

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OFFICIAL SPOKESMAN FOR PFIO COLLENTS ON CENTO MANOUEVRES IN THE GULF OF OMAN

The CENTO pact is continuing its military manouevres in the Gulf of Chan which are expected to continue from 15.11. to 29.11.75. These manouevres are taking place in the territorial waters of Oman and they prove without doubt the link of the puppet regime in Muscat with the circles of imperialism, revelation of its identity and falsehood of the independence claimed by it.

The CENTO muscle show in this area and at this time in particular is of close link with the Anglo-Iranian campaign in the liberated area of Dhofar Region in particular and the American plan in the Middle East in general, which plan aims at silencing the revolutionary gun in Oman and Palestine and establishing the American hegemony on this sensitive part of the world.

These provocative acts carried out by the CENTO only threaten peace throughout the area of the Arbian Peninsula and the Middle East. The People's Front for the Liberation of Onan while condenning such provocative acts carried out by the colonialist CENTO pact, also affirms that these forces cannot terrorise our people and that they will bulk increase their determination and will to continue the struggle under the banner and pioner of its struggle the People's Front for the Liberation of Onan. In the face of these moves the People's Frontfor the Liberation of Onan calls upon all progressive regimes and national and progressive forces all over the Arab arena to stand in the face of such provocative acts and to confront the American plan in this area.

SOLIDARITY STATEMENT BY LIBERATION MOVEMENTS IN ADEN

CITIZENS SHAKE THE THRE AND YOU WILL FIND EVERYTHING

Once the tribal sheikhs of Oman (inner) met puppet Qaboos and asked Qaboos about the reason that made him not implement any of the reforms promised by him particularly in inner Oman and showed surprise that all reforms, starting with the opening of roads and construction of hospitals and ending with the open of education houses, are concentrated on Muscat and the Southern Region in particular. Qaboos has nothing but to reply to them by saying: "These shake the tree". So the sheikhs understood that they have "to shake the threes in their areas" in order to get reforms. This is a fact known by all citizens in Oman which says that if it were not the revolution all this would have not happened in Oman. What are the Conditions in Inner Oman?

TheFirst Fact: Although the general picture for the state of the Omani people is similar and closer yet the masses of inner Oman live in misery and poverty, disease and hunger. The first facts taken from the state of this area demonstrate misery and deep sadness that flatters over all villages, towns and rural places in this area where they lack the simplest reformatory projects such as schools, hospitals and roads. This area does not know any type of reforms for llong, and the state of the masses there was not changed and it is was it was during the era of tyrant Saced bin Taimbur.

The Second Fact: employment ministerial positions and important posts are only given to the well known puppets. None of the citizens of the inner Omen is represented in any of these positions. The structure of the government machinery is composed of a group of puppets sincere to Britain and Iran. Although the State machinery is administered and run by the British yet all government positions are confined to the puppets belonging to the British intelligence. N person can be employed whatever his identity be except after the approval of the intelligence machinery. The strange thing is that the under-secretaries of Ministries are they who practice the powers of Ministers and impose their decisions even on the fictitious Ministers themselves. This matter is not taking place foolishly but is due to the assignments of the British intelligence because the undersecretary is like the representative of theintelligence and represents the real authority. traditions were abendoned and drinks are extensively spread but

British Policy and the Minorities

The British colonialist method towards the minorities and foreign communities which was followed in Aden is the same policy thatis being enacted at present in Oman. This policy provides to priority being given to the members of these minorities in employment and in other works. This coldnialist policy aims at attracting these minorities and enticing them in order to link them with the colonialist projects and to depend upon them for creating contradictions between them and the Omani masses. For example there are the Luwatis and the Balush and other minorities in Muscat who occupy ministerial positions and other sensitive and key posts in the State machinery. Most of the undersecretaries come from these groups in addition to Omanis born in Zanzibar and who pour in huge numbers to Oman. Due to their qualifications and their remoteness from the sufferings of the homeland and Omanip cople most of them live like mercenaries in Oman. The structure of the regime in Oman is complicated and being controlled by many of the blacks and the British and Iranian influence and mercenaries of Hussein. Each Ministry is belonging to a certain sector but the matters of affairs are undoubtedly in the hands of the British colonialists. In addition to the repressive machinery and terrorism against the citizens, there is ugly power given to the puppets of the authority in repressing the masses. Moreoever, the British and Iranian intelligence machinery in Oman had attached a huge army of weedy elements who devoted their life for listening and spying on the masses.

What is the Reaction by the Masses Thwards This?

These colonialist conditions created amidst the popular masses a state of indignation and great deploration. Due to the spread of spying eyes by the authority, this created a stateof misconfidence and mistrust amidst the citizens. Generally you will see the faces sad and depressed and hatred piles up in the chests of the masses. You may picture the situation like the silence that precedes the storms." The citizen who speaks against the British is described throughout as a Communist and the spiritual habits and Omani customs and traditions were abandoned and drinks are extensively spread out by orders from puppet Caboos.

OUR OFFICE IN ALERIA ISSUES STATEMENT ON ANGLO-IRANIAN INVASION CAMPAIGN

Our office in Algeria issued a statment on the recent Anglo-Iranian campaign on the west of the Southern Region. The statement pointed out the huge losses suffered by the forces of invasion and mercenaries at the hands of the forces of the People's Liberation Army.

The statement also pointed out the losses of the front since the start of the Iranian invasion and its expansionist policy and the dangers of this invasion as well as the pre-planned aggressive intentions against the area of Oman and the Arabian Gulf to all Arab national regimes and to all Arab masses.

It is known that the British interference and British military presence in Oman finds opposition at increasing rate from the British people and the British parties including the ruling Labour Party.

Beveral Deputies have been interrogated including Stan Neonz, the British Government on the interference in Oman and asked for revelation of facts on the British involvement in the aggressive war in Oman. More than 74 Deputies have signed the proposal for the withdrawal of the British forces from Oman and suspension of their interference in this war. But the British Government which represents the interests of the oil monopolies and the traders of arms always ignore the wishes of the British people and their representatives on parliament. It is expected that the Wilson government is to bounce on this proposal submitted by the party branch in Wales.

All events taking place at present in the area of Oman and the Arabian Gulf have numerous faces and signs but all of these have one ain. Who links between the aims of the Anglo-Iranian campaign on the west of the Southern Region of Oman and between the CENTO pact manouevres in the Gulf of Onan on one hand and between the political moves) heavy) of the Gulf regions, Teheran, Muscat and the Arabian League on the other there will appear before him the aims defined for all these events clearly well. The political observerneed not use hardship to obtain the result from all these military and feverish political moves as the aim is to chop the head of the Omani revolution and to impose on it submissive plans. All hasten and events follow one of ter the other to impose the will of subjugation on our militant people. This wheel and speed up by the enemies in Oman is due to the collapse and damage suffered by the durny regime in Muzcat and its inability to live further. Such race comes as a result of the political and military embarrassment lived by the regimes of Teheran and London in Onan. Accordingly they are hastening up their steps to prevent the complete collapse of the Qaboos regime on one hand and to save their reputation which is dumped in the sand in Oman.

At political level they suffer complete isolation and at political level and military level they suffer the inability of the hireling army to sstand in the face of the mevolution while at financial level the puppet regime is on complete collapse. The Iranian invasion and its occumation of the Arab islands in the Gulf, and its continuous flow on Oman is only net with silence from the Arabian League and by the Arab regimes with the exception of some national regimes (such as Democratic Yenen, Libya and Iraq). As to the Arab League it was contented with condemnation of the foreign interference in Oman. But who are the foreigners in Oman who are covered by the condemnation? Why it did not name things by their name. This was not explained by the League. This is in addition to the fact that another tune started to be played by the League. This is conversion of the form of conflict in Oman into difference between the Muscat puppets and Democratic Yemen. The ain is to deface the cause of our struggle. The silence over the Iranian invasion and the foreign presence in Onan is also to be strengthened by it.

But our people and their revolutionaries, in spite of all this, are continuing their strugle and are observing steadfastness in the face of darkness and have the will and determination to continue so until the targets for freedom, independence and progress in Oman are realised.

The outcome of last week 's battles waged by our revolutionaries and their intensified attacks on the enemy positions in Sarfeet west if the Western Region included the infliction of heavy losses anidst the ranks of the enemy forces, his equipment and positions.

The losses of the Anglo Iranian invasion forces and mercenaries of aboos and Hussein during the past week which were contained in the mi itery communities Nos. 258, 259, 260, & 261 were as follows:-

Destruction of two helicopters and a transport inside the Centre of Sarfeet

Destruction of 73 fortified defeasive resitions Death and injury of 102 individuals.

An explosion also occured inside the enemy centres at Jarfeet and fire was set to them.

The forces of the liberation army are continuing their besiege of the enemy centres in Sarfeet tightening the besiege and messure on them.

The attacksof our revolutionaries by light and heavy (uns continue to hit the energy fortifications in a continuous and daily numer. No casualties occurred amidst the ranks of our forces during these battles.

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MOB SQUAD - A TOOK FOR REPRESENTING THE STRUGGLES OF THE FASSES Three years ago a police squad consisted of 60 policemen was formed. The task of this squad is to redress the struggles of the masses including labour strikes and mass demonstrations. It is also responsible for guarding the political detainees and bringing them to the prisons. The elements of this squad are coming from different nationalities and sects. Its only headquarters is at Rawi. This sound is called the mobile force unit. The first man responsible for it is Baxton, a British, and the second is Salem Haltim, deputy police commissioner who was born in Africa. The third man in the force is De Silva, the Folice commissioner and he is a Ugandan mercenary. This squad shared in redressing the labour strikes at Fuhood, Raisout and in al-Ghawaref. Thereis an attitude to expand this force but citizens refused to recruit themselves for the force in view of its filthy role. -0-0-0-0-

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
