

FORCES OF THE PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY DHOFAR REGION

FROM MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 76 to 92/73

The forces of the People's Liberation Army and People's Militia Launched during the second week offebruary 28 operations and attacks on the enemy camps andcentresin difficent areas of the outher Region of Oman (Phofar) eighten of which were on enemy positions in North Sarfeet intheWestern Regioninwhich different weapons were used (mortars, medium machine-guns and rocket launchers). The artillery of our revolutionaries throughout the week wereimposing a seige onthe enemy airport in these positions which is used for the enemy cupply planes. Our revolutionaries shell the airport whnever there is a bid for landing. This compelled the enemy to seek the help of fighter planes to open the seige but invain the fighter planes were intercepted by our artillery atSallalah plams. Our revolutionaries also planted a mine on the road linking between Om al-Fuwareq infantry base and ql-Fog camp. The mine led to the destruction of a Bedford vehicle. In the East in particular the militants waged a number of successful battles with the enemy forces. At the same time the enemy artillery shelled heavily the villages of citizens and places of their gatherings. The following is a comprehensive report on these operations:-

WESTERN REGION:

Since the 10th of February upto 16th February, our revolutionaries launched eighteen successful attack onthe enemy positions in North Sarfeet. On 10th February our forces shelled the enemy positions for three times throughout the day and our artillery continued to open fire on the airport on any attempt at landing by his supply planes. This compelled the enemy to seek thehelp of fighter planes to break the seige but these planes were intercepted by our defences. The clash resulted in one of the planes being directly hit and later escaped ablaze.

Our casualties were the injury of two of our comrades slightly.

On 11thFebruary, the day which coincided with Martyrs Day inthe People's DemocraticRepublic of Yemen, our forces launched three attacks on these positions. The attacks were named after the martyrs of the revolution of 14th October. During these attacksour forces used all weapons. The enemy suffered heavy losses inlife and equipment. On 14th October our forces launched four attacks in which artillery was used to hit the enemy positions. These attacks were namedafter Martyr Ahmed All Assaita. The attack resulted inthe destruction of a number of enemy positions and fire continued to rage in them for four hours. In addition to the other attacks, the sniping group continued throughout the week to snipe the enemy members. The

snipers lilled and injured a number of enemy individuals.

HIGH PRICES, AND THE INTEREST OF GOVERNMENT AND MERCHANTS

A report published by "5th March" bulletin, organ of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf, Bahrain Region, in its third issue of January, 1973, stated that "under the curtain of complete silence spread by the authority, prices soar up again in a frightening manner that it is impossible for the poor citizen to obtain essential stuff for daily life because of the reduction of salaries. Working masses find double oppression from the companies which enslave the work, and from the commercial authority.

One of the local politicians in Bahrain, who represents the government, cannot of course, raise his voice to link between the daily fact lived by the citizen and between what the ruling authority is planning in the Constituent Council. He cannot say that the economic interests of the merchants are not separated from the market or the council.

HELSINKI:

WORLD PEACE COUNCIL URGES UNITED NATIONS TO INTERFERE TO SAVE THE LIVES OF DETAINEES INMUSCAT AND ABUDHABI

The World PeaceCouncil sent the following message to the Chairman of the current session of the International Security Council and the U.N. Secretary General: "The World Peace Council expresses resentment over the wishful arrests and extensive chases in the Sultanate of Oman and the Federation of Amirates.

"More than 300 citizens have been arrested and are given avery brutal treatment. We urge the United Nations to interfere to save their lives and to realise their release and ensure respect of the fundamental human rights."

SOUTHERN REGION OF OMAN "DHOFAR"

The Radio of the puppet authority in Sallalah admitted the injury of 28 enemy members including three British, in a battle which took place between the forcesof the People's Liberation Army and the enemy forces at Kudbeet in the north of theWesternRegion on and the enemy forces at Kudbeet in the north of theWesternRegion on 6th February after the attempt made by the enemy forces to make urgent air landings and infiltration from the north direction to station at Kudbeet. Our forces issued a military communique bearing the number 68 saying that the forces of the liberation army cordoned the enemy forces atKudbeet on the morning of the following day after enemy landings. Hot battles ensued during which our forces managed to ransack the enemy hideouts and clear them.

The enemy forces escaped leaving behind a large number of military equipment, foodstuffs and tools for digging trenches.

The enemy admitted 28 injuries.

DEMOCRACY OF INTELLIGENCE

Last month (January) a number of youth tried to return to their country, Bahrain, from abroad, but they were prevented by the intelligence from doing so after their arrival at Bahrain airport and sent them back without any legal justification for that. These youth are:-

- 1) Mohammad Assayed Youssef,
- 2) Ibrahim Daito,
- 3) Dr. Abdul Rehman Khalifa and his wife doctor.

This happened in spite of the fact that there is a provision in the constitution providing that the citizen has the right to enjoy the freedom of traveland to carry a passport.

So how this provision can conform with what is being practiced by the ruling authority against the people. What is the position of the deputies who claim to represent the people in the council in front such acts.

BEIRUT: JOINT ARAB FRONT OF PALESTINE REVOLUTION CONDEMNS SUBMISSIVE PROJECTS AND CALL FOR STOPPAGE OF DEALINGS WITH PUPPET JORDANIAN REGIME

The Joint ArabFront of the Palestine evolutionissued a statement in which it revealed the attempts taking place at present to pass American liquidatory projects, and condemned the role of Jordan in this respect. It said that the recent visit by King Hussein to Washington, was one of the significant signs on this road. The visit was preceded by King Hussein's refusal to allow the Palestinian resistance to return to Jordan. The arab front colled for stoppage of dealing with the puppet regime of amman and stressed effective combative cohesion with the Palestine revolution and adherance to its full right to wage all forms of struggle for the sake of liberation.

CENTRAL REGION:

In the CentralRegion the forcesof the People's LiberationArmy and People's Militia launched on1th February (MartyrsDay in Democratic Yemen) three sniping operations which were successful on the enemy centres at Kushm in the Central Region. The following day our revolutionaries attacked the same centre with light weapons reinforced by mortars. During these operations the enemy lost many of his members and positions.

On 13thFebruary a land-mine (anti-tank) exploded under an enemy vehicle of the Bedford type on the road between Om al-Fawareq and al-Fog camp atSallalah Plain leading to the destruction of the vehicle with its occupants. On 14th February our artillery shelled al-Ma'amoorah c.ntre in Sallalah Plain for half an hour. A number of enemy positions were destroyed.

EASTERN REGION: 1004 Miles and hand all fadd and to be a feet

On the same week our revolutionaries planted a network of antipersonnel mines for the enemy forces at Yur and Shurkh. The mines exploded on a group of enemy individuals. This was admitted by the authority Radio atSallalah which said that three including a British officer were killed at Yur andShurkh, three other shoulders injured and one British officer waskilled. On the 8th of Eebruary, the forces of the People's Liberation army and the People's Pilitia launched an attack in which different weapons were used on the enemy centres atAshurkh for four hours during which the enemy used aircreft to check off the attack. After the attack helicopters of the enemy were seculanding on the enemy positions to remove the killed and injured.

On 11th Febru ry our comrades attacked the same position with morters and machine-guns. Two enemy psoitions were destroyed and a number of enemy members were injured. As a result of the successful blows by our revoltionaries on the enemy, the colonialist enemy as usual resorted to retaliate from the peaceful citizens. His heavy artillery at Khoisal centre shelled on 14th and 15th February the citizens in neighbouring areas. This resulted in the martyrdom of child Suhail Masood, the injury of female fitizen fialloot and the extermination of animals. In the east of theRed Line, some enemy individuals infiltrated into the houses of citizens to torture them and break the determinationand steadfastness enjoyed by these citizens in the rural areas. They beat citizen Suhail Saced Bakoob with their rifles. He was severely beaten on the head andbody. They also killed a collection of animals of the citizens without any reason. The following are the total losses of the onemy in different areas:

- 1)Death and injury of 34 enemy members including two British officers
- 2) Fighter plane directly hit
- 3) Destruction of eighteen positions and silencing of machine-gun post
 - 4) Destruction of Bedford vehicle with its occupants.

Our losses included the injury of two comrades slightly and the martyrdom of child Suhail Mascod as well as the injury of female citizen Hallot Mohammad and the extermination of a number of animals of the citizens.

POLITICAL COMMENTARY

LET THE PEACE AND FREEDOM-LOVING FORCES STAND IN THE FACE OF FLAGRANT VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN OMAN

The conditions of the political detainess in Oman call for great anxiety by all peace and freedom-loving national and progressive forces in this world, while their lives are threatened with danger as a result of the barbaric and savage torture methods followed by the Jordanian and British intelligence.

During the past few weeks many of the international and Arab federations and organisations expressed resentment over the violattinn of freedoms inOman and asked for immediate interference to save the lives of hundreds of citizens in prisons in Muscat andAbuDhabi.

Last week, the colonialist authorities released Juna'ah Annumai after spendingtwo years in prison without any charge and without being forwarded to triel. He revealed through the signs of torture appearing on him, the brutal methods followed by the Jordanian and "ritish intilligence during interrogation with him and other detainees beginning from nail-pulling, hair-pulling, torture by electricity and harsh beating and ending with individual imprisonment, psychological torture and iron clads and not allowing the detainees to appoint lawyers to defend them and not to forward any of them to trial and to continue to keep them in prison for long periods. These brutal methods surpass the stages of torture followed by Saeedhin Taimour while treating prisoners as he was throwing the citizens in dreadful prisons without giving them any attention.

If it is the duty of the freedom and justice-loving forces to resent such a clear barbaric wave of violating the simplest human rights in Oman, then a progressive positive step is needed to defend the political freedoms violated by the puppet Qaboos rule.

.llpopular corporations in the .rabhomeland and the world are required to throw their weight on the battle of freedom and justice in our homeland and to resent such brutal campaigns against our people.

If yesterday we stood in the Beirut conference to declare that the battle of liberationin Omen and the irabian Gulf is a basic tribunal of the tribunals of the progressive irab revolution and pointed out the nature of the dialectic link between the Palestinian revolution and the revolution in Oman and the irabian Tulf, we ask that all friends must realise that the Jordanian executionists who violate the prestige and dignity of the Palestinian people; are violating and outraging in a greater manner the prestige and dignity of the patriotic people of Oman.

If the Jordanians are exercising their traditional torture to safeguard the throne of their master in Oman, they are now exercising their ugly torture in Oman in order to establish their British masters and to show them their skill as well as to loot the wealths of the Omani people in order to consolidate the regime of Hussein and to hit the Jordanian Palestinian people.

We made it clear that the battle of freedom and democracy is a fundamental part of the battle of heab national democratic liberation and that all progressive and national forces are required to stand as one row when freedoms are violated in any heab country, in order to prove our ability to interpret the resolutions adopted by us and to give the people their true meaning.

In front of a series of imperialist attacks on the Arab revolution all over the Arab homelend, we ask all national and democratic forces to rally around an actual battle arena in order order to make the attacks of the imperialists in other areas as mere attacks on advanced positions defending a major standing base. We ask that the forces of liberation and Arab progress give the battle of our people in the arena of oil the attention it deserves and to interfere with all their potentialities to defend the violated rights of our people in which the monies of Zaid and Saudi Arabia play a role to deface its broadlines in many positions.

deportees and is facing today not only the crimes of the British
and Jordanian intelligence but also an extensive extermination
war inDhofer. In spite of all this our people continue their
patriotic struggle with steadfastness emanating from firm conviction
to defend their homeland and legitimate and just rights. The lines
of friends and freedom-loving people who stend by our side increase
and we view them with pride and great admiration.

KUWAIT

OIL COMPANIES PAY TWO MILLIONS FOR PASSAGE OF AGREEMENTS IN KUWAITI NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

Rightisti newspapers began to reveal the nature of methods followed by the oil companies to effect the passage of partnership agreement to ensure continuation of looting the oil wealths in the Arabian Feninsula.

Annahar newspaper of Beirut published a report by its correspondent in Kuwait saying that the oil companies have earnarked two million Kuwaiti dinars to make the position of the opposition lean.

It is worth recalling that the national and democratic forces in the Kuwaiti National Assembly managed to secure the attention of the public opinion in Kuwait when it revealed the conspiracies woven by imperialism of which the partnership agreement stand as a series.

The monopolistic companies use different methods including the regional andtribal feuds and the methods of bribing to sabotage the ranks of the opposition and to create fictitious conflicts for the passage of the distorted agreement.

LIBY.N DELEG.TION RESENTS PRESENCE OF JORDANIAN OFFICERS IN THE SULTAN TE OF OMAN

Assiyasah newspeperof Kuwait published a report saying that the Libyan delegation which visited the "ultrante of Coman and which was headed by Major Hamed Belkacem, resented the presence of great numbers of Jordanian officers and soldiers who are taking part in the fighting against the revolution. The newspaper said that it is probable that the delegation had returned disappointed after getting acquainted with the real situation in the Sultanate. This came opposite to what was expected by the Sultanate that he would be able to hide the reality of the revolution in Oman and to bypass facts.
