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ISRAELI IMPERIALIST AGGRESSION CONDEMNED IN DELHI:

Former Indian Defence Minister Krishna Menon has called on the Arab League Office in Delhi placing all his services at the disposal of the Arab cause.

A cable from the Acting Director of the Arab League Office in New Delhi stated that students are still pressing to join the battle against Israeli aggression.

Meanwhile, a popular meeting was organised on June 4th which passed a resolution condemning the Israeli-imperialist aggression.

STATEMENT BY OMANI OFFICE IN CAIRO.

The Omani people have announced that they have devoted their lives, their oil and all their material and moral potentialities to the destruction of Israel and those who stand by it. A statement to this effect was issued by the Omani Office in Cairo.

The statement said the people have decided to destroy all ports, airports, military and oil establishments on its territory when the decisive moment comes.

ARAB LEAGUE REPRESENTATIVE IN BONN DENOUNCES ISRAELI AGGRESSION.

El Sayed Zohair El Kabbani, Director of the Arab League Office in Bonn has affirmed in a TV interview that the war now

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raging in the Middle East was kindled by the Israeli aggression on the United Arab Republic.

Referring to West German supplies to Israel, El Sayed Kabbani said that the Arabs regard as military supplies any goods, shipped by West Germany to Israel which can be used for military purposes.

In conclusion, the Arab League Representative affirmed that the Bonn Office has received several applications from the German citizens to volunteer in the battle.

ACTIVITIES OF ARAB LEAGUE OFFICES ABROAD.

The Arab League Office in Paris has made two statements to the French TV, and the French Broadcasting station and Luxembourg Radio and TV referring to the Israeli aggressions, the statements of Israeli officials and war prisoners affirming Israel's aggressive intentions.

The League's office in Bonn has also officially informed the German Foreign Ministry of the Israeli aggression calling on it to honour its pledges to withheld support from Israel and stop the supply of strategic materials to it.
