I - INTRODUCTION

Our Committee was started in 1972 as a consequence of the efforts of several politically active elements from the Arab Minority Community in Detroit and its suburbs ( Primarily among Immigrant Arab workers ). The Committee was formed for the purpose of rendering political and material aid to the Omani Revolution. It was known as " the Support Committee for the Revolution in Oman and the Gulf". But later , the name was changed by 1975 to " The Support Committee for the Omani Revolution".

Many activities were carried by the Committee among the Arabic Immigrant Workers and Laboring People and U.S. Working class. By 1975 , the Committee developed a yearly program of action, a regular newsletter " Saout al Thawrah AL Omanieh ", an organizational base " General body " and a sheet of rules and regulations with minimum basis of Unity.
