

MILITARY COMMUNIQUES ON MILITARY OPERATIONS  
BETWEEN HEROES OF PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY AND PEOPLE'S MILITIA  
ON ONE HAND AND IRANIAN INVASION FORCES AND JORDANIAN AND QABOOS  
MERCENARIES ON THE OTHER

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 87/75

On 29th March, 1975, the colonialist reactionary enemy forces which are composed of Iranian and Jordanian battalions and local mercenaries led by British and Iranian officers and lifted by armed Iranian helicopters under cover of fighter aircraft in addition to huge forces carried by armoured cars, launched an extensive military campaign against the liberated Eastern Region and all over the southern tape of Nasheb highlands and Durbat heights to the west and all over the northern part of Kheisal.

The enemy made landing operations in many areas in the high lands and important points such as water sources and the gatherings of citizens. The enemy forces carried by vehicles and armoured cars also advanced to realise this assignment but the forces of the People's Liberation Army and the People's Militia were watching the advance of the enemy and his movements.

The clash with the enemy forces started at Aqabat Arram before midnight on 29th March for fifteen minutes. At 1.30 a.m on 29th March another group of our forces clashed with the enemy forces at Arram for ten minutes. At 2.00 a.m. a third group of our forces clashed with the enemy forces for the third time for ten minutes. At 3.15 in the morning of 30.9.75 the fourth group of our forces clashed with the enemy forces at Arram for ten minutes. At 5.00 a.m. a group from the Liberation Army and the People's Militia clashed with the enemy forces for quarter of an hour. At nine in the morning of the same day (30.3) a group of our forces clashed with the enemy forces which were brought to the battlefield on armed helicopters. The heroes of the liberation army managed to hit two enemy helicopters directly one of which was seen falling on the coast and the other was seen falling towards Arrazzat.

At four in the afternoon of the same day a group of our forces attacked the enemy forces at Arram for fifteen minutes.

At 1.00 in the midnight of 30.3.75 one of our groups clashed with another group of the enemy in the north of "Tubraq" for quarter of an hour. A helicopter was seen removing the dead and injured of the enemy forces.

On 2nd April our forces attacked the enemy forces which are withdrawing from Tubraq and using for their withdrawal helicopters. They managed to hit two helicopters loaded with troops directly. One of these fell between the plains of Razzat and Khor Sooli while the other made a force landing at Razzat. An enemy official spokesman confessed the fall of one helicopter and the hitting of another and the death of two British officers.

At 3.45 the People's Liberation Army and People's Militia forces launched a concentrated attack on the enemy forces at Tubraq which enemy forces were unable to withdraw. A fierce battle ensued in which the enemy suffered heavy losses which covered:-

- 1) Death of eighteen officers and soldiers from the Iranian, Jordanian and British and mercenary forces
- 2) Destruction of a wireless set completely
- 3) Hitting of one armed Iranian helicopter and death and injury of its occupants.

From our side brave comrade Ahmed Omer Kharfash was martyred.

The enemy launched a barbaric raid and savage shelling against the houses of the citizens resulting in the injury of the two daughters of the martyr Saeed Mussallan seriously, along with two female citizens who are the daughters of martyr Ahmed Saeed Aggar. This is the habit of the coward enemy in retaliating from the citizens after all confrontation with our brave forces.

Following the losses and utter defeat of the enemy, the enemy retaliated from the citizens when the Iranian invasion forces and the executionists of puppet King Hussein and the mercenaries of the British and Arabs attacked the citizens and exterminated their livestock, which compose a source of living for them. They also looted their properties and foodstuffs and burnt their houses and later the enemy withdrew pulling behind him the signs of defeat.

#### OPERATION OF TWO MARTYRS BADR ALI AND AHMED MAHROOS.

On 6th April, 1975, the People's Liberation Army forces launched an artillery shelling operation on the enemy centre at Agarat (north-east of Rakhyout) using heavy artillery for twenty minutes. The shelling was strong and concentrated on the enemy positions and fortifications. The enemy suffered three casualties amongst his members. Moreover five defensive positions were destroyed and our forces returned safely to base.
