## WITH THE SUPPORTERS OF THE REVOLUTION

The General Federation of Arab Students in the United Kingdom held a photographic exhibition on the revolution and struggle in Oman and the Arabian Gulf during the International Week for Solidarity with the Arab people which was held in France and later moved to tour different branches of the Federation in Britain and Ireland. The exhibition also displayed the television film taken for the first time in the liberated area and a number of resolutions were taken during the conference in support of the struggle of the front and demanding the withdrawal of the British forces.

\* The Committee in Support of the Revolution in Montreal is carrying out a leading role in giving prominence to the struggle of our people in Oman and the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf. The committee is translating, printing and distributing and reproducing leaflets of the front. The latest job carried out by it was the reprinting of Ninth June bulletin and its distribution in the United States and Canada.

\* Arab Students in the town of Bordeaux are performing significant activities in acquainting the French and Arab masses with the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf by distributing and translating the leaflets of the front and delivering lectures. It is to be recalled that Bordeaux is regarded as an important centre for university education and a large community of Arab workers and students live there.

\* Typhone, organ of the Iranian Marxist-Leninist Organisation published a lengthy article in which it introduced an analysis on the political situation in Oman and the Arabian Gulf and revealed the expansionist policy of the puppet Shah-in-Shah and the role of Iran in implementing the plans of American imperialism to protect the interests of imperialism in the arena and to hit the revolutionary movement of our people. It also praised the struggle of the masses under the leadership of the People's Front and stressed the necessity of cooperation between the Arabian and Iranian progressive organisations and brotherhood between the Iranian and Arab people to expel and knock down the plans of imperialism.

### \* Germany

The Committee in Support of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf issued in West Berlin a book in the German language on the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. The book is containing an analysis on the political, economic, social and tourist conditions and documents and statements by the two fronts - the People's front and the Democratic Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf. It distributed thousands of copies of this book to Arab and German students and workers and collected five tons of medicines for the front.

\* A Committee in Support of the Revolution was established in the 1st of March in Hamburg. The committee is composed of German progressive organisations and branches of Arab progressive organisations and Arab progressives in the town.

FRANCE

\* The group of supports of the revolution in Tora town distributed front pamphlets in a wide-scale manner. It is also printing and distributing pamphlets of the front in French.

\* The Paris Committee in Support of the Revolution in Yemen (Democratic) and the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf is carrying out an extensive information and political activity. It published recently a documentary book on the revolution in French and distributed thousands of copies of this book to Arab and French progressives. Members of the committee are also on many occasions delivering lectures and holding symposiums to show the cause of the revolution and struggle of our people.

BRITAIN:

Branches of the Association of Iraqi Students are backing the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf in an active and effective manner. Through the branches of the association the association members are translating, printing and distributing literatures of the front. Reports on the struggle and stands of the front occupy prominent places in the monthly magazine of the association "Voice of the Students". The recent annual congress of the association recommended strengthening of relations between the association and the People's Front and adopted several resolutions in support of the revolution. It also condemned colonialism and its stooges in the area and the puppet reactionary regimes and conspiratorial regimes.

\* The Arab workers League issued a statement supporting and backing the merger of the People's and Democratic Fronts and hailed the establishment of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf and its triumphant congress at Ahlaish. It published this in its magazine "Voice of the Workers" which is explaining the cause of the revolution in the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf and defending the struggles of our people against colonialism and local stooges and the Iranian and Saudi reactionary regimes.

\* Resolutions were issued by the annual liberation conference which was held during the period 8th to 9th April in support of the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of the People's Front and condemning British colonialism in the area and its war against the forces of the revolution, and backing for the fake regimes of the sultans, sheikhs and Amirs.

Switzerland:

The Committee in Support of the Revolution in Geneva in Switzerland is carrying out an active information activity to explain the revolutionary conditions in the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf and to back the struggles of our people against the colonialists and puppets.

UNITED STATES:

The Arab students at Seattle (capital of Washington) recently formed a committee in support of the Revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. This committee translates, prints and distributes leaflets of the front and publishes reports on the struggles of our masses in the arena of the Arabian Gulf and Oman and the victories realised by the revolution all over the seven past years including the armed struggle. The Arab students in Bongs Town formed a committee in support of the revolution. This committee carries out information and political activities in support of the armed revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of the People's Front.

ENGLAND:

A broad meeting was held by the Federation of Arab Students in the United Kingdom and Ireland at the begining of April. During the meeting the message of Comrade Salem Robaya Ali was read. Then the Chairman of the Federation delivered a speech in which he praised the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf and paid homage to the martyrs of the revolution and the solidarity with the people and government of the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen and the Arab people and their recent uprising. It is to be recalled that the Federation has prominent information and political activity in supporting the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. It also submitted a report from the Committee in Support of the Revolution in Palestine and the Arabian Gulf which was regarded as an official paper of the federation.

\* Yemeni workers who are members in the General Confederation of Yemeni Workers, England branch, are carrying out prominent activity in the service of the revolution and propaganda for it among the Arab masses and British progressives. Articles were constantly published in "Voice of the Workers", organ of the Federation, on the revolution and the struggles of our people in the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

\* Comrades in the revolutionary gathering of Iraqis are carrying out a broad activity in acquainting the Arab masses and British progressives with the blazing revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf through translating, printing and distributing in a wider scale pamphlets of the front and holding a number of symposiums and lectures on the revolution and the struggles of the masses.

ATTITUDE OF REVOLUTION:

ANGLO-AMERICAN PLANS TO WHERE ???

During this period the imperialists and their reactionary puppets are escalating their criminal and atrocious conspiracies for liquidating the progressive forces and regimes in the world and in particular in the Third World in order to establish their monopolistic interests in many areas and to reinstate their influence in a new colonialist form as well as to face national liberation with harsh and filthy methods with the aim of extinguishing the struggles of the peoples and obstructing the heightening procession of the revolution in the three Continents.

The Anglo-American imperialism and its reactionary puppets are executing their fierce and atrocious attack in the Arab arena in front of the serious Arab retreat during which a dreadful physical liquidation was directed against the Palestinian resistance movements and the progressive parties and forces in many Arab countries with the aim of halting the mass revolutionary movement and current in the Arab homeland. The colonialist plans were executed for re-arranging the conditions in the area of Oman and the Arabian Gulf in favour of Anglo-American imperialism and its puppets in Riyadh, Teheran and the Emirates of the Arabian Gulf.

Several conspiracies were laid down for quashing the progressive regime in the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen and the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. These imperialist and reactionary circles are still weaving the conspiracies against the heightening revolutionary current in Yemen and the Gulf and recruited remnants of the mercenaries and equipped with modern weapons to hit the progressive regime in the southern part of Yemen and weaved the strings of plotting in the inside.

WHAT WAS THE FATE OF ALL THIS?

All this was smashed down in front of the strong determination and revolutionary steadfastness of the armed forces, popular forces and crowds of the workers, poor peasants and fishermen and students and masses of the toiling people under the leadership of the pioneer National Front Organisation.

All these revolutionary crowds stood up for defending the homeland and the revolutionary accomplishments and gains realised by the immortal revolution of 14th October. The masses of 14th October proved their ability to check off all imperialist and Saudi reactionary aggressors and to clear the pockets of conspirators in the inside. They are now standing with revolutionary courage and patriotism ready to teach the aggressors lessons not to be forgotten by history.

The conspiracies planned and weaved against the progressive regime in Democratic Yemen form only a chain of the chains of imperialist and reactionary plotting against the progressive forces in the world.

At a time in which the strong revolutionary base in the Arabian Peninsula and the Arab homeland is facing strong imperialist and reactionary conspiracies, the revolution in Dhofar Region is facing repeated military campaigns and filthy economic war aimed at killing everything alive and burning and destroying everything green in abortive bids to extinguish the revolution.

All these atrocious and criminal bids were smashed under the feet of the People's Liberation Army and People's Militia and in front of the patriotic steadfastness of the citizens beginning with the espionage networks merged within the masses and ending with the conspiracy of 12th September and the October-November campaign (Operation Jaguar) which was abortive and other military campaigns on Ho Chi Minh Pass.

Our militant people are teaching the colonialists and reactionary bitter defeats and realising great victories. The more victories realised over our enemies the greater the conspiracies and military preparedness become to hit the revolution in the southern region of Oman and liquidation expands within the ranks of the progressive and nationalist forces in other regions of Oman and the Arabian Gulf in a hysterical manner.

The imperialist and reactionary forces in the Arabian Peninsula and Gulf exert all efforts to extinguish the revolution in Dhofar where Saudi Arabia promised Qaboos to interfere for protecting the collapsing puppet regime in Oman and other tribal regimes in Gulf as well as to safeguard the Anglo-American interests. To fulfil this ambition the Saudi reactionary regime gave Qaboos 150 million dollars and sent ten thousand soldiers near to Abu Dhabi prior to despatching them to Dhofar and other areas of Oman.

It is also training remnants of mercenaries from Yemen and the Gulf to send for subversion against the progressive regime in the southern part of Yemen and the revolution in the Gulf.

The fateful and principled cohesion between the progressive regime in the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen and the revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf is faced by a fateful and interestful cohesion by the forces of imperialism and reaction in Yemen and the Arabian Peninsula and Gulf and Iran.

Their military conspiracies and campaigns will constantly increase in a bid to extinguish the procession of the revolution which is escalating. But the wheel of the revolution is advancing constantly to smash down the enemies of the peoples and humanity. The experiments of the militant peoples confirm this.

FIERCE BATTLES WAGED BY THE PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY AND  
PEOPLE'S MILITIA AGAINST THE BRITISH AND PUPPET FORCES

Enemy Suffers 31 Casualties Within His Members and  
Destruction of 81mm Artillery Position

Military Communique No. 106/72

On 15th March at 6.00 p.m. our forces operating on Ho Chi Minh Pass launched an attack on the enemy positions at Akoot centre. The attack was launched from several directions using automatic (light and medium) weapons. The attack continued for half an hour during which the enemy lost seven members between killed and wounded. Our losses were nothing.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 107/72

Fierce Battles with Enemy Forces Result in 17 Casualties Between  
Killed and Wounded

On 16th March at 6.30 p.m. our forces repeated heavy shelling on the enemy centre at Akoot highland. The operation continued for fifteen minutes. Enemy casualties were not assessed upto the moment of writing this communique. No casualties were sustained by us.

On the same day at 7.00 a.m. the sniping group carried out a sniping operation against the enemies at Akoot centre leading to the death of one enemy member. Our group returned safely to base. On the same day at 8.00 p.m. our group repeated the attack on the same enemy position leading to death of two enemy soldiers. Our forces returned safely to base.

Military Communique No. 108/72

On 7th March the enemy infiltrated into Ghadia in the Eastern Region where one of our patrols was watching this enemy infiltration. At 5.00 p.m. our patrol engaged the enemy for half an hour using automatic weapons and light machine-guns. Enemy casualties were ten between killed and wounded. From our side one of our colleagues was slightly wounded. As usual the enemy fighter aircraft retaliated by bombing the area in a hysterical manner. But there were no casualties as a result.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 109/72

On 7th March at 7.00 p.m. our forces attacked the enemy positions at Asheiheet in the Eastern Region from several directions using all weapons and medium and light machine-guns. The attack continued for five continuous hours during which the enemy suffered heavy casualties in life which were not assessed upto the writing of this communique. No casualties were sustained by us.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 110/72

OUR FORCES DESTROY MEDIUM MACHINE GUN POST

On 8th March at 6.30 p.m. our forces launched a strong attack on the enemy positions at Darbat in which the artillery and machine-gun weapons were used. During this attack the enemy was hit by strong confusion. The attack continued for one and a half hours from all directions during which one enemy medium machine-gun post was silenced and part of the enemy fortifications was destroyed. Our forces returned safely to base.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 111/72

Successful Sniping Operations by the Comrades

On 9th March at 3.00 p.m. the sniping group of our forces operating in the Eastern Region carried out a successful sniping operation against the enemies for one and a half hours during which the enemy was seen evacuating the casualties among his members. Our forces returned safely to base.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 112/72

On 10th March at 7.00 p.m. the forces of our People's Liberation Army operating in the Eastern Region launched a strong attack on the enemy positions at Asheihat in the Eastern Region from all directions using different heavy and light weapons. The attack continued for one hour during which the enemy suffered eight casualties. Our losses were nothing.

On the same day at 8.00 p.m. our forces attacked the enemy positions at Darbat heights using artillery and automatic weapons. Enemy casualties were not assessed. Our forces returned without incurring any casualty.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 113/72

On 14th March our forces launched an attack on the enemy positions at Aqeirat in the Eastern Region. The attack continued for twenty minutes during which the hits were direct on the enemy positions. Another attack was also launched on the same day on the enemy positions at Aqeirat at 10.00 a.m. The attack was from different directions. Enemy losses included the destruction of a heavy artillery position and many of the enemy fortifications.

Helicopters were seen landing to evacuated enemy casualties of dead and wounded after our direct shelling stopped. No casualties were suffered by us.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 115/72

On 14th March at 7.00 a.m. our sniping group from the Ho Chi Minh Unit launched a successful operation on the enemy positions at Akoot heights resulting in the death of two enemy soldiers. On the same day at 3.00 p.m. our group repeated the operation against the enemies in the same positions leading to the injury of two enemy members. Our casualties during both operations were nothing.

Military Communique No. 116/72

FIERCE ATTACK ON THAQBEET RESULTS IN DESTRUCTION OF 81-mm ARTILLERY

On 20th March at 4.00 p.m. our forces from the Western Military Unit launched a fierce attack on the enemy centre at Thaqbeet in the north of the Western Region using heavy artillery and other weapons. The attack was from several different positions and continued for one hour after which the enemy sought the help of fighter planes which came to comb the neighbouring areas. But our ground defences intercepted them and forced them retreat. Enemy casualties included the destruction of eight positions with those manning them completely, the destruction of an 81-mm artillery position and the setting of fire to enemy tents. No casualties were sustained by us.

ENEMY SUFFERS FOUR CASUALTIES

Military Communique No. 117/72

On 11th February at 1.00 p.m. our forces operating in the Eastern Region launched a sweeping attack on the enemy centres at Sharq which continued for two hours during which the enemy suffered four members between killed and wounded and destruction of a heavy machine-gun post with its crew members. Our casualties were none.

PUPPETS OPEN FIRE ON ARMLESS CITIZENS

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 118/72

On 13th February at 2.00 p.m. a group of our forces advanced on the enemy forces at Harrar Mahood in the Eastern Region and engaged them in a fierce battle during which the enemy lost seven members between killed and wounded, a heavy machine-gun post silenced and a wireless set destroyed with its crew. Our forces returned safely to base.

As usual enemy fighter planes launched brutal raids on the same day on houses of citizens in that area to retaliate for the losses inflicted on him by the People's Liberation Army. The planes hysterically bombed houses of citizens resulting in the burning of these houses and wide areas of citizens farms. On the same day at 4.30 p.m. a group of puppets infiltrated into Harrar Mahood in the Eastern Region with the aim of terrorising the armless citizens. On their arrival to the places of the citizens fire was opened ~~on~~ by them resulting in the serious injury of Omer Shirkally.

MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 119/72

On 14th March a group of enemy forces infiltrated from their positions into the Asheihat heights into some places nearby. Our forces stationed there were watching the enemy infiltration and set ambush traps for them.

At 8.00 a.m. our forces opened heavy fire on the enemies from different heavy and medium weapons. The fire continued for half an hour during which the enemy lost three members between killed and wounded. Our losses were nothing.

PUPPET SULTANATE IN MUSCAT EXPLOITS ISLAMIC SECTS TO STIR FUEDS AMONG CITIZENS

With the development of problems, and shattering of the puppet regime in Muscat following the murderous blows rendered to the puppet army by our patriotic revolutionaries and with the increase of the people's wrath against the Sultanate of Qaboos all over the Omani region and after the Sultanate lost all masses, it resorted to new methods to create feuds between the masses and separate them from each other by using and exploiting the sects of the Islamic religion.

Reports came that the corrupt Sultanate ordered the inhabitants of Jaalan and Soor, who embrace the Suni sect, to learn the Abadhi sect in schools. This created general disappointment among the citizens in these areas. It is worth recalling that the ruling family of Al Bu Saeed is abiding by the Abadhi sect. The Sultanate is aiming behind this at creating sectarian feuds between the masses who adorn Islamic sects.

REPLY MESSAGE FROM QADDAFI TO THE CENTRAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Central Executive Committee of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf received a reply message from Colonel Muammar Qaddafi, in reply to the message sent by the committee to him on the occasion of the evacuation of British forces from Libyan territories.

The reply message said: "I thank you for your greetings on the occasion of the evacuation of British forces from our territories and exchange with you the same noble feelings. Colonel Muammar Qaddafi, Chairman of the Revolutionary Command Council and Premier of the Libyan Arab Republic."

PEOPLE'S FRONT GREET ARAB JOURNALISTS CONFERENCE IN BAGHDAD

The People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf sent a message to the Arab Journalists Conference which was held in Baghdad during the second half of April.

The message said: "We greet your conference now meeting to defend the freedoms for which the Arab masses are fighting and demand your backing for the revolution of the people in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. The People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf."

The People's Front also raised a memorandum to the conference in which it explained latest developments in the area and demanded exposure of the colonialist plans to the Arab and international common opinions and to break the embargo struck around the people's revolution in the arena and the distortion campaigns launched by the puppet information machineries which collaborate with the fictitious regimes in the arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

LEAGUE OF ARAB WORKERS IN ENGLAND ABIDES BY BACKING  
THE REVOLUTION IN OMAN AND THE ARABIAN GULF

The 14th central general conference of the League of Arab Workers was convened on 19th March in the United Kingdom and adopted several resolutions including the following:-

- \* Commitment to back the armed revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf and its staunches in the Gulf area under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf, against British colonialism and its bases.
- \* The conference condemns the deaf-ear and scaring policy followed by some Arab governments towards the revolution in the Gulf. It also condemns the recognition of these governments of the fictitious independences of weak States created to defeat the will of the people in the Gulf.
- \* The conference condemns occupation by Iran of the three Arab islands in the Arabian Gulf area. As to Democratic Yemen, the conference affirmed backing and support for the progressive regime in the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen in its firm stands and steadfastness in the face of repeated aggressions on the borders of Democratic Yemen by Saudi reaction and the British air force.

LEAGUE OF ARABIAN PENINSULA CITIZENS ABROAD (SAUDI ARABIA)  
ISSUES STATEMENT ON THE OCCASION OF GULF WEEK

The League of the Citizens of the Arabian Peninsula issued a statement on the occasion of the Week of the Arabian Gulf. In the statement the league dealt with the total situations in the area and particularly in the Arabian Peninsula and the armed revolution in Oman and the Arabian Gulf. It also revealed in the statement the conspiratorial role of Saudi reaction by leading the forces of counter-revolution towards confronting the progressive revolutionary movement in the Peninsula, Yemen and the Gulf. The statement also stated that groups of the progressive revolution in the Arabian Peninsula and the Arabian Gulf realise thoroughly well and assess the colonialist and reactionary plans. They know also that their unity and cohesion is vital for possessing the grounds of power and firm stand in the face of these plans.

The statement added that the news of the merger of both the People's Front and the Democratic Front in one front brought wide joy to the people all over the Arabian Peninsula.

The statement appealed: "O' militants in the Arabian Gulf. Your people who is chained and suppressed under the tyranny of the rule of the Saudi family, is firmly standing by your side and is part of you. The cause of this people is your cause and its objectives are your objectives and is now preparing to bounce and break the chains to join your procession in order to take up its position within your ranks. Comrades of yours in the prisons of the Saudi family are introducing daily new numbers of martyrs for the unity of the Arabian Peninsula." The statement said that the League of the Citizens of the Arabian Peninsula which fights for backing the national movement, greets the revolutionary forces in the Arabian Gulf under the leadership of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

THIRTY OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS IN THE SO-CALLED DEFENCE FORCE OF ABU DHABI SUBMIT RESIGNATIONS

In protest against the acts of discrimination exercised by the puppet Sultanate amongst the citizens of Inner Oman and their fellow citizens in Abu Dhabi, citizens of Inner Oman working in the army of the puppets in Abu Dhabi went on a strike. This action came after the prevention of eighty citizens of Inner Oman from going abroad on training courses. These were chosen as cadets but the puppets in Abu Dhabi prevented them from going abroad as they were stopped at the airport and replaced by other persons from Abu Dhabi. Following this coward act which aims at planting discrimination between the people of one land, the citizens of Inner Oman went on a general strike. Thirty officers and soldiers from the so-called defence force of Abu Dhabi submitted their resignations in protest against the prevention of their fellow citizens from going abroad on training courses.
