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## P R E F A C E

Under the gracious patronage and keen interest of His Highness the Amir, the Planning Board was established in 1962 which was upgraded into the Ministry of Planning in 1976. The Central Statistical Office was established in 1963 under the Act 27 of 1963 which empowered it to conduct periodic population censuses and collect all economic and social statistics concerning the country.

One of the essential requirements for planning is the availability of upto date and reliable data on various aspects of the economy and life of the citizens. The Central Statistical Office has been, since its inception, engaged in the task of building up a sound statistical base. In pursuance of this goal population censuses have been conducted once every five years. The last census of population was undertaken in April 1980. This was preceded by a Census of Housing and a Census of Establishments.

The preliminary results of the 1980 population, housing and establishment censuses are presented in this report.

Census taking has been an arduous task. The success of this venture depended on the generous co-operation and efforts of many government organisations, supervisors and

enumerators engaged in the census process and the citizens. I take this opportunity to record my appreciation and gratitude to all those who assisted in making the 1980 Census a success. I hope the results issued in this document will be useful to all those concerned and interested in the economic and social aspects of the country.

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### Introduction

The sixth Census of Population of the country was conducted by the Central Statistical Office in April 1980. Prior to the population count, the CSO organised a Census of Housing. Alongwith the general population census, a Census of Establishments was also undertaken.

Data on the demographic, economic and social characteristics of the population, housing and its characteristics, number of establishments, their activity and numbers employed were collected through the censuses. These data are now being edited and coded and it will take some time for the CSO to publish the comprehensive and final results. In the meanwhile it was considered desirable to issue the preliminary findings regarding population, housing and establishments in view of the widespread interest in census data.

The preliminary results of the censuses of population, housing and establishments are presented in the following pages.

Section I : Population Census1. Census Chronicle and Population Data

The first Population Census of Kuwait was conducted in 1957 by the then Ministry of Social Affairs and Labour and the second in 1961.

After the formation of the Planning Board, the Central Statistical Office (CSO) was established according to the clause I of the Law No.27 of 1963 concerning Statistics and Census. The third clause of this Law conferred on the CSO the responsibility to carry out a general population census periodically. Accordingly CSO carried out the third Population Census in 1965. Since then a census has been conducted once every five years. The fourth Census was conducted in 1970, the fifth in 1975 and the sixth one in April 1980. The results of the last census presented in this report reflects the population as on the night of April 20-21, 1980.

3. Population Composition

Analysis of the magnitude, composition and characteristics of immigration and their changes over time are pertinent to the understanding of the demographic dynamics of Kuwait and in framing a population policy for the country.

The following table shows the significance of immigration when we compare the composition of the population by nationality during the period 1957-1980.

4. Sex Ratio

As the population of Kuwait is significantly affected by immigration, the differential in sex-ratio is a noticeable phenomenon especially for the non-Kuwaitis and in turn of the total population.

Section II : Housing Census1. Census Chronicle and Housing Data

Housing Census is considered the most important field operation conducted within the preliminary stage of the general population census. This census seeks basic data on buildings, residential conditions, specifications of the place to be visited for enumeration, indications of the necessary number of enumerators needed and their distribution in the field.

The following table shows the number of buildings and housing units in census years. It may be noted that the 1970 census figure represents the number of "census buildings" and not the number of "whole buildings" as in 1975 and 1980. The concept of "whole building" includes one "census building" or more than one according to the design and components.

The 1980 census data represents the housing situation during the period 11.2.1980 to 4.3.1980

Section III : Census of Establishments

1. Census Chronicle and Data on Establishments

The data collected through censuses include kind of activity and employment. The data provide the basic frame for drawing samples for various economic surveys.

Due to the rapid pace of economic development of Kuwait over the last two decades, it was found that quinquennial censuses of establishments were not adequate to reflect the progress, changing structure and composition of establishments and to serve as a reliable frame for economic surveys. It was therefore decided to carry out more frequent censuses to provide uptodate and reliable data. The first Census of Establishment was carried out in 1965, the second in 1970, the third in 1973, the fourth in 1975 and the fifth in 1980.

The results of the last census are shown in this report.
