London, August 23-Am greement w s signed valued at one hundred million sterling under which Iran will get modern British . . equipment and weapons including scorpion tank, troops carriers, Rappier ground took rechtet reconce-

The agreement was signed during the recent visit made by the Shah of Iran to London two months ago. The Builty Heil newspeper of Britin published a report by its militery editor today in which he said that the military weapons and equipment which will be obtained by Ir m in coordance with this greenest will include hundreds of tanks, recommaissance ircr ft, military coast guards, patrol boats and anti-circraft rockets of the Rapier type.

The Egyption MiddleEast news agency, which published the report, said that

Iran received before such rockets to the value of fifty million dellars.

It also received under separate agreement bout 200 tanks of the Chieftain type. The new agreement also provides that Iron is to get all its needs of necessary space for its armed forces and organisation by British experts of a training programme on the new weapons for the soldiers and officers of the Iranian forces.

IRANIAN STAND RENDERS TO FAILURE ATTITUDE OF OPEC COUNTRIES

BETRUT: Talks continue since Saturday 18.8. between the delegation of oil-producing countries in the Gulf headed by Ahmed Zaki al-Yamani, Saudi Oil Minister, and representatives of Western oil companies operating in the Arabian Gulf headed by Arthur Parker without reaching a solution on denands by the Gulf countries to contribute in the capital of the companies at the rate of twenty per cent. The talks were hanged on 23.8 and differences are taking place on two points:-

- 1) Differences ensue on compensation. At a time in which the oil countries want payment of compensation on the basis of the nominal value of properties, the companies want to pay compensation at the future value of the properties in addition to other compensations resulting from decrease, in the companies income.
  - The companies want to market not less than sixteen per cent of the share of government of oil while the governments do not want to stick to such commitment.

It is known that since the holding of the Jeddah conference at the end of last year the negotiations started dragging. The oil states, after giving their ambiticus calls, began to appear in their real size. At a time in which some of their officials announced that their demands for contribution will not be less than fifty per cent, they now accept twenty per cent under the conditions of the monopolistic companies.

One of the reasons for this retreat was the subversive stand of Iran which was announced by the Shah of Iran in London who declared his government's intention not to contribute and its agreement with Western companies to increase the production of Iran in a huge manner so that any attempt fails to idcorease production in order to bear pressure on the companies.

PROPLES FRONT FOR LIBERATION OF OMAN AND THE ARABIAN GULF TAKES PART IN SECOND CONFERENCE OF AFRO-ASIAN WOMAN HELD IN OLAN BATOR

The People's Front for the Liberation of Cman and the Arabian Gulf took part in the women conference held in Alan Bator during the period 14th to 19th August. The conference was attended by 62 woman delegations nineteen of which represented the national liberation movements. #### WEEKLY POLITIC AL ANALYSIS

### IRAN - THE WA CH-DOG FOR THE INTERESTS OF IMPERIALISM

The report is the conclusion by Iran and Britain of an agreement on a huge arms deal valued at 100 million sterling and covers most destructive offensive weapons including tanks of the Scorpion type, modern reconnaisance ships, military warships, fast patrol boats and anti-aircraft rockets of the Rapier type. The deal also provides that Iran is to get its needs of necessary spare parts for its armed forces and organisation by British exports of military training programmes on the new weapons for the officers and soldiers in the Iranian armed forces.

No doubt a deal in such greatness calls for such a question: Why imperialism makes of Iran an arsenal depot while Iran itself is not threatened by any foreign country? It is surrounded by a State perceful in its policy and other States which are go wool to threaten the security of Iran and which circle in the orbit of Iran or are in alliance with Iran.

American and British imperialism poured more der Muctive weapons on Iran and the puppet a Shah regime obtained weapons never obtained even by America's allies of Western countries. It secured Phentom planes even before Israel did and obtained Hawk and Rapier rockets. It also secured modern tanks of the American Centorion type and British Chieftein type. Finally this recent deal came to reveal to the world that Iran is equipped from top to bottom.

No doubt that American has drawn up a role for the Iranian reactionary regime conforming with this great power. The U.S. State Under-Secretary Joseph Seiscu revealed that emerica depends on Iran in safeguarding peace and stability in the Arabian Gulf and it is confident in Iran's ability to do so.

So the first role to be performed by the ' 1 3hah regime is to protect the interests of imperialism in the Arabian Gulf Basin. From this role we can understand the behaviour of Iran beginning with occupation of the three Arab islands and ending with control over Bassendum Strait.

The imperialist interests and in particular the oil interests are not threatened by any foreign State. Moreover, all Gulf regimes are tools in the hands of the imperialist interests and are frontages for the oil companies. Then the only danger posed to those capitalist interests stems from the area masses - Iranian and Arabs. Any observer of the situations in the Arabian Gulf realises that the mohopolistic companies are the actual rulers and replace the frontage rulers whenever their interests call for that. They also have hold on everything and control the refundion of the Gulf States. Only the revolutionary organisations and Arab and Iranian masses remain to suffer alone from the dreadful exploitation of the companies and looting of the wealths of the area which suffers from terrific repression and oppression so that these companies continue the looting.

The role of the Iranian repressive machinery is to break down an revolutionary movement in the arena. This is not hidden by Iran as the Shah announced that if Britain allowed him to break the revolution led by the People's Front he would do that in two weeks.

#### WEEKLY POLITICAL ANALYSIS - Cont'd.

Moreover Iran entered into an alliance with the puppet regime in the Sultanate and also entered into a regional pact with other puppet regimes in the area which give it the chance of entering any area threatening the interests of imperialism. In fact Iranian patrols roun the Irabian Gulf and watch the western coasts. They also occupied the Arab islands as a sign for occupying other parts if the Interests of imperialism call for that.

As to other filthy role of Iran it is summarised in fighting for the interests of the interest. This huge deal took place during the presence of the Bhah of Iran London at the beginning of July and after his shomeful announcement that his government aband ned the principle of sharing in the ownership of oil companies as agreed upon in the organisation of oil-exporting countries. By this Iran have played a subversive role in the efforts of these countries seven of which are Arabs, to limit looting by the companies of theoil wealths of the Arab people and to secure the minimum limit of control on the activities of suspected monopolistic companies which do not hesitate to supply Israel with oil directing by this a final blow to the oil-producing countries as admitted by all observers. For this reason the monopolistic companies refrained and did not pay attention to the demands of the government. The Shah of Iran also revealed that the deal between him and the monopolistic companies will raise the Iranian oil production to reach 400 tons annually within three years. This naturally will take place at the expense of Arab production and will share in hitting the experiment of oil nationalisation by Iraq in hitting a forthcoming oil experiment and to fill the sefes of the executioners of the Iranian people with millions and save other millions for arming and building the huge armies to protect the interests of imperialism and decayed regimes.

The role of Iran in serving the imperialist plan is a dangerous role which any Arab whether independent, official or . . . must not overlook as such will be regarded a national orine. The Iranian arms are directed in the first place against the Arab people and Iranian occupation of the Arab islands is a lively proof on the serious expansionist policy of the Iranian regime.

A short word we conclude from the historical experience of then and number of aircraft and tanks increases, the fate of the oil and homeland is in the hands of the members of this poor toiling people under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation Of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

# MILITARY OPERATORS DURING ONE WEEK FROM 16.8 to 24.8.72

Battles raged this week in the north of Sarfeet where the People's Liberation army launched night and day attacks signified by fierce and heavy shalling and fire. Our heroes scofed the records in the number of these attacks including shelling and sniping. They recorded this week five sniping operations from short distances and ten offensive operations. Shelling was concentrated and fire was heavy making the enemy hit with great panic, and failed on many occasions to retreat because of encirclement from all directions. This made the enemy to seek the help of British aircraft which bombed the area indiscriminately without casuing any casualties on our side.

Enemy casualties were:-

- 1) Death and injury of more than 25 enemy individuals,
- 2) Destruction of two machine-guns,
- 3) Destruction of fortifications completely
- 4) Casualties were not assessed in some operations.

Fire went ablaze in enemy tents and benzine barrels which were heard exploding.

From our side there were no casualties.

## CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY REINFORCES DETERIORATED SITUATION IN EARREIN

On 2nd July, Mohammad bin Naukrak , Foreign Minister of the State of Bahrain announced the declaration of the long-awaited draft constitution which defines the basis for the establishment of the Constituent Assembly.

The declaration of the new plan came following Rogers' visit to Bahrain where he inspected the Americanbases and ascertained the power of American presence. That was not mere coincidence as the new plan which is being implemented in Bahrain is part of the comprehensive American plan to re-arrange the situations in the Arabian Gulf area to ensure control and the interests of imperialism topped by the American interests.

The plan for the Constituent Assembly and the constitution comes as part of a comprehensive plan to modernise the imperialist presence in Bahrain and to guarantee American influence. This was preceded, in a speedy manner, by control of American monopolies over the economy of Bahrain and its use as a launching point for economic pometration in the area. American influence and military presence replaced British political influence and military presence and work is now goingon to reinforce American colonialist cultural influence.

At a time in which the authority marched on the road of complete surrender to the American plan, Bahrain was opened for the establishment of American bases and for American monopolies and invasion by colonialist culture. Masses of the people resisted the new American colonialism fiercely. This was resembled in the continued strikes and demonstrations which werecrowned by the uprising of March 72.

Resistance by the masses made the authority to hasten implementation of the plan to forge the popular will represented by fundamental demands for the establishment of a national democratic regime, which made the authority work to make half nationalists and opportunists take part in looting the people through government posts and the Constituent Assembly.

In fact the authority knows that a wide vacuum separates between the masses on one side and the authority on the other. The masses cannot bargain with their demands which were reinforced with blood and incurred great sacrifices for them in the struggle.

This explosive situation between the authority and the masses and this hatred which deepened in the hearts of the people and this inesistance by the authority to enact all nethods of repression at a time in which it is raising the flags and banners of the new constitution and Constituent Assembly, made the authority take all steps so that no honest element infiltrates through elections or the Constituent assembly to reveal the whole game. The constitution came as the strangest of all constitutions so that we can described as reinforcement for complete tribal rule and a mockery which will never pass.

#### CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY - Cont'd.

We review some provisions of this strange constitution:

- 1) The constitution deprives half the society of women from the right of free franchise and condidature. This happens in the twentieth century and under a regime which joined the United Nations the charter of which forbids discrimination between citizens due to race, cast or else.
- 2) Only those men holding passports whose age exceeds twenty years reserve the right to vote. If we know that a passport cannot be obtained except by those accepted by the intelligence service, a big part of citizens remain without passports. Moreover the worker and poor peasant do not have the time to obtain a passport otherwise they will lose their jobs.
- 3) Anyone sentenced by the authority courts in the past or who is spending a prison term does not have the right to vote. If we know that the clash with the authority did not stop since 1956, manycitizens sentenced by the authority or a kept under watch, and so a big. Part of the citizens will remain aloof particularly that the government reserves the right to keep away whoever forms danger to security.
- 4) Those who embraced the Bahranian nationality or even born in Bahrani have no right to vote except after fifteen years from nationalisation. Here a big portion of the people is kept albof.
- 5) The ordinance fixes the number of members of the Constituent Assembly at 42 of whom 22 are elected and ten are appointed in addition to the Ministers. Bythis the majority is guaranteed and appointed by the authority.
- 6) The electoral constituencies were not distributed in accordance with the number of voters but the authority gave areas controlled by it for certain reasons an undesserved number of representatives such as the southern area in Manamah Island.
- 7) The authority deprived employees from the right of voting. If we know that the biggest portion of enlightened elements are employees the area would remain wide for the merchants and landlords.

By introducing the above provisions of the constitution, we only wanted to prove the backwardness of the authority and to show to persons with good will and Liberals who may be deceived by this new conspiracy and tell them not to be pulled behind the authority or those who make propaganda for it on the grounds of positiveness. In fact,

our masses are more enlightened to be overcome by this new plan. The boycott by the masses appeared clear since the start of registration for election. This boycott resulted in the registration of only 7 per cent of those who have the right to register for election. This clearly showed that different sections of the people agreed that the masses do not trust the authority for several reasons including:-

1) The experiment of thesemasses with the authority which resorts to promises when it finds itself in a crisis but when it becomes able to repress the masses it breaks its promises and directs violence against the people.

- 2) The authority will impose whatever it wants through the Constituent Assembly because it holds the appointed majority an all those who are good with it.
- 3) Elections are being held in a country ruled by martial. law where the best members of the people sit in prisons and others kept under watch or expelled by the British intelligence.

On the other hand no nationalist element nominated himself that even in some areas such as al-Hadd the only candidate was the candidate nominated by the authority.

The duty of every nationalist at thise stage is to reveal this malicious plan and to confront the propaganda campaigns launched by the authority machineries and the puppet press and to call upon all masses to boycott the elections. Let the word of the masses be heard loud on 1st December not for the fictitious elections and the appointed Constituent Assembly but for the continuation of the struggle until the tribal regime is toppled down. Not for elections under the spears of the American forces but for the liberated and united homeland which is free of foreign bases and tribal authority.
