THE NECESSITY OF LINKING THE STRUGGLE AGAINST ZIONISM WITH THE STRUGGLE AGAINST AMERICAN PRESENCE AND INTERESTS

FROM MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 427-433/73

ISSUED BY FORCES OF THE PEOPLE'S LIDERATION ARMY, DHOFAR REGION

The forces of the People's Liberation Army and the People's Militia are continuing their successive and strong attacks on the colonialist and reactionary enemy centres and positions in the Southern Region of Oman (Dhofar). During the period between 1st and 11th October, our forces carried out ten successful operations which were concentrated at al-Mammar on the enemy centre at Mu'tabrani and Maghseel and in the Western Region at North Sarfeet during which the enemy suffered heavy losses in life and positions as well as installations and militarry equipment. The following are details of these operations in each area separately:

AL-MAMMAR

On 6th October at eight in the evening the enemy advanced from his centre situated at Mu'tabrani. Our brave revelutioneries were watching his nevements and so set up planned ambushes for him. No scener the enemy forces crived to distances closer to the am ushes they were rained by our forces with fire from their weapons for one hour. It twelve at noon the following by the enemy forces repeated their advance from the same centre but our forces were in wait for them, and clashed with them in a battle which lasted two hours and in which light weapons and hand grenades were used. Ifter that the enemy forces were forced to retreat after suffering twelve casualties amongst their members between killed and wounded. From our side ero Compades Saced Salen Muhad, Amer Suhail Amer and Hasson Muhad Mubarak were martyrised. It nine in the norning on list October our forces shelled the enemy positions at al-Maghiseel using artillery for ferty five minutes. Our forces repeated shelling of the same positions at twelve at noon on the same day for half a n hour. This resulted in the death and injury of three enemy members and the destruction completely of four enemy positions. Our lesses were none.

WESTERN REGION - NORTH SARFEET:

On 7th October at ten in the morning the sniping group of our forces launched a sniping operation against the enemy members in North Sarfeet during which three enemy members were killed. Our losses were none.

At seven in the norning on 9th October, our forces shelled the enemy positions in North Sarfeet using artillery for helf an hour. The shelling was concentrated and heavy on the enemy positions during which three enemy positions were destroyed. Enemy casualties were not assessed. No losses were sustained by us. On the same day at 9.30 in the morning our forces shelled the enemy positions in North Sarfeet using artillery for half an hour during which four enemy positions were completely destroyed.

On the same day too the sniping group of our forces were carrying out a sniping operation against the energy members. This resulted in three energy members being sniped betweenkilled and wounded. No losses were sustained by us.

On 11th October at seven in the marning our forces shelled the enemy positions in North Sarfeet by artillery. The shelling was strong and concentrated on the enemy positions and lasted for one hour during which the enemy sought the help of British fighter planes which came to comb the meanby area indiscriminately. The losses of the enemy included the destruction of three positions completely and the silencing of an 81-mm artillery gun. Enemy losses in life were not assessed but a helicapter was seen landing at the enemy centre to remove the dead and injured amongst his members. Our losses were none.

On the same day at three in the evening our forces repeated shelling of the enemy positions in North Sarfeet for half an hour. The shelling was concentrated and strong on the enemy positions and resulted in the destruction of four enemy positions completely. Enemy casualties were not assessed and we sustained no losses.

However, the sniping group of our forces carried out a sniping operation on the same day on the enemy nembers in North Sarfeet during which two enemy nembers were sniped between killed and wounded. Our group returned safely to base.

TOTAL ENEMY LOSSES:

- 1) Death and Injury of 23 enemy members. Enemy casualties were not assessed in some operations.
- 2) Destfuction f fourteen enemy positions completely
- 3) Silencing of an 81-mm artillery gun.

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BAHRAIN GOVT. FORMS COMMITTEE AS CONTRIBUTION IN DATTLE

The puppet regime in Muscat found the opportunity to ride the wave of the national battle when it announced the despatch of two nedical teams, one to the Syrian front and the other to the Egyptian front, although the citizens in Onan die on the doorsteps of the hospitals which lack even Aspirin and in spite of the frot that the medical delegation will not reach the front of the battle.

The other thing is that the Govefnment of Muscat ardered the employees to denote a week's salary. But gaboes and his clique will pay anything from the funds which they lavishly spend on the purchase of yachts and palaces. But the Government of Muscat remains more clever than the Government of Bahrain which surgrised all citizens with its decision to form a committee of two members, Abdel Aziz Ashamlan and Abdullah al-Medeni, to assess the needs of Egypt and byria and to contact the corporations and citizens for collecting donations. This means that the government will pay nothing from its budget and the sheikhs who spend millions will sacrifice nothing. Perhaps the government feared that the mass corporations, like the clubs and federations, might start moving and form popular committees which may cause messive response feared by the authority in Bahrain.

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SPECIAL MESSIGE FROM DAURAIN

A decree was recently issued by the Council of Ministers for payment of social allowances to State employees in a bid by the government to reduce the wave of sociang prices. But the specifications defined by the Council of Ministers for the method of payment of such allowances are the main point. Every Bohraini citizen can realise the injustice done to those with small salaries from the question of how to take advantage of the social allowances and who is the main person to benefit from them and whether such allowances will solve the strangling living crisis lived by the masses in Bahrain.

If we see the new decree issued by the Council of Ministers we will find that the main person to benefit is that person with a high salary because the allowance will be at a certain percentage of the salary. For example the tenth grade employee receives 25 dinars allowance while the small employee only gets eight dinars with the knowle ge that those with limited income suffer and are the most to be affected by the scaring up prices. Therefore they are the most to deserve. But we always find matters upset down in Dahrain. The existing allowances system which is based on the grades of the employees, does not serve the small employee and those affected but gives more inflation and luxury to those with high salaries who do not know enything about the searing up prices. In addition to this, the brilliant Council of binisters instead of curbing the wave of the soaring prices and stops the play of merchants with goods, we find it olways approving such conditions and even welcomes them as stated by the Development Minister Youssef Ashirawi who said in the Bahraini magazine "Sada -1-Asboo": it is wrong to specify prices and its better to let them subject to offers and demand because this is the way for the promotion of trade and goods. Where is the interest of the poor citizen in such a game then? How low income citizens can live in such a system and under such laws and where to find the living bread so long that the regime and its clique launch such laws.

Phemelessness reached its peak when the Sadda al-Asboo magazine published on 2.10.73 an interview with one of the senior officials in the Administration for Employees' Affairs on the question of the allowance on the basis of which the higher grade employee is given a larger amount while the opposite is required. The official justified this by saying: "It is not legic to give the senior employee an allow noe amounting to dinars for example because the cost of living of this employee differ to that of the small employee and because the luxuries required by the director are not required by the small employee. Therefore, it is natural that the senior employee is to receive a bigger amount. This is a fact not realised by the small employees."

It is funny that such an official deres to say that it is logic that, the luxuries of the senior employee are bigger than these of the small employee. Has he forgotten or he does not know that the low-income employees do not lock for luxuries at present but are still looking for the essentials to provide their living break.

It appears that the officials there are stupid and short-sighted when they make such statements to justify their positions in front of the starving masses to whom all these matters become exposed and such justifications became clear to themlike the sun coupled with their belief in the corruption of the regime and the necessity of change.

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MESSAGE FROM RUSTAQ STAGE IN INNER CMAH

The State of Rustaq is a State inhabited by more than 40,000 people. It has one hospital and one school. The authorities claim that this hospital is equipped with modern instruments and medical equipment. But the lies of such claims are ascertained through the strong indignation prevailing within the ranks of the citizens here, either from mal-treatment or discrimination, inferiority of medicines and primitiveness of medical methods. The citizens say that it is better if this hospital did not come into existence.

This hospital witnesses tens of painful incidents to the citizens. The simplest example was that ugly incident which claimed the life of a female citizen and her infant. The incident is surmarised as follows: one of the citizens took his prognant wife to thus hospital to deliver her child. On delivery she suffered bleeding which led to her death leaving behind the infant which was returned by the pospital department to his father. But because the father is an aged man and has nobody to look after the infant, he asked the hospital department to keep the infant in hospital even for one month. The department accepted at first but then changed its view and returned the infant to the father who in turn authorised one of the persons who brought the infant to take it back to the hospital where it re mined. After about a month the father received intimistion from the hospital that the infant died. So he went to receive its body. In hospital he was notified that his child died nearly a month ago and he has to go to the freezer to receive the body. Here the father was aroused with anger. But what to say he cannot de antyh ing. So he went to the freezer to receive the body of his infant with tears nearly passing fromhis eyes. This incident took place at the end of last month.

But in the field of educational services extended by the government of prosperity in Muscat to the members of the people. The condition is of course marching with other conditions in other aspects of which the reactionary authority boats and which the Qaboes exaggerates and flutters that they have been realised in accordance with a studied educational plan. In addition to the inavailability of teaching materials and the bad quality of the curricula and lower standard of the teachers and in spite of the fact that the students come from remote areas, villages and towns of the State to receive education, yet the prosperity government did not take the hardship of providing means of transporting these students although the parents of the students showed preparedness to bear the transport expenses. The student cuts long distances daily either on foot or on a donkey.

Most villages are far from the cepital by one hour or two hours and some of them three hours. It is to be recalled that the reactionary authority in Muscat, arrest before nearly one year, the principal of this school and a group of national teachers who are still upto new in the prison of Kot al-Gallali where the principal was sentenced to life imprisonment. The fate of the majority of the teachers was not known. They were arrested following the kass uprising which took place in the State in protest against the mal-treatment and the bad medical, educational and economic conditions and the restriction of public freedoms. In addition to such deturierating conditions in these two field, there are many other problems from which the Omani citizen suffers.

MESSAGE FROM RUSTAQ - Cont'd.

The question of obtaining food became one of the most difficult problems overburdening the citizen. Unemployment began to spread and foodstuff prices began to sear up continuously. These conditions exist in all areas and states of Gman like other areas which lie under the injustice and subjugation of colonialism and reaction. The messages said that the masses were hit by indignation and every person here began to feel as if he is walking on a valcane which is nearly to explade. The citizens here following the programmes of "Saut al-Thawrd" (Voice of the Revolution) over Aden Radio and follow the victories of the revolution and its accomplishments. The authority feels the changes taking place amongst the masses and as such it is working energetically to follow the honest citizens and detect their movements through the nearenary puppets it launches within the ranks of the people. When will the volcane explode? Some sparks began to appear now.

DUBAI RULERS RIDE WAVE OF TRADING WITH NATIONAL ISSUE

The Dubai Government sent medical teams to the battlefronts in Sinai and Gelan. These teams are composed of Iranian and British doctors and other doctors of ngn-arch nationalities. This, as it appears, is an attempt by the Rulers of Bubai to ride the wave of trading with the national issue and the battle of destiny waged today by the varguards of our Archantion.

It is worth recalling that the Iranian intelligence established in Dubai a hospital named "The Red Lion and Dun Association Hospital" as a facade behind which they hide their subversive and espionage acts against the national forces in the Gulf area and to detect the activities carried out by the progressive Arab regimes with the aim of safeguarding the Arabism of the Gulf and its freedom.

Moreower, the majority, if not all, of the Iranian dectors working in the government hospitals in Dubai belong to the Iranian intelligence machinery and we believe there is no need to explain the Iranian stands and intentions towards the national issues of ours.

ANOTHER OPEN DECEIP

The colonialist reactionary authorities in Muscat started to spread rumours within the circles of the Omani citizens in the inside and outside and within the circles of the soldiers and balush citizens saying that they are willing these days to carry out work leading to the recevery of "Gawadhar area which was sold by puppet Saced bin Trinour to the Pakistani government. The reactionary authority aims behind this at:-

- 1) ...bsorbing the wrath and indignation which began to spread within the circles of the Balush soldiers working in its nerconary colonialist army and who started to realise the filthy hature of the war in which they share.
- 2) To divert the attention of the Omani masses from the problems and pains suffered by them as a result of the critical exercises by this puppet authority in a bid to absorb the masses wreth.

But the basses of our people and the Talush masses realise the reality of such allegations and appreciate that wheever opens the doors of the hemeland for the Iranian involers in addition to the Pritish cannot be a liberator of his lands. Therefore, the game is open like other games played by the puppet authority.
