In Somewher 1975, our forces stationed in the western region were surrounded by the shery forces and were threatened to a total annihilation. The withdrawal from this region were therefore very necessary as it were better loosing the land than the land and fighters in the hame time.

The huge air, land and sen forces of the enemies in these compaigns constitutes one of the factors of the military defeat and our withdrawal from the *entern region, but this
