MILITARY COMMUNIQUE

From Military Communique tNo. 444/72 to 460172

On 23rd September the enemy carried out a landing operation for his air-lifted forces by helicopters, in Aram highlands in the Eastern Region of Dhofar.

The forces of the People's Liberation Army confronted the air-lifted enemy forces in a hot battle during which they brought down anenemy helicopter.

Throughout the three days (23,24 and 25th Sept.) our forces were involved in fierce clashes with the enemy forces in the Aram highlands where our forces were attacking the enemy positions continuously and hitting any movement being made by him.

During this operation the enemy forces suffered heavy losses. Our losses were the martyrdom of a Comrade. He was Martyr Awadh Naseeb.

It is to be recalled that the Eritish enemy and his stooges launched at the beginning of October of last year a huge campaign against the Eastern Region (October/November Campaign) during which he used the British com ando division and Strike Master aircraft and huge crowds of mercenaries and local stooges. But our masses confronted the campaign and pushed it away. Now the enemy is repeating the start of a new move on the Eastern Region at the end of the rainy season directly. These movements areonly the start of a comprehensive plan. It will be noticed that this is taking place at a time in which the enemy forces supported by Saudi reaction are carrying out their distorted moves against the Feople's Democratic Republic of Yemen.

At the same day in which the air landing took place in Aram, three of our comrades where carrying out their revolutionary missions in the north of the EasternRegion (Geilab) and fell in an enemy trap but they fought until the lost shot was fired from their guns. They were injured and two of them were captured as a result of their serious injuries. These include Ahmed Salem and Mohammad Sandeed. As to the third comrade he was able to reach other comrades after sustaining light injuries.

In the Central Region, the forces of the People's Liberation Army attacked during 23rd, 24th and 25th September the enemy centre at Char situated in the north of the town of Awyad and Ardeet Qawn centre to the north-west of Rasyout port and other centres to the west of the town of Augad in the Sallalah Plain. The enemy suffered heavy losses in life and positions during these operations in which they used heavy and other weapons.

In the Western Region, our forces launched during the past six days (29th September to 2nd October), seventeen successful attacks on enemy centres in the north of Sarfeet during which the enemy suffered heavy lesses. During these attacks the forces of the People's Liberation Army used mortars and rocket launchers and other machine-guns.

The sniping group also launched several sniping operations against the enemy in his positions during this period. This group was in wait for the enemy and sniping his members during their movement. Totady enemy losses were as follows:-

- Eighty one between killed and wounded including a British officer.
- 2) Shooting down of a helicopter,
- 3) Destruction of fifteen positions and 81-mm artillery and a machine-gun.
- 4) There were four operations inwhich enemy losses were not assessed.

Our losses were as follows:-

- 1) Martyrdom of patriot Awadh Naseeb
- 2) Two injured comrades captured. They are Ahmed Salem and Mohammad Ahmed Sandeed and a third was slightly injured.

WORKERS OF GULF COMPANY IN BAHRAIN GO ON STRIKE

NUMBER OF WORKERS ARBESTED

FEDERATION OF KUWAITI WORKERS UNION ISSUES STATEMENT RESENTING A RRESTS

The GeneralFederation of Workers Unions in Kuwait, issued a statement in which it deplored the incident in which workers in Bahrain were arrested. The statement said that the puppet regime in Bahrain represses the workers movement at a time in which the importalist-reactionary and Zionist tide is increasing in the Arab homeland.

The statement said that the workers of the Gulf Company in Bahrein went on strike on 6th September demanding improvement of their living conditions and improvement and increase of their wages. The following day the police arrested a number of workers.

The statement added that another number of Bahraini workers are at present arrested in Bahrain prisons since the events of last March. The Union Federation in Kuwait asked the pupped Government of Bahrain which is the lackey of American imperialism to respect democratic freedoms and in particular the right to establish workers unions.

SEVENTEENTH CONFERENCE OF FEDERATION OF WORKERS UNIONS IN SYRIA GREETS OUR PEOPLE

Aden News Agency issued on 3rd October a report in which it said that the seventsenth conference of the Federation of Arab workers union in Damascus groeted the strug le of the Yemeni people and the struggle of the Arab people in the Arabian Gulf. It also greeted their steadfastness against Arab reaction, imperialism and Zionism.

This was announced by Fara Noman who represented the General Confederation of Democratic Yemeni Workers in the conference. In a speech delivered by him at the conference on behalf of the General Confederation he condemned the continued Zionist aggression on Arab territories and also explained the nature of the conspiracies and concentrations being continuously weaved against the Yemeni people and their revolution by Yemeni reaction and Saudi reaction which are backed by world imperialism and Zionism. He said that the armed struggle in Yemen and in prticular in Democratic Yemen is the same armed struggle now going on in Palestinian territories and occupiedArab territories in the Arabian Gulf which is simultaneousl directed against a common enemy.

ZAID DISCUSSES WITH BRITISH OFFICIALS SITUATION IN ARABIAN GULF

Officials in the British Govern ent announced that puppet Zaid bin Sultan, President of the so-called State of the Federation of Arab Amirates, paid a visit to Douglas Home, British Foreign Secretary. This is the second time in which Zaid visits Home during his visit to Britain. Both held talks on 13th September, 1972.

It is to be refalled that re-arrangement of the situations in the Arabian Peninsula area, Oman and the Arabian Gulf in a way conforming with the plans of importalism and its oil monopolies, the military aid that can be obtained by the so-called State of the Federation of Arab Amirates from Britain and settlement of problems outstanding between the Federation State and Saudi Arabia were the topics for discussion between Zaid and Home.

Zaid also met Heath, British Prime Minister, during this visit which continued for five weeks.

PEOPLE'S FRONT LODGES MEMORANDUM TO LEBANESE COMMITTEE-IN-SUPPORT OF REVOLUTION

The People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf lodged a memorandum to the brother kembers of the Lebances Committee in support of the revolution in Oman and the ArabianGulf and in Democratic Yemen.

After dealing with the historical melations tying the two peoples in Omanand the Arabian Gulf and Lebanon, the memorandum gave a clear picture on the stage lived by the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

The memorandum ended with affirming the importance of the role being played by the committee in strengthening and developing combative relations between the struggle of the people of Lebanon and the people of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

AMERICAN CORPORATIONS WITH ARAB NAMES

The Lebanese Destour newspaper published in its issue of 18th September, 1972, an article on the replacement of American ownership of Tapline, the pipe which pumps Saudi cil from fields in the eastern region to Syria and Jordan to be refined at Zahwani refinery in the Lebanese coast. We quote the following from this article:-

(It is understood by the Destour correspondent that an agreement was reached between the Saudi Government and TAPLINE. The new agreement provides that the Government of the Saudi Arabian Kingdom is to buy the full shares of the TAPLINE so that Saudi oil exported becomes hundred per cent Saudi oil).

"In other words this means that SaudiArabia will take over payment of oil revenues due from oil passing the threeArab territories. It will also pay the revenues for refining in Lebanon. By this Saudi Arabia will become master over these countries and in other words will have stronger influence on the policies of these countries.

"The other shape of this has also another meaning. It is that this agreement between the Saudi Government and Tapline will mean that any attempt to blast the TAPLINE pipeline will be construed, if it happened in future, as a blow to Saudi interests and not American interests".

Our comment on this report is that the serpent American monopolies are prepared to change colour in order to evade any source threatening their existence.

When the TAPLINE company felt the danger is approaching against its interests it resorted to this step particularly when the pipeline was subject to blasting on more one occasion. Moreover demands by countries inwhich the line is passing for rights leads to reduction of vast profits obtained by those monopolies.

From here Saudi Arabia is at present realising the objectives of imperialism in return for the commission received by this idolist regime from those companies.

MESSAGE FROM A CITIZEN

"Voice of the Revolution' Programme which is being supervised by the Aden Office of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the ArabianGulf, received amessage from citizen Ali bin Hussein from North Oman under the title "The United State of Shame and Injustice".

The message said:"From the first day of the birth of the colonialist Federation, this ederation brought shame for us as this federation on its first day of bth maxupicatixing fram occupied the three Omani islands. Since its first day our people were suffering daily more repression and opression from this State which is protected by the spears of Fitain. Let it be known to you that the British will not withdraw from this country. In the Sharjah air base, there exists a British division still stationed there and estimated ato hold their families. The British are working to hide their presence in this huge base. The British arm moved to build bases for it in Khash and northem placesin Ras al-Khaimah.

Moreover the British officers are they who in fact administer the country and in particular the political officers such as Captain Ash and others.

The Eritish worked to stir tribal feuds and disputes in the Eastern Region. After the rifles directed by the inhabitants against each other were silenced, the Eritish started working to stir tribal fighting afresh in other areas in the EasternRegion where the borders are endless, and are known by the British who ignite for us a problem daily in the country.

Their puppetZaid sent the army of the Federation to theEstern Region where the army members startedlooting the agricultural lands and tell the farmers that these lands are not theirs but belong to the President of the Federation. They also outraged their modesty and raped their women. The inhabitants complaint to the British officers but these officers sacked them and told them that the army is doing nothing. When the plan of Zeid was revealed he imprisoned one of the garrisons and replaced by another.

Puppet Zaid paid money to Asharqi and el-Jassemi to abandon the land and naturally these puppets do not care but for their interests and refuse to let these lands be taken from them on the grounds that they belong to the Federation.

Not this only. These puppets also committee an atrocity every day on the grounds of obtaining money from puppet Zaid and to keep the people busy from the injustice and corruption spread in the country. This State is the State of Shame and Injustice.

Puppet al-Qassemi the ruler of Sharjah is receiving from Iran the sum of 1,5 million dinars in return for selling the islands. In other words he sold the islands in istallments. As to Sagt he claims that he defends the Arabism of the islands while he received weapons last month from Iran in a secret manner to strengthen repression inside the Amirate.

As to Zaid he goes to Britain to seek advice. Not one month passes without an official from this Britain going to Britain, while they say that the country is independent. Our people did not gain any thing from this Federation, and those who gained from it wereonly the sheikhs. Our people only lost their lands and unemployment increased particularly that the majority of our people are peasants.

We follow the programmes of the revolution and we know that the revolution is the only road for establishing a national democratic regime."

THE NEW OCTOBER CAMPAIGN WILL BE DOMMED TO FAILURE UNDER THE HANDS OF OUR PEOPLE

The Anglo-American plans against the progressive regime in Democratic Yemen and the armed revolution led by the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf began to shift from the stage of preparation to the stage of implementation.

At a time in which the groups of falling reactionary and mercenary forces, which are supported by expert Jordanian and British officers, were launching new campaigns on the EasternRegionof the liberated territories of Dhofar, other concentrations of American and Saudi mercenaries, the enemies of the Yemeni people, were performing their tasks to prepare a malicious invasionoperation on the territories of Democratic Yemen. And so only three days passed for the start of fierce flashes between the People's Liberation Army and People's Militia onone side and between the British and falling puppet forces on the other, when the invasion plan was implemented. This conformity in the timing of the two moves was not a mere coincidence but is attributed to what is the fact that both parties are moved by one source and one hand accurately and promptly as part of an Anglo-American imperialist plan in which Iran, Saudi Arabia, Jordan and reactionary forces in Yemen and tribal regimes in Oman and the Arabian Gulf and all elements having interest in restoring backing the wheel of history and keeping in the rule the present odd regimes, play their roles.

It is not secret that the Regional Pact called by America was turned into a real fact under the hands of the American intelligence which placed all ign its potentialities and expertise for extinguishing the flame of the Arab revolution in this part of the Arab homeland.

The forthcoming year carries in it a fierce battle which will be witnessed by this arena, a battle between the forces which struggle for freedom and peace in Oman and the irabian Gulf and for their reunification. What is witnessed today of the attackedby the forces of hireling in the Region of Dhofar and theSecond Province is only a prolude for an imperialist-reactionary campaign against Democratic Yemen and the armed fevolution in Oman and the irabianGulf. It will be remarked that the imperialists and reactionaries have agreed between them and dug all their differences as well as coordinated their efforts for confronting the revolution all over the Peninsula and Gulf prior to liquidating it at any cost.
