MILITARY MOVEMENTS OF THE ENEMY

With the end of the rainy season which extends from the month of June upto the end of September the enemy undertook extensive movements during the past days. The enemy carried out the following moves in the Western Region:

A landing operation took place in North Sarfeet on 23rd September in which thirteen helicopters of the Augustile type and a transport plane were used.

Another landing operation also took place on 24th September in the north of the Western Region in East Sarfeet in which thirteen helicopters were used.

The enemy launched a concentrated shelling operation on our positions at Daghmeet on 25th September:

The enemy resumed the landing operations on 26th September using a helicopter and a transport plane in each trip as the operation was repeated for six times in the enemy centre at Sarfeet.

Two fighter bomber planes shelled Akoob area and in the evening the enemy staged another landing operation using several Iranian helicopters estimated at seven.

Eight helicopters carried out a landing operation under cover of fighter bomber planes in North Sarfeet in the direction of Najd. These were reinforced by giant transport planes estimated at seven.

In the evening the enemy warships staged a concentrated shelling operation on Akoob area: The shelling continued for two hours.
