of the Arab League and head of the League's fact-finding commission on Oman in which it affirmed its stand by the side of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman in its demands and insistence to sit with the commission in the liberated territories. The message says:

"We see that acquaintance with the identity of the national liberation movement in Oman cannot be achieved except by visiting the sites of its presence and especially to help the commission get acquainted with the criminal activities carried out daily by the foreign forces brought with consent and approval of Qaboos topped by the British and Iranian forces in a bid to hit and liquidate the revolution of the Omani people under the leadership of the People's Front. The League of Arab Students regard the behaviour of the commission as mishandling of the right of the Omani people to determine their future since the authority which depends on the help of foreign forces against its people is not liable for representing this people. Moreover, such attitude by the commission gave the rulers of Oman a chance for

exploiting the Arab League in order to strengthen their weak and shaky positions.

The League of Arab Students concluded its message by asking the fact-finding commission to visit the liberated area before issuing any report on its assignment.

The congress of the Federation of Ethiopia Students started its meetings in West Berlin on 2nd September. The People's Front for the Liberation of Oman sent the following message to the congress:-

"We wish congress which comes as part of the struggle of the Ethiopian people for self-determination and democracy every success."

In Ethiopia, the escalating contradiction between the Ethiopian masses, on one side, and the regime of Emperor Haile Selassie developed and started to take new more severe form. The Agence France Presse reported last weeks that the army is the actual power in Ethiopia at present permitted the way for roddy demonstrations staged by the Ethiopian masses in the streets of the Capital, Addis Ababa, against the Emperor. During these demonstrations, the masses were chanting slogans hostile to the Emperor and demanding his hanging.
