POPULAR FRONT FOR LIBERATION OF OCCUPIED ARABIAN GULF SUBMITS MEMORANDUM TO ARAB LEAGUE ON BROAD FRONT

THE POPULARFRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF THE OCCUPIED ARABIAN GULF SUBMITTED A MEMORANDUM TO THE ARAB LEAGUE DURING ITS SESSION HELD LAST MAINTH ON THE REQUEST BY THE PUPPET SULTANATE FOR MEMBERSHIF IN THE ARAB LEAGUE, IN THIS MEMORANDUM IT REVEALED IN THE SULTANATE THIS MEMORANDUM AND THE FIRM STRAND OF DEMOCRATIC YEARS HAVE HAVE HAD ARRESTED FOR THE PUPPETSULTANATE AND A DECISION WAS TAKEN TO THE EFFECT THAT THE SECRETARY GENERAL OR ANY ONE ON HIS BEHALF IS TO VISIT THE SECRETARY GENERAL OR ANY ONE ON HIS BEHALF IS TO VISIT THE SULTANATE TO KNOW THE REAL STATUS THERE AND THE REVOLUTIONARY SITUATION IN THE LIBERATED AREAS. BUT THIS DECISION WAS NOT MEMPERAMED TO THE NEW OWN OF THE REAL STATUS THERE AND

BAHRAIN AND THE PUPPET SULTANATE IN OWAN AND OTHER WEAK ENTITIES COME FORWARD WITH REQUESTS FOR MEMBERSHIP INTO THE ARAB LEAGUE. THE POPULAR FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF THE OCCUPIED ÁRABIAN GOLF FORWARDED ANOTHER MEMORANDOM IN WHICH IT ASKED THE ARAB LEAGUE TO SHOULDER ITS RESPONSIBILITIES IN FULL TOWARDS THE SITUATION IN THE ARAB OF OMAN AND THE ARABIAN GULF AND CALLED UPON THEARAB "EAGUE ONCE AGAIN TO VISIT THE LIBERATED AREAS. THE FOLLOWING IS THE FULL TEXT OF THE MEMORANDOM!

AFTER REVOLUTIONARY COMPLIMENTS,

SUBJECT: REQUESTS BY BAHRAIN AND SULTANATE OF OMAN TO JOIN ARAB LEAGUE MEMBERSHIP

SINCE BRITISH COLONIALISM STARTED TO CONTROL OUR COUNTRY, IT WAS EXERCISING THE UGLIEST METHODS OF OPPRESSION AND ATROCIOUS PRIMES AND LOOTING AND ROBING THE WEALTHS AND PLENTIFULNESS OF OUR COUNTRY!

PARTITION OF OUR COUNTRY BY BRITISH COLONIALISM AND ITS TRANS-FORMATION INTO GROUPS OF WEAK ENTITIES (STATES AND SULTANATES), AND THE TIGHTENING OF COLONIALIST INFLUENCE ON THESE ENTITIES THROUGH BROAD AND EXTENSIVE MILITARY BASES SCATTERED ALL OVER OUR HOMELAND IN ADDITION TO MEAN AND STUPID TREATIES CONCLUDED BETWEEN THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE AMENS AND SHEINHS OF THESE ENTITIES, TURNED OVER COUNTRY INTO A BIG FIELD FOR LOOTING AND ROBING THE WEALTHS OF OUR FEOPLE AND A DEN FOR WEAVING MEAN CONSPIRACIES TO OBSTRUCT THE ADVANCEMENT OF THE SCCIETY AND TO ENABLE IT SECURE FREEDOM AND INDEPENDENCE.

A GENTURY AND A HALF OF COLONIALIST OCCUPATION OF OUR COUNTRY AND EXERCISE OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF CRIMES AGAINST OUR FEOPLE, AND THE DROWNING OF PEOPLE IN THE DEPTHS OF BLLITERACY, POVERTY AND DISEASE, NECESSARILY OREATED HATRED IN OUR FEOPLE FOR RRITISH COLONIALISM AND ITS PUPPET SHEIKHS, AMIRS ANDSULTANS, IT ALSO MADE OUR PEOPLE CARRY THE ARMS IN NUMEROUS INTERVALS SINCE COLONIALIST COCUPATION. TO THE SIST WITH PATRIOTISM COLONIALIST INFLUENCE OVER OUR COUNTRY AND TO LIBERATE THE HOMELAND FROM FOREIGN OCCUPATION.

THE APPEARANCE OF THE REVOLUTION OF 9TH JUNE, 1965 IN THE SOUTHERN PART OF OMAN AND THE DECLARATION OF THE ARMED STRUGGLE AGAINST ALL FORMS OF COLONIALIST AND PUPPET EXISTENCE WAS A CONTINUATION OF THE LONG AND STRENUOUS STRUGGLES WAGED BY OUR PEOPLE WITH PATRICITISM, THE PREVIOUS STRUGGLES OF OUR PEOPLE WERE GREAT LESSONS OBTAINED BY THEM THROUGH THEIR LIVE EXPERIMENTS. ALL THESE LESSONS MELTED IN ONE BASIN TO CREATE A NEW AND RIPE EXPERIMENT FORMING THE START OF THE FIRST STREAK OF THE BULLET IN 9TH JUNE, 1965 OVER THE PEAKS OF DHOPER MOUNTAINS.

TODAY, ATTHE END OF 1971, THE YEAR OF HOT EVENTS BETWEEN THE FORCES OF OPPRESSION AND EVIL ON ONE HAND AND THE FREEDOM-LOVING FORCES ON THE OTHER, AND AFFER THE GREATNESS OF THE REVOLUTION AND ITS HEIGHTENING GROWTH INDREASED TO SECURE FOR IT THE SUPPORT OF THE MASSES AND TO HELP IT LIBERATE MORE THAN NINETY PERCENT OF THE MOPPAR RURALS (SOUTHERN AREA OF OMAN) THE FIERCENESS OF THE MALICIOUS IMPERIALIST FLANS AND ITS MEAN ATTEMPTS INCREASED TO RE-ARRANGE ITS DIG INTERESTS THROUGH A NEW FORM OF COLONIALISM (NEO-COLONIALISM) AND PUPPET WEAK AND LOSSE ENTITIES AS POLITICAL FRONTAGES HELPING IN REPRESSION THE NATIONAL LIBERATION MOWEMENT AND THE STRUGGLES OF THE POOR MASSES AND ENSURING THE CONTINUATION OF LOOTING AND ROUTH THE POPPLE.

THE COLONIALIST PARTITION OF OUR COUNTRY, NOW REPRESENTED IN THE PARTITION OF OWAN INTO TWO PARTS - THE SULTANATE OF OMAN AND THE AWIRATES OF THE COAST OF OMAN (FEDERATION OF AMIRATES) - AND THE AWIRATES OF OTHER AREAS IN THE GULF INTO DIVIDED STATES AND THE GRANT OF FAKE AND LIQUIFIED INDEPENDENCE TO THESE ARTIFICIAL STATES AND THE ATTEMPT TO GIVE THE LEGAL SHAPE TO THESE ARTIFICIAL TRROUGH ODTAINING AREA AND INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR THEM TO QUALIFY THEM TO ENTER THE AREA "EAGUE AND THE UNITED NATIONS, ARE IN FACT AN OBJECTIVE EXPRESSION OF THE FEARS OF WORLD IMPERIALISM AND ITS REACTIONARY PUPPETS OVER THE HUGE AND VAST INTERESTS IN THIS AREA AND A REGULT OF THE GREATINESS AND INCREASE OF THE MOVEMENT OF THE MASSES AND GROWTH OF THE ARMED REVOLUTION AND ITS SPREAD TO PLACES WHERE OLIFICELDS EXIST.

ALL THESE IMPERIALIST AND REACTIONARY CONSPIRACIES, NO MATTER
THE FORM OF ÁRAB AND INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITIONS OF THESE ENTITIES,
ONLY MAKE OUR PEOPLE MORE DETERMINED TO CARRY MORE GUNS IN THE
FACE OF IMPERIALISM AND THE PUPPETS. THE DESTINY OF THE REVOLUTION
IS NEVER DECIDED IN THE GALLERIES OF ÁRAB AND INTERNATIONAL
ASSEMBLIES BUT IS DECIDED BY THE MILITANT MASSES, THEIR FIRM AND
ENLIGHTENED LEADERSHIPS AND THROUGH BITTER, STRENUOUS AND LONG
STRUGGLE.

THE LONG-TERM POPULAR WAR WAGED BY THE MASSES WILL AT THE END DECIDE THE FATE OF THE REVOLUTION AND ITS ENEMIES AND WILL CHANGE THE BALANCE OF THE ARAD AND INTERNATIONAL FORCES IN THE INTEREST OF THESE MILITANT MASSES.

THE NINTH MONTH OF 1971 IN WHICH THE SESSION OF THE ARAB LEAGUE BY BAHRAIN AND THEGULTANATEOF OMAN IN FRONT IT, THIS OCCASION PUSHED US TO NECESSARILY LOGG THIS MEMORANDUM (DETAILED MEMORANDA WERE SENT IN THE PAST ON THE ISSUE) TO CLEARLY EXPLAIN AND WITHOUT DOUGT THE EXTENT OF COLONIALIST INFLUENCE OVER OUR COUNTRY AND ITS MILITARY BASES IN IT, AND THE NON-AVILABILITY OF ANY OF THE CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION INTO THE ARAB EAGUE AS CALLED BY THE LEAGUE'S ROULES AND LAWS FOR MEMBERSHIP.

HERE WE MUST EXPLAIN ANEW THE NATURE OF COLONIALIST EXISTENCE AND THE NATURE OF THE PUPPET SULTANS IN OMAN THROUGH THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

THE SULTANATE OF OMAN:

- 4) THE SULTANATE OF OWAN IS LINKED WITH A NUMBER OF TREATIES WITH BRITAIN. THROUGH THESE TREATIES THE PEOPLE LOST THEIR NATIONAL SOMERICARY AND THEIR WEALTHS WERE OPEN TO LOCKING AND A GROUP OF MILITARY AGGRESSIVEDASES SCATTERED ON THEIR SOIL MAKING THEM LOSE THEIR FREEDOM AND INDEPENDENCE. THESE TREATIES AND AGREEMENTS ARE SILL IN PORCE UPTO NOW;-
 - 1798: THE DEFENCE AND OFFENSIVE TREATY BETWEEN MUSCAT AND THE BRITISH-OWNED INDIAN ORIENTAL COMPANY;
 - 1839: TRADE AND SHIPPING AGREEMENT BETWEEN BRITAIN AND MUSCAT;
 - 1845: SLAVERY AGREEMENT BETWEEN BRITAIN AND MUSCAT;
 - 1843: COMPROMISE RELEASED BY THE SULTAN OF MUSCAT IN WHICH HE ABDICATED THE OMANI ISLAND OF MURIA MURIA TO BRITAIN;
 - 1811: FRIENDSHIP, TRADE AND SHIPPING TREATY BETWEEN BRITAIN AND MUSCAT;
 - 1891: THE AGREEMENT CONNECTED WITH ABDICATION OF AREAS WHICH WAS CONCLUDED BY THE SULTAN OF OMAN ON 20TH MARCH, 1891 WITH BRITAIN.
 - 1902: A COMPROMISE BY THE SULTAN OF OMAN FOR THE BRITISH POLITICAL AGENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE OILFIELD AT SOOR;
 - 1923: THE SPECIAL UNDERTAKING MADE BY THE SULTAN OF MUSCAT FOR MONOPOLISATION OF OIL BY BRITAIN.
 - 1937: THE TRADE AND SHIPPING TREATY BETWEEN BRITAIN AND MUSCAT;
 - 1951: THE FRIENDSHIP, TRADE AND SHIPPING TREATY BETWEEN BRITAIN AND MUSCAT:
 - 1953: A FRIENDSHIP, TRADE AND SHIPPING TREATY WITH BRITAIN
 - 1958: EXCHANGE OF MESSAGES DETWEEN THE UNITED KINDOM AND THESULTAN OF MUSCAT ON THE SULTAN S AIR FORCE AND CIVIL AVIATION AND THE REINFORCEMENT OF THE BRITISH AIR FORCES IN OMAN;

 1958: AGREEMENT ON THE DASES OF SALLALAH AND MASIRAH AND LEASE
 - OF THESE TWO BASES TO BRITAIN FOR 99 YEARS.

 2) AS A RESULT OF THESE AGREEMENTS AND TREATIES BRITISH EXISTENCE
 - As a result of these agreements and treatles skilled earliere.
 Is now represented in the following matters:

 A) British influence (Folitical) on Oman is demonstrated through
 - A BRITISH IN-LUENCE (POLITICAL ON OMAIN TO BEHINDED IN THE POLITICAL REPRESENTATIVE IN OMAN AND THE ADVISORY BODY CONSISTED OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS:
 - * COLONEL HUGH OLDMAN, GENERAL INTELLIGENCE OFFICER AND ACTUAL DEFENCE MINISTER.
 - * MAJOR ABRAHAM, PRESENT COMMANDER OF THE ARMY.
 - * MAJOR DENISON, COMMANDER OF BEIT-AL-FALAG BASE AND INTELLIGENCE OFFICER.
 - * MAJOR LONDON, POLITICAL AND INTELLIGENCE OFFICER IN SALLALAH.

THEY ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL INTERNAL, EXTERNAL, POLITICAL, ECONOMIC AND MILITARY AFFAIRS TAKING OF THE PUPPET SULTANS : AS POLITICAL FRONTAGES FOR THEM.

- B) EXISTENCE OF BRITISH BASES SCATTERED ON OMANI TERRITORIES AS FOLLOWS:-
- MASIRAH AIR AND NAVAL BASE IN WHICH SQUADRONS OF BRITISH AIRCRAFT STAY. THIS BASE IS USED TO SUPPLY BRITISH SUBMARINES AND VESSELS OPERATING IN THE INDIAN OCEAN WITH NUCLEAR FUEL;
- 2) SALLALAH AIR BASE FOR BRITISH R.A.F.
- 3) ADDUQM INFANTRY BASE NEAR MASIRAH ISLAND;
- 4) OM AL-GHAWAREF ANFANTRY BASE NEAR SALLALAH;
- 5) BEIT AL-FALAG AIR AND INFANTRY BASE IN MUSCAT;
- 6) NIZWA BASE;
- 7) ABRI BASE;
- 8) BUDBUD BASE;
- 9) RAS AL-HADD BASE
- 10) MILITARY AIRCIELDS FOR BRITISH ARMY IN THE FOLLOWING PLACES: -QALIYAH, KHUBABAH, ABRI, NIZWA, JEBEL AL-FUHOOD, THAMREET, MORDAT AND HEBROOT.
- 11) POSTS FOR BRITISH ARMY IN MANY AREAS OF OMAN.
 - c) Monopoly of Omani oil wealth by the British Shell Company at the rate of 85 per cent. The company supplies all military and Political activities hostile to the revolution and People.
 - D) STREAD OF HUNDREDS OF BRITISH OFFICERS IN COMMANDING MERCENARY OFFICERS AND ADMINISTERING ESPIGNAGE NETWORKS AGAINST THE FEOPLE AND REVOLUTION.

OMAN COAST (FEDERATION OF AMIRATES)

THE TREATY OF 1892 WHICH WAS CONCLUDED WITH ALL AMIRS OF THE COAST OF OMAN CALLS FOR GRANTING BRITAIN COMPLETE INFLUENCE AND CONTROL OVER THE POLITICAL, ECONOMIC AND MILITARY AFFAIRS IN ALL AMIRATES, AND ABOLITION OF THE FREEDOM OF POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC DEALS BY THE AMIRA WITH ANY STREED OWN AFFER REVERTING TO BRITAIN.

AS A RESULT OF THESE TREATIES COLONIALIST PRESENCE IS REPRESENTED IN THE FOLLOWING MATTERS:-

- 1) POLITICAL INFLUENCE REPRESENTED IN THE PRESENCE OF THE BRITISH POLITICAL RESIDENT AND BRITISH ADVISERS IN EVERY AMIRATE WITH THEIR TASKS INCLUDE INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL AFFAIRS;
 - 2) MILITARY PRESENCE IS REPRESENTED IN THE FOLLOWING BASESE
 - A) SHARJAH AIR BASE;
 - B) MANAMAH INFANTRY BASE.
 - ESTABLISHMENT OF ESPIONAGE NETWORKS HEADED BY BRITISH OFFICERS WITH THE TASKS OF FOLLOWING THE STRUGGLES OF THE POPULAR MASSES.
 - 4) ECONOMIC PRESENCE IS REPRESENTED IN PETROLEUM, MONOPOLISTIC ""AND OTHER COMMERCIAL COMPANIES FOR CAPITALIST INVESTMENT, EXPLOITATION AND LOOTING OF NATIONAL WEALTHS.

AMIRATE OF BAHRAIN

A FRIENDSHIP TREATY DATED 15THAUGUST, 1971 INSTEAD OF THE 1892 TREATY. THIS LINKS BHRAIN IN CLOSER RELATIONS AND CONTINUED CONSULTATIONS WITH BRITAIN.

BRITISH AND AMERICAN AIR AND NAVAL BASES STILL EXIST IN ... BAHRAINI AREAS AS FOLLOWS:-

AL-MUHARRAQ, AL-JAFEIR, AND AL-HAMLAH.

THE TREATIES AND BASES MENTIONED IN THIS MEMORANDOM ARE ENOUGHT TO STAND AS A STRONG EVIDENCE ON THE EXTENT OF DIRECT IMPERIALIST INFILTRATION AND INFLUENCE ON THE TOTAL MILLITARY AND ECONOMIC SITUATION IN OUR COUNTRY. THE GUESTION NOW IS HOW THE LAWS OF THE ARAB LEAGUE PERTAINING TO MEMBERSHIP IN IT COMPORM WITH THESE TREATIES AND BASES WHICH STILL EXIST UNDER THE TITLE OF "PRIENDSHIP TREATIES". YOUR REALISE WITHOUT DOUBT WHAT THESE BASES REPRESENT, WHAT ARE THEIR TASKS AND HOW BRITISH AIRCRAFT TAKE OFF FROM BASES SPECIALLY IN SALLALAH TO DROP INCENDIARY AND DESTRUCTIVE BOMBS ON OUR PEOPLE.

THE TREATIES WHICH BRITAIN CALLS FRIENDSHIP TREATIES MEAN CONTINUATION OF MILITARY BASES AND MILITARY INTERFERENCE AND CONTINUATION OF LOOTING AND ROBING THE PLENTIFULNESS AND WEALTHS OF OUR COUNTRY WHATEVER IMPERIALISM TRIED TO HIDE THE TYPE OF THESE TREATIES AND BASES.

WE, WHILE NOLDING YOU HISTORICALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY NEGLIGENCE FROM YOUR SIDE TO THE ISSUE OF THE STRUGGLE OF OUR PEOPLE AND NATURE OF THE IMPERIAL IST PLANS WHICH ARE WEAVED AGAINST THEM, REAFFIRM THAT WE ARE CAPABLE OF TOPPLING DOWN THESE WEAK ENTITIES AND EXPELLING THEIR COLONIALIST MASTERS FROM OUR COUNTRY THROUGH THE LONG-TERM POPULAR WAS

IN CONCLUSION WE INVITE TO VISIT THE LIBERATED AREA TO SEE FOR YOURSELF THE CONTROL OF THE REVOLUTION ON THE LIBERATED AREAS AND THE NATURE OF THE ATROCIOUS AND FILTHY WAR LAUNCHED BY THE BRITISH FORCES AND MERCENARY ARMIES AGAINST OUR FEOTLE.

IN THE NAME OF OUR STRUGGLING PEOPLE WE REQUEST TO ABIDE BY THE LAWS OF THE ARAB LEAGUE AND TO PREVENT THESE PUPPET STATES (BAHRAIN AND THE SULTANATE OF (MAN) FROM ENTERING THEARAB LEAGUE.

THE EXECUTIVE COMMETTEE OF THE GENERAL COMMAND OF THE POPULAR FRONT FOR THE LIBERATION OF THE OCCUPIED ARABIAN GULF.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE No. 166 71.

ON 9TH JUNE, 1971, AT 8.00 A.M. A GROUP OF ARTILLERY FORCES FROM THE LENIN UNIT SHELLED WITH CONDENTRATION THE ENEMY GATHERINGS AT THE TOWN OF MONBAC, FOR FIFTEEN MINUTES. ON THE SAME DAY-AT 11.30 AT NOON OUR ARTILLERY SHELLED CONCENTRATIVELY THE ENEMY GATHERINGS AND POSITIONS IN THE SAME TOWN. THE ENEMY POSITIONS WERE DIRECTLY HIT AND ENEMY CASUALTIES WERENOW KNOWN. OUR FORCES RETURNED SAFELY TO BASE.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE No. 167/71.

On the Night of 12th July, 1971, a group of Enemy Forces Tried to Infiltrate into the Area of Kudalbet in the Western Region But the People's Liberation anny was watching their Movement. The army opened the Way For them to advance into the areas marked by the Liberation army. On armival of the adgressive forces in the Regulato Place, our grave men surraised them with fire from their Light and Medium weapons from these directions. The Battle Continued For two Bours During which the Enemy incorred the Following Desses

- DEATH AND INJURY OF 20 MERCENARY SOLDIERS:
- * DESTRUCTION OF A MACHINE-GUN (MEDIUM) POSITION
- * DESTRUCTION OF AN ENEMY MEDIUM ARTILLERYL

AT 1.30 IN THE AFTERNOON OF THE SAME DAY A GROUP FROM THE PEOPLE'S LIGERATION ARMY LAUNCHED AN ATTACK ON GROUPS OF EMENY SOLDIERS STATIONED NEAR KADIECT CENTRE, THE DATTLE CONTINUED FOR ONE COMPLETE HOUR DURING WHICH OUR FORCES USED DIFFERENT WEAPONS. AS A RESULT OF THIS SUCCESSFUL ATTACK ENEMY CABUALTIES WERE AS FOLLOWS;

- . DEATH AND INJURY OF FIFTEEN MERCENARY SOLDIERS
- DEATH OF HIGH-RANKING BRITISH OFFICER
- * DESTRUCTION OF ENEMY ARTILLERY WITH ITS COUPLE.
- * DESTRUCTION OF WIRELESS SET OF THE 165 MODEL.

AT 5.00 P.M. ON THE SAME DAY AN ATTILLERY UNIT FROM THE PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY SHELLED WITH CONCENTRATION THE ENEMY FORCES PLEEING FROM THE BATTLE. THE ENEMY FORCES WITHDREW FROM THEBATTLE CARRYING WITH THEM THEM DEAD AND INJURED MEMBERS AND THE SIGNS OF DEFEAT AND SHAME.

OUR FORCES RETURNED SAFELY TO BASE.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 168/71

ON 8TH JUNE, 1971, AT TWELVE NOON OUR HEAVY ARTILLERY SHELLED SALLALAH AIR CASE WHEN THE OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS WERE ENTERING THE MESS FOR TAKING THEIR MEALS. THIS RESULTED IN THE FOLLOWING.

- DEATH OF 2 OFFICERS AND 2 SOLDIERS AND INJURY OF A NUMBER OF ENEMY SOLDIERS.
- DESTRUCTION OF A NUMBER OF PROPELLERS AND BURNING OF MANY ENEMY TENTS.

AT 11.00 F.M. ON HE SAME DAY, A GROUP OF LIBERATION ARMY FORCES LAUNCHED A FIERCE ATTACK ON THE ENERY CENTRE AT THE TOWN OF AWGED AND THE AIR DASE AT SALLALAH AS PART OF THE COORDINATION BETWEEN ALL MILITARY UNITS. OUR FORCES USED HEAVY ANTILLERY IN THIS ATTACK WHICH CONTINUED FOR THIRTY MINUTES, THE ENEMY LOSE THREE DEAD AND THREE INJURED. THE ENEMY ADMITTED TWO KILLED AND THREE INJURED, OUR FORCES RETURNED TO DASE SAFELY-CARRYING THE FLAG OF VICTORY.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE No. 169/71:

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE No. 173/71 . .

AFTER MORE THAN ONE YEAR OVER THE GABOOS RULE, THE PUPPET INFORMATION MINISTER REPEATS THE SAME REASONS REPATED BY TARGE BIN TAIMOUR ONE YEAR DEFONE THE INDEPENDENCE OF DMAN AND THE REASONS THAT MADE THE SULTANATE REJECT AND REFUSE TO EMPLOY THE ORANIA.

AT HIS PRESS CONFEIENCE WHICH WAS HELD ON 25TH JULY, 1971, TAI SAID THAT THE COUNTRY NEEDS WORKING HANDS, DUT THE OMANIS DO NOT WANT TO WORK IN BUILDING PROJECTS AND THE COUNTRY IS NOT PIT FOR THE AUMY DUE TO HEALTH REASONS. WE DISTRIBUTED NOT PIT FOR THE AUMY DUE TO HEALTH REASONS. WE DISTRIBUTED THE CHILD PAPERS TO THE QUANIS ABROAD AND ASKED THEM NOT TO COME UNTIL WE PAVE ROR THEM THE RESIDENCE AND SHELTER. AS TO THECHELL COMPANY, IT SENT ENVOYS TO ENROLL THE QUANNS IN HER REMOUVEMENT BUT IT TOLD THEM THE OMANIS THAT IT WILL OALL THEM IN FUTURE AS SOON POSSIBLE. HE FORGOT TO SPEAK ABOUT THE EPIDEMICS SPREADING IN JAALAN EAST IN PARTICULAR THE CHOLERA EPIDEMIC AND WHY THE AUTHORITIES REFUSED TO RECEIVE THE DRUGS FROM ABROAD BECAUSE THE CITIZENS ARE DISSIDENTS.

THE PUPPET RULE DID NOT ACHIEVE SUCCESS AT ARAB AND INTERNATIONAL LEVELS AS THE ARAB COUNTRIES REFUSE TO RECONISE THIS REGIME AND COLONIALIST TERRITORY AND REFUSE TO BRING INTO THE ARAB LEAGUE. IT REPEATEDLY ASKED THIS REGIME TO SUBMIT AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT EXPLAINING ITS RELATIONS WITH BRITAIN. THE ARAB LEAGUE ALSO TRIED TO SEND A DELEGATION ON A FACT-FINDING MISSION BUT THE QADOOS REGIME REFUSED AS DID THE RULE OF SAEED BIN TAIMON BEFORE.

THE ARAB AND FOREIGN COUNTRIES (EXCLUDING THE IMPERIALIST COUNTRIES) DISCOVERED THE FALSEHOOD OF THE CLAIMS CIRCULATED BY THE REGIME ABOUT INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY. REPORTS FROM MUSCAT STATED THAT THE BRITISH OCCUPY ALL IMPORTANT POSITIONS AND CONTROL EVERY SMALL AND BIG THINKS LEAVE ALONE THE MILITARY. BASES WHICH THREATEN THE PEACE AND SECURITY OF THE ÁRAB COUNTRIES.

AT A TIME IN WHICH THIS PUPPET REGIME COME TO THE NUDE AND THE KEX LAST CARD WITH WHICH IT IS COVERING ITSELF FALLS, THE REVOLUTIONARY MASSES JUMP FROM VICTORY TO VICTORY AND REALISE WITH THEIR WILL THE CHERISH FREEDOM AND PROCRESS. THE WASSES IN THE LIDERATED AREAS ELECT THEIR LEADERSHIPS AND PEOPLE'S COUNCILS AND THE WHOLE CITIZENS, IN SHITE OF THEIR ILL-HBALTH, CARRY THE ARMS AND DEFEND THEIR LAND WHILE THE HONEST AND NATIONALIST ELEMENTS JOIN THE LIBERATION XRMY FROM THE SULTAWATE ARMY DAILY TO ENJOY FREEDOM, EQUALITY, PRESTIGE AND DIGITY.

IN THE FACE OF ALL THESE VICTORIES THE POPULAR FRONT LAID DOWN ITS NATIONAL DEMOGRATIC PROGRAMME FOR THE ENTIRE PEOPLE INCLUDING WORKERS, FEASANTS, INTELLECTUALS AND ALL SECTI-MS OF THE PEOPLE, FOR REALISING MORE VICTORIES FOR THE PEOPLE AND EXPELLING THE BRITISH AGGRESSORS AND THEIR FEUDALIST STOOGES OF TRIBAL FAMILIES, OUR PEOPLE ARE DETERMINED TO RECOVER THEIR RIGHTS AND ARE FULLY CONFIDENT OF WINNING VICTORY.
