Assifa Strikes & Holds Again

ASSIFA commandos of the Palastine National Liberation Movement, al-Fatch carr ied out Sept.30, two more major and simu ltaneous operations against the accey on a wide front that covered the Upper Gali lee as well as the Central and Northern Jordan Valley.

The two operations marked another step in the new stage of commando strategy -that of 'mobile war" which was first implemented at the battle of al-Himmeh on May 2 1969

The Sept.30 operations were code-named Abu Deyyah and Beit Sahour, respectively after a Palestinian martyr and an occupied village near Jorusalem which was ree ently slapped with a 35-day Nazi-type time her Uneits efficiencies

The Abu Deyyah operation aimed at Jiba Zeet military camp in Upper Galilee while operation Beit Sahour simed at enemy posts in the Central and Northern Jordan Ghor.

Assifa Forces Shell Ford Assembly Plant, Blast Gaza Bridge

ASSIFA gocrillss of al-Patch shelled Dct.12 Ford's car assembly plant in occupied Narareth, cousing serious damage to the building. The attack was reminiscent of a minilar operation undertaken by ASS-IFA commandos on Nov. 11, 1967.

Introv reports from Galilee admitted the itack saying barooks shells were fired at the ear assembly plant during the night. As usual the occupation authorities said the shells encode no casualities. They said the shells were fired from an improsized pat on a hilbide mert the plant. No other shells, they claimed, were discverted on the lamehers.

Israeli occupation authorities said the barooka shells were "Marricam-made which and been prepared for firing with Israeau patteries made locally." They ndmitted that shells landed inside the parimeter of the plant.

Also on Oct. 12, ASSIFA men blow up in Gata an enemy bridge just as a train was passing over it, causing several wagons to fall off track. Enemy casualties are undetermined but high.

Several enemy settlements and posts in the Jordan Volley and south of Mt. Hermon were also mortared or rocketed by ASSIFA commandos during the same day.

Octomer 12 was a typical day for the MSERE guerillas of al-Fatch, whose operations against the eveny daily cover most if not all of the occupied areas extending from the Upper Galice down to Mazareth and the Jordan Volley and down to

The Israeli paper "Maretz" wrote on Oct 7: "The number of commandes apprehended in the past month is not satisfactory, and the explosion in Affula proves that it is necessary to improve the situation.
