PRESS STATEM

An official source in the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman (PFLO) made the following state:

ment: "The command of the Omani revolution followed the total plans and conspiracies which are being woven against Oman and the Arabian Gulf and the chain of suspected moves being made by the Anglo-American imperialists and their puppets in Muscat.

The talk repeated by the Sultanate and the Western sircles on the presence of a plan to close the Hormuz Strait is in fact nothing but lies and fabricated propaganda with which they want to justify the foreign interference in the Arabian Gulf area topped by American military interference. All these fabricated propaganda are exposed recently by the project submitted by the Sultanate of Oman to the Gulf countries for the creationof colonialist military pacts in the area in follaboration with the forces of imperialism headed by the United States of America which in fact started to send its experts and vanguards of its forces to the Omani island of Masirah. We, inthe People's Front for the Liberation of Oman .nnounce to the world entirely that we are very eager and keen about the safe functionof navigation in the Hormuz Strait and will not and never think of undertaking any act threatening navigation in this lively and important waterway in the world.

We affirm to the Arab and world pablic opinions that the American plans HORMUZ

and merican military presence in the area and the estabnlishment of suspected military pacts and the presence of a regime such as the regime of Qaboos are they which threaten the security of the area and its peoples and create further tansion that will inturn threaten world peace wholly. The American military presence and the continuation of the stay of a regimesuch as the Qaboos regimein Muscat constitutes great danger to the area. We in the front struggle and call continuously for the liberation of Oman "the Sultanate" from foreign presence and to keep the area away from any military pacts or any military presence by any foreign forces as this alone would realise real security and stability including the safety of waterwys and others.

The recent call by the Sultanate is infact an American call. This call was rejected and condemned by the Arabian Gulf countries such as Iraq and Kuwait andmust be rejected by other countries. But in addition, the open activities hostile to the peoples of the area and carried out by the Muscat regime must inour view be faced with more firm apprehension than mere condemnation and denouncement. Qaboos was the quickest Gulf ruler to respond to the American warnings i n connection with the "subyersive acts" against t he oil tankers crossing Hormuz Strait. At the same time he was one of the few rulers towhom Washington, while giving such warnings offered its preparedness to consolidate his defensive abilities in order that he performs his role in a better manner for defending the lively interests in this strategic area. The quick response and generous offer only proof the nature of relations and horizons of their development in hture between Washington and Muscat as the first, after loosing its stronger staunch in this area following the victory of the Iranian revolution and the toppling down of the Shah, became in more need to the rulers of Muscat in order to undertake increasing roles at the level of ensuring the flow of oil to the capitalist countries and imparticular America, and defending one of the most important straits through which it passes.

If the signified strategic position being occupled by Oman in the Arabian Gulf where the interests of American imperialismexist, andthe Indian Ocean where the Seventh Fleet is stationed, it is possible to realise Washington's eagerness & care to give Muscat special attention.

Inturn Qaboos realises

such facts and adds to them his full preparedness to sell our country to the circles of imperialism in return for the crumbs thrown by these circles to Qaboos and his like to keep themable to spend on their personal desires so long that these imperialist circles have the desire to back him and help him against the brave Omani people and their escalating struggles under the leader ship of the People's Front for he Liberation of Oman, which is disturbing him and of which he fears much especially after the Iranian revolution withdrew the forces sent by the Shah to support Qaboos in t h e annihilation war launched by him against the masses of the Omani people.

Emanating fromthis, and nothing else, Qaboos hastened to consolidate his forces overlooking the Hormuz Strait on the grounds of the "correctness" of the American speculations and occurance of the incident of Monday 21st July.

Meither national severeignty nor Omani prestige and dignity were standing before the eyes of Qaboos when he decided to "stand against the occurance of any incident in that waterway",.

Stemming from the same launching points and in fulfilment of its desire to increase its military presence in this area and particularly on the Omani "Meairah" island where the



American forces get special facilities for the pieces of their fleets operating inthis area, Washington offered Qaboos to supply him with his needs of forces for taking up position in this strait and for standing against anything that may disturb the safety of cil tankers crossing it or subject them to danger.

For the sake of justifying such mean and treacherous projects against the Omani people, the Western information media started to circulate rumours to the effect that those to undertake such acts would only be one of the two: the Palestine revolution or the Omani revolution.

The Palestine revolution hastweed to demy the possibility of carrying out such an act and affirmed that when it decides to perform any acts against oil and its installations it would do that inside the United States itself.

Wein turn affirmthat oil is an Arab wealth and a source of power for the Arabs and when we decide to hit the interests of imperialism in this area there is the ladder of priorities and there are our humanitarian responsibilities at international level which we value much and credit them the needed attention and behave towards them in the required manner.

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## OF PEOPLE'S FRONT IN BAHRAIN.

On the day of Idd al-Fitr (Muslim feast) the Bahraini authority carried out an extensive arrest campaignwhich covered more than 120 (one hundred and twenty citizens) fellewing the peaceful precessien in which thousands of demenstraters took part demanding the release of thepolitical detainees fellowing the arrest of Sheikh Mehammad al-Akri and Ali al-Asfeer at the airport af5ter their return from Iran.

The authority has already launched the first campaign fellowing the procession of 17th August - the day of selidarity with the liberation of Jerusalem. By this campaign the authority confirmed its traiterous attitude towards the Palestimiam issue and its great hestility towards the pepular masses which called for the liberation of Jerusales and placement of all Araband Islamic petentialities under the service of the Palestinian isaue.

These repressive campaigns cameinscentinuation of the traiterous eppressive atitude adopted by the authority.

On one hand it is epening its prisens and detentions for the heneurable nationalists subjecting them to ugliest types of terture savagely and penfiscating all political andtrade union rights of the dizens and making th-

em priseners of the awkwardnessef the ruling class and the Special Branch which is supervised by British and Jerdamian experts. The matter even reached the extent of confiscating the passports of hundreds of university students and their deprivation of centinuing their studies as well as the chaining of their freedom of mevement. It refused response to the just demands of the workers for creating trade unions and technical federations for them and threw against the wall the simplest human rights stipulated by the Charter of the United Nations andHuman Rights Commission as it detained tens of nationalists and trade unienists since more thanfive years witheut trial. On the other hand, it is opening the deers of the country for all trade and banking monopolies and agents of +ha American Central Intelligence and British intelligence and remains of the Savak and the ousted Iranian regime and made Bahrain a base for the American fleet and a station for American military aircraft, and it is not hesitating to transform the country into a centre for all bur glary operations being undertaken by the imperialists from the Gulf area for losting the o i l revalties. It is also turning the country into a launching pad for American pletting inthe Gulf.

We appeal to the Arab and world public opinion to at and by the side of our people and its national forces and militants whe are lying in the Hudderson prisons and detentions.

Our people is fighting for its just rights for the release of political and trade union freedoms and abelitien of repressive laws and in particular the ill-famed State Security law restoration of parliamentary life and releaseof all political detainees as well as abolition of the hard resolutions against the right of hundreds of students, as well as liquidation of the American bases.

We also appealto all honourable pens and jurist organisations to stand by the side of our people and defend it in the face of the oppressive tyrants. We highly admire all campaigns of solidarity and backing extended by many of the political and trade unionorganisations and honeurable people which campaigns have had great effect in the hearts of our people andits national forces.

We are confident of the etermination of our people and its insistance to wrest its rights backed by Arab and world solidarity with which it will force the rubing authority change such traitorous oppressive attitude being adopted and exercised by it.
