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CANADIAN-ARAB ACTION COMMITTEES:

Canadian Arab Action Committees have been established over the weekend in Toronto London and Montreal with headquarters in Ottawa, the Arab League Office in Ottawa reported.

An Arab Relief Fund with a one-million-dollar target has also been set up to provide aid to the victims of the recent Israeli aggression on Arab countries.

LEAGUE'S OFFICE IN PARIS COLLECTS FUNDS AND PLASMA FOR VICTIMS OF AGGRESSION.

The Arab League Office in Paris has dispatched to Jordan the plasma it had collected last week in reponse to an urgent request by the Jordanian Embassy in the French capital.

The Office is also raising a fund for the relief of Palestinian refugees and victims of the Israeli aggression. Some of the money collected has already been sent to the Jordanian Embassy.

In an open letter to Russel's Court for the Trial of war criminals, the Director of the League's Office had earlier called for investigating Israel's use of the internationally banned Napalm bombs in its aggression on Arab countries.

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ARAB BOYCOTT OF AMERICAN AND BRITISH COMPANIES.

The Israel Boycott Offices in Arab countries are presently preparing a list of the names of companies and establishments belonging to the United States and Britain prior to adopting resolutions concerning the application of boycott regulations to them at the Boycott Conference to be held in Alexandria on July 15th.

This was disclosed by the Director of the Regional Boycott Office in Alexandria.
