

LEAVE THIS OCEAN YOU DIRTY FLEET

MILITARY REPORT

FROM MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 452-459/73

ISSUED BY FORCES OF PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY - DHOFAR REGION

The forces of the People's Liberation Army and the People's Militia are continuing their successive and strong attacks on the centres and positions of the colonialist and reactionary enemy in the southern Region of Oman (Dhofar) during the period between 24th October and 6th November, 1973 during which our forces launched successful operations which concentrated mostly on the Western Region and inflicted upon the enemy heavy losses in life and equipment and installations. The following are details of these operations:-

AL-MAMMAR - M RTYR AHMED MUHAD ASLAM OPERATION

At nine in the morning of 30th October, the forces of the People's Liberation, Army shelled with artillery the enemy centre at Abu Khuseifa at al-ammer. The shelling was strong and concentrated and continued for one hour during which four enemy positions were destroyed and four enemy members were either killed or wounded. A helicopter was seen removing them after the withdrawal of our forces which returned to base safely without incurring any losses.

WESTERN REGION:

On 24th October the aircraft of the British Royal ir force raided the houses of citizens and their cattles at Dhalkout town in the Western Region. The raid continued for one and a half hours resulting in the extermination of fifteen she-camels of the citizens but there were no casualties.

At eight in the morning of the following day the sniping group of the forces of the People's Liberation Army carried out a sniping operation against the enemy members in North Sarfeet which continued upto 4 in the evening. During these operations three enemy members were wounded and the group returned safely to base.

On 8th October, at one in the afternoon the sniping group of the People's Liberation.rmy attacked the enemy members in his position in North Sarfeet using light weapons. The attack continued upto 1.45 in the afternoon of the same day during which our group managed to kill two enemy members. At 1.15 in the afternoon of the same day another group of our forces shelled with crtillery the enemy positions in North Sarfeet. The shelling continued for three quarters of an hour during which three enemy positions were destroyed. Enemy losses in life were not assessed. In the morning of the same day a group of our revolutionaries strongly shelled the enemy positions in North Sarfeet for twenty minutes causing to the enemy great damages inlife and equipment and the destruction of two enemy positions.

Our losses were none.

On 2nd November at 8.30 in the morning our forces shelled with artillery the enemy positions in North Sarfeet for 45 minutes during which two enemy positions were destroyed and a number of enemy members were injured. Our losses were none.

On 4th November, our forces operating at Sarfeet launched at 9.30 the enemy positions for three quarters of an hour during which our forces managed to destroy three enemy positions and injur a number of enemy members. At ten in the morning of the same day another group of our forces shelled the enemy positions in North Sarfeet for half an hour but enemy lesses were not assessed during this operation. Our losses were none during both operations.

At six in the evening of the 6th November, a group from the forces of the People's Liberation "rmy attacked the enemy forces in their positions in North Sarfeet using in this attack which was launched in a surprising and lightning method and which lasted for fifteen minutes, light weapons. Enemy losses during this operation were not assessed. Our forces returned safely to base.

TOT. L ENEMY LOSSES:

- 1) Death and Injury of nine enemy members
- 2) Destruction of sixteen enemy positions completely
- 3) Destruction of artillery position of 81-mm
- 4) The enemy losses also included heavy losses in installations, equipment and lives which were not assessed yet.

OUR LOSSES DURING ALL THESE OPERATIONS:

1) Extermination of fifteen she-camels of the citizens.

RETURN OF P.F.L.O.A.G.'S DELEGATION FROM PECCE CONGRESS IN MOSCOW

The delegation of the People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the archianGulf roturned from Mescow last Wednesday - 7.11.73 after taking part in the World Congress of Peace Forces which was held in Moscow during the period 25th to 31st October and in which more than 5,000 invites from 143 countries representing 120 international organisations and more than 1,100 organisations, parties and national movement attended signifying by that a biggest international demonstration for consolidating peace based on justice and freedom.

The Feople's Front delegation took part in this congress enancting from its conviction that the struggle of our people for real political and economic independence is only a struggle for ending one of the vacuums of tension caused by Inglo-Imerican imperialism and for establishing a permanent and just peace. Our delegation took part in three committees. They were:

1) The Middle East 2) Security in Asia, 3) Nati nal Liberation and Strug le against colonialism and racism.

Through the studies forwarded by us and by convincing many of the delegates of countries and friendly organisations, the committees reports contained the following:-

1) The Security in Asia Commission: In the Arabian Gulf and Arabian Peninsula area, Anglo-American imperialism in cooperation with the reactionary regimes build military bases and arm in an extensive gammer these regimes and work to build the new pacts of imperialism for continuation of their control over these areas which are rich with oil and against the nationalliberation movement in this area and the progressive regimes in Iraq and the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen.

MESSIGE FROM SALLALAH

If the economic blockade and all methods of tightening the rope were intended before against the rural masses, then these necessures extended to cover the urban masses which are accused of helping the rural masses to reduce the hardness of the blockade imposed on them.

Under the curtain of fighting the high prices and exploi tation of the merchants, and under the curtain of allegati as ever the world crisis in rice, the reactionary authorities agreed with the exploitist merchant Mr.Salem bin Ibrahim Ali, to be the responsible for and the only source for traind in rice in the towns of Dhofer. It also agreed with him on the prices and the methods of sale as to quantity and way to be followed and whom priority is to be given in the disposal of the important quantity of foodstuffs.

..s to the ordinary citizen who wants to obtain a bog of rice, he has to get a paper signed by governor "Buraik bin Hamcod" or his deputy. This agreement from the Governor cannot take place except in very exception cases and through mediations because the authority announced that it impossible to give a bag of rice to any citizens except on Idd or important occasions. Excluded from such measures were all puppers and those having positions in the machineries of the State, as any one of these can obtain this foodstuff at any time and in an quantity he wants and with a special price. From it appears to us who is affected by the measures and what are the real aims and objectives hiding behind them?

Of course those intended and affected by the e measures will not be the merchant or puppets but will be the adinary citizen as this citizen will be lucky if he reaches the office of the Governor or his deputy and will be lucky if he gets their approval. This means that the citizen will remain under the mercy of the merchant. Because he wanted to live he must eat and get permission and obtain the foodstuffs but this means to him the impossible. Therefore, he will resort to the wereheart who will exploit him and impose on the citizen the price he wants and who does not want to buy at this price he is not forced to buy.

of the operation as it is clear is aimed at subjugating the citizen and as the Governor says at punishing him because he helps his brothers and his relatives who come from the rurals and on whem the authority imposes an ugly economic blockade. By this he is only rebelling against the government.

From here it appears to us that the authority wants to fight exploitation with the exploiters themselves and wents to fight high prices with the imposition of further factors which help in the dedication of these prices and wants to overcome the crisis in the quantities of rice by piling up and stocking the rice in their palaces and the palaces of its employees and their relatives who include puppets, hirelings and mercencries.

NEW TERFORISTIC OFFICIAL I N THE EMBASSY OF THE AUTHORITY IN KUWAIT

The reactionary authority in Muscat appointed puppet Saced Ali Akak as member in its Embassy in Kuwait to replace the former puppet "li Sahl who was in charge of following up the citizens of the Southern Regionwho reside in Kuwait and who clashed with the "mbassador of the reactionary authority as a result of his interference in the affeirs of the Ambassador and his duties as "mbassador."

STAND CONFIRMS FALSEHOOD OF CLAIMS ON NATIONAL SOLIDARITY

During the holiday of Idd al-Fitr, all Arab embassies in Kuwait closed their doors and refused to hold any reception which they were holding on such occasions every year in view of the combative circumstances being passed by the Arab nation.

But the embasy of the puppet authority deviated such a stand and opened its doors to receive the greeters. It even addressed invitations to receptions held by it on this occasion. So where is the solid-rity stand boasted by the puppets?

MUSCAT:

After the wave of scaring up prices in Oman in a very actite manner, the reactionary authority in Muscat started to form a committee for studying such a sign in a bid by it to throw ashes into the eyes in order to reduce the popular turnoil against the policy followed by the authority to face the problems of the masses.

The so-called Public Development Board issued a statement to the citizens in which it announced shaenlessly that the government is we aware of the problem of high cost of living and is studying it carefully on the hope of reaching a solution to be announced to be citizens as soon as possible.

STRIKE BY WORKERS AND EMPLOYEES OF AMERICAN MISSIONARY HOSPITAL

E.HR.IN: The workers and employees of the American Missionary hospital in Dahrain staged a strike at the end of October after all their efforts to realise their demands failed. Their just demands centred on the following:-

- 1) Improvement of the level of the wages of all workers in the hospital where the salaries are lew to a great degree and prices are high and going up higher. The workers demanded an increase of ten per cent.
- 2) Provision of transport for the workers and employees.
- 3) Clothing to be provided by the hospital as the workers are forced to put special clothes and the hospital management forces them to buy such clothings from their small salaries.
- 4) To count the over-time hours.

The workers have submitted a memorandum senetime age to the director of the hospital but the *merican officials turned back without shame this memorandum and increased their oppression against the workers and employees. The strikee came in reply to the non-response of the officials in the hospital to the just demands of the workers and the employees and as an expression of the great indignation reinging over the Bahrain as a result of the high wave of prices which harrass the citizen.

LEAVE THIS OCEAN YOU DIRTY FLEET

During the recent war which was waged by Egypt and Syria and the Palestine resistance backed by the masses of the Arab nation against the Israeli aggression, the American Sixth Floet carries out suspected and distorted displays and moves in the Mediterranean. It was clear to all nationalists and progressives in the Mediterranean area that this fleet constitutes great danger to the peoples of that area. This danger appeared during the recent war when it extended full military support to Israel provoking by that not only the peoples of the arab nation but all peoples overlooking the Mediterranean. The voices of the nationalists and progressives were raised high condomning this fleet and its dirty role and asking the peace-loving countries and peoples to intensify the campaign against American imperialism in order to force it withdraw its fleet and make the Mediterranean sea a lake of peace and security for its peoples.

It was clear too to our masses that the Israeli base in occupied Palestine cannot live one moment without *merican backing and without *merican protection and strict watch by the American. Moreover the "morican imperialists get all necessary facilities from their British allies on the island of Masirah which was turned by British imperialism into a huge naval and air base.

In Iran naval bases are scattered all across the eastern coast of the Gulf of Omen and the Arabian Gulf extending all facilities to the Seventh Fleet in spits of all appeals by peace-loving peoples and countries to make the Indian Ocean an area of peace and security.
