I - INTRODUCTION

Our Committee was strarted in 1972 as a consequence of the efforts of several politically active elements from the Arab Minotity Community in Detroit and its suburds (Primarily among Immigrant Arab workers). The Committee was formed for the purpose of rendering political and material aid to the Omani Revolution. It was known as "the Support Committee for the Revolution in Oman and the Gulf". But later, the name was changed by 1975 to "The Support Committee for the Omani Revolution".

Many activities were carried by the Committee among the Arabic Immigrant Workers and Laboring People and U.S. Working class. By 1975, the Fommittee developed a yearly program of action, a regular newsletter" Saout al Thawrah AL Omanieh ", an organizational base" General body " and a sheet of rules and regulations with minimum basis of Unity.
