denouncing the armed Workers Innian invasion of Oman

Amidst the huge masses of people, speeches condemning the Shah-Qabus plots and the Iranian invasion and supporting the struggles of the people of Oman & the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of P.F.L.O A.G were delivered at the confederation of Yemeni Workers Headquarters in Aden, Representatives of the mass organizations, the Union of Democratic Yemeni Youth, the Popular Front for the Liberation of Oman & the Arabian Gulf and the Central Committee of the Congolese Communist Party delivered speeches expressing utter condemnation of the Iranian invasion of Oman and demonstrating its complementary aspect to the Zionist invasion of other parts of the Arab world. The speakers communicated the full support that their organisations gave to the people of Oman & the Arabian Gulf in their just struggle led by P.F.L.O.A G. against the local and Iranian reactionaries.

In a declaration issued by the General Confederation of Yemeni on the occasion, the Workers stated that the Confederation position Of Iran in its plots against our people in the position of Israel in the Middle East and that both these countries represented the shock force directed against the Arab people and the aggressive base for invasion. The reason for this is to liquidate the revolutionary Arab movement as part of the general imperialist-reactionary strategy of hitting at the national liberation movements and toppling, the

progressive regimes throughout the world. The declaration emphasized that the great ties which link the revolutions in the Arabian Gulf, in Yemen, and in the Arabian Peninsula are the objective consolidation to the 9th of June revolution under the leadership of P.F.L.O.A.G. and that the 14th of October revolution in Yemen and the 9th of June revolution in Oman & the Arabian Gulf are part of the Arab revolutionary movement and the international revolutionary movement.

The representative of the Union of Democratic Yemeni Youth pointed out that in order to have a good

understanding of the nature of the struggle in the Arabian Gulf one must comprehend the motive behind these developements. This area contians 60% of the known world oil reserve and is the main source of gil to U.S. imperialism and its allies in Europe, Japan and all this in the atmosphere of the "energy-crisis". The invasion was not an event without its previous manifestations, such as, the hysterical arming of Iran and the other CENTO members, the U.S. diplomats meeting in Tehran, the massive shipments of arms to Saudi Arabia.

# **Public opinion against Iranian Invasion**

A call From Support Committee for the Liberation Movement in the Galf.

The Committee received the following telegram from the P.F.L.O.A.G dated 27 December 1973:

#### IRANIAN MILITARY CAMPAIGN AGAINST LIBERATED ZONE AROUSE PUBLIC OPINION.

Later reports in Western sources confirm that 3,000 more soldiers of the fascist regime of the Shah were sent to Salallah, the capital of Dhofar and the only -major area still under the control of the forces of the Sultan. The Iranian soldiers are now engaged in fierce battles against the revolutionary forces of the PFLOAG as well as massing troops near the border with the Democratic Republic of Yemen. The Iranian Air Forces is continuously and savagely - bombing-the-liberated regions.

The Shah's "beat" as gendarme of the Gulf has been enlarged. Recent war communciqes from the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf indicate that the oace of the struggle has quickened. Reports of downing British airplanes indicate that the people's war in Oman is entering a new phase. It was clear that the forces of the Sultan and his British "advisors" even bolstered by small contingents of Jordanian secret police and Iranian soldiers could not cope with the revolution.

plans for such contingencies. The U.S. puppet regime of the Shah has been shored up militarily for years in order to step in and preserve "Law and Order" for U.S. imperia lism in the Gulf. Iran has apparently been given the go-ahead to attempt to intervene in Oman.

The troops near the border with revolutionary Yemen are ominous as well. The imperialists are well aware that the P.D.R.Y, is the firm rear area of the revolutionary forces throughout the Arabian peninsula and in the region generally. Attacks in the past have come from north Yemen and Saudi Arabia as well as British bombing raids over the border with Oman. Unless the imperialists attack by sea as the British did when they took Aden in 1839 the only route left is by land from Dhofar

The revolutionary forces around the Gulf will never allow this viscious attack to go unanswered. The Iranian people in particular have

#### 25 LEBANESE STUDENT ORGANISATIONS ISSUE A STATEMENT

In a joint statement by 25 student organ sations in Lebanon, the Iranian invasion was strongly condemned, and the war of aggression against the Omani people and its vanguard PFLCAG was described as one against the whole Arab nation. The statement called upon the Arab democratic and nationalist forces to immeliately realise the following demands:-1. Support the Popular Front in its

struggle against the reactionary rulers of the Gulf and against the Iranian and British invasion.

2. Mobilise all Arab resources to foil the plot against the Arab National Liberation movement, of which the Geneva surrender conference and the invasion of Oman are manifestations

3. The complete withdrawal of the invading forces of Iran.

...4. All Arab nationalist states to sever all relations with invading Iran,

5. Dismiss the government of the Omani Sultanate from all official Arab Organisations and Institutions, because by inviting invasion it lost its national independence.

6. Support Democratic Yemen as a revolutionary focus in the Arab peninsular.

The Shah of Iran, this ruthless, and its imperialist masters against despotic dictator, has "finally taken the step he has been itching to take for years.At the bidding of his U.S. imperialist masters, on Dec. 20 he sent 3,000 Iranian troops to wage an offensive against the heroic struggle of the people of Dhofar. He also has as many as 30,000 troops presently stationed in Oman.

This is the second major act of aggression which the Shah has carried out in the Gulf and is a blatant attack against the people of the entire Gulf. (His first major at tack was military occupation of three Gulf islands in 1971.)

The revolution of our Arab brothers and sisters in Oman and around the Gulf, under the correct leadership of the PFLOAG, is being seriously threatened by the Shah's barbaric attack. The Shah is carrying out his role as gendarme of the Gulf in the most blatant form now by directly and openly trying to crush the struggle of the people of Oman. Ever since the people of Oman began and particularly the Omani masses their revolutionary struggle in the province of Dhofar on the ninth of June in 1965, their struggle has reached out and touched the masses around the Gulf. Particularly in recent years, the struggle in Oman as a whole has gained tremendous victories and has become a point of inspiration for all the Arab and Iranian masses in the Gulf region This struggle is awakening all the peoples of the region to rise up and struggle for their national independence and freedom. The imperialists cannot tolerate the existence of this revolution. For it presents the most serious threat to political and strategic interest of the imperialists and especially to the lifeline of the capitalist world, the vast oil resources of the Gulf

The Shah's attack against the people of Oman and the Gulf which is being focused in Dhofar is a test of the Shah's ability to act as a gendarme to protect the imperialsts' interests and to bolster the other local reactionary puppets in the area. This attack is a test of whether the imperialists have been able to successfully turn Iran into a counterrevolutionary base against the people of the Gulf.

The fascist attempt by Momammad Reza Shah's gang to annihilate the entire revolutionary movement in the Gulf must be wholeheartedly and actively condemned It is the duty of all Iranian revolutionaries to raise high the banner of militant unity between the struggle in Iran and the struggle throughout the Gulf. And by continuously struggling against the aggressive Pahlavi regime and its imperialist masters, we must change Iran from a base of counter-revolution to a base of revolution in the Gulf.

The new-feature today is not the great size of this military operation in the Dhofari countryside but the nature and size of the role given to the Iranian reactionary invaders and this also demonstrates the willingness of the puppet regimes to accept invaders to protect their thrones.

We direct a call to all the progressive forces and forces of freedom and peace to take its great responsibilities in standing beside the 9th of June revolution. The progressive Arab forces are called to stand by the revolution in its battle of destiny in these historical moments of its life.

It is their duty to do so now, In 1956, the peoples of the whole Arab nation rose and denounced the tripartite aggression against Egypt The Arab regimes, consequently had to support the struggle of the Egyptian people. In 1967 after the June defeat, when the Arab armies were destoryed and their

regimes humiliated, at a time when Moshe Dayan was waiting for a surrender plea form the heads of Egypt and Syria, the Arab masses moved by their true patriotic feelings and refused to surrender. Following the appeal made by he People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf to he Iranian. Arab and international progressive organisations to protest against the armed Iranian invasion of the liberated area of Dhofar (Oman) and its open interference in the affairs of Oman, the Confederation of Iranian Students (National Organisation) called for a protest demonstration on Wednesday 9th January 1974 in Frankfurt to deplore the Iranian invasion and to back up the struggle of our people in Oman under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

BRITISH GOVERNMENT: MORE **BACKING FOR QABOOS** 

he Etitish Government promised the Muscat Government with the extension of technical aid.
