


IMPORTANT SPECH BY COMPADE ABOUT FATTAH ISMAIL ON 9th JUNE

To mark the tenth anniversary of the 9th June revolution a massive rally was held in the eve of Monday 9th June, 1975, following huge massive processions. For this rally the Yemeni masses came out to great the tenth anniversary of the procession of the struggle of our people to affirm their determination and backing for the struggle of our Omani people.

The rolly was attended by many of the Arab and foreign diplomatic corps and the representative of Arab liberation movements as well as a delegation from the Afro-Asian Organisation, and a delegation from the Soviet Committee for Solidarity with the peoples of Asia and Africa.

It was also attended by Comrade Abdel Fattah Ismail, Secretary General of the Central Committee of the National Front Political Organisation and some members of the National Front Central Committee.

Comrade "bdel Fasten Ismail delivered a speech on this occasion in which he condemned the Iranian invasion of Oman and described it as an open interference against the Arab nation, entirely. In his speech the Secretary General of the National Front called upon all Arab ragimes and the Arab national liberation movements to stand uppfor facing the imperialist danger and the danger resulting from Iranian expansion in the Arabian Gulf area.

Comrade Todal Fattah Ismail warned that this area might become an area posing danger to the freedom and sovereignty of the Arab people in the Arabian Teninsula and "ulf and the entity of the Arab nation. Comrade Abdel Fattah Ismail said that confrontation of this danger necessarily calls for a united stand by the Arab regimes in backing and supporting the revolution of the people of Oman against the forces of imperialism and reaction so that the revolution shall be able to expel the forcign invaders and to liquidate the puppet occupationist forces linked with them.

Comrade Abdel Fattah Ismail strongly condemned the national treason committed by the pupper Qaboos regime which recently hired the Masirah island to the United Status of America. Comrade Abdel Fattah Ismail reaffirmed Democratic Yemen's firm support for the revolution of the Omani people under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman. He said that such stand affirms the right of the Chani people to determine their own destiny without any foreign interference.

Other speeches were also delivered by the representative of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman who praised the firm stands of the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen and also highly valued the stands of support and backing by some other Arab national regimes such as Libya, Iraq and all ocialist countries and friends who support our issue.

A speech was also delivered by the leader of the delegation from the Soviet Committee for Solidarity with the peoples of Asia and Africa who affirmed the standof the Soviet people by the side of the struggle of the omani people and their continuous support for it for its freedom from foreign influence.

He said in his specch: "The patriots of Oman have recorded throughout the past ten years wonderful pages in the history of the Arab national liberation movements. In spite of the attempts by reaction to isolate the liberation struggle in Oman from the world public opinion yet the solidarity campaign by the progressive forces with the struggle of the Omani people is continuously and constantly increasing and expanding along with the international position of the People's Front." He condemned the foreign interference in Oman and declared confidence over the victory of the Omani people.

Other speeches were also delivered by the representatives of the liberation organisations and mass organisations.

MARTYR ZAHER GROUP BLACTS AL-MIRANI FORT IN MUSCAT

In reply to the acts of repression and terrorism exercised by the criminal Qaboos authorities and in retaliation for the souls of the martyrs who were martyred in the homeland and those who are still sitting in the cells and dungeons of the dreadful Muscat prisons awaiting their role in the physical torture and to mark the tenth amiversary of the glorious 9th June revolution, the Martyr Zaher ali latter al-Miyahi group planted on 25th May, 1975, an explosive device in one of the arms stores at al-Mirani fort in Muscat which is about 500 metres away from puppet Qaboos palace. The device exploded causing a huge sound which terrorised the inhabitants of Muscat. he explosion resulted in the destruction of a large portion of al-Mirani fort and fire broke out in it for several hours. About one hundred soldiers and officers from the puppet Qaboos army which exists inside this fort have been wounded and killed.

It is to be recalled that a military barrack belonging to the enemy army is stationed in this fort.

News agencies beamed the incident which the Muscat authorities attributed to be caused by gun powder. The traitorous authorities in Muscat carried out extensive arrest campaign amidst the ranks of the army directly after the incident.

JALLOUD SAYS: ARAB REGIMES DID NOT SPEAK EVENO NE WORD ABOUT THE INTERFERENCE OF 20,000 IRANIANS IN OMÁN

In the fifth anniversary of the evacuation of the American forces and bases from the Libyan Arab Republic, a huge ceremony was held in which the Libyan people and members of the Libyan Revolutionary Command Council participated.

The ceremony was attended by Comrade Ali Nasser Mohammad, Prime Minister of the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen and the delegation accompanying him in addition to some leaders of the Palestinian resistance including Comrade George Habbash, Comrade had Gibrael and Comrade Naif Hawatimah.

Comrade Abdel Sallam Jalloud, Prime Minister of Libya, delivered an important speech on this occasion on behalf of Colonel Muammar Qaddafi, in which he reviewed the conspiracies of imperialism, Zionism and reaction which are being woven against the Arab national regimes for liquidating the Palestinian and Omani Revolutions and otherArab revolutionary forces.

Jalloud doo dealt in his speech with the situation in Oman. He said that if the papet Iranian and Jordanian forces do not withdraw from Oman, the Libyan Arab Republic will go to fight with the revolutionaries and people of Oman to expel the Iranian invaders and the British and American forces which protect the puppet Qaboos regime. He also warned British and American colonialism and the Iranian invaders and the mercenaries of puppet Hussein to withdraw from Oman and to leave puppet Qaboos solve his problems with the revolution and people.

Jalloud said that this serious responsibility at this time in particular calls upon all Arab regimes which did not utter a single word on the interference of 20,000 Iranians in Oman, to define their stands. He said that silence is now killing us while fconfronting Zionism. It is also killing us in Oman. Jalloud warned the Anglo-

American colonialism and the Iranian invaders and the puppet regime in Jordan from the consequences of continuing to fight the Omani people and to interfere in Oman, a matter which qualifies the area to become a new South-East Asia. He said that the Libyan Arab Republic will unite with all revolutionaries and national forces in the Arabian Gulf and Peninsula.

Other speeches were also delivered on this occasion by the leaders of the resistance, who praised the stands of Libya towards thenational and patriotic issues of Palestine and Oman.
