

ON OCCASION OF 9TH ETERNAL ANNIVERSARY : Voice Firm Solidarity With Our People

The heroic Just struggle of the people of Oman andArabian Gulf against the Qaboosite regime and the Iranian reaction was highly greeted by Comrade abdul Fattah Ismail, NFPO Central Committee Secretary General, in addressing the huge ly cowded mass rally organised on June 9th 1974 at the workers Confederation headquarters in Maalla on occasion of the 9th Anniversary of the June 9 Revolution.

The NFPO Central Committee Secretary General said in his speech to the masses attending the rally, "We warmly greet the prominent struggle of the people of Oman and Arabian Gulf since the break out of their revolution led by the People's Front for the Liberation o f Oman and Arabian Gulf on June 9, 1965.

The Secretary General newly confirmed the firm stand of the 14th October revolution led by the National Front political organisation to the side of the struggle waged by the Omani people for dispelling the Iranian invaders and ending the Qaboosite reaction. "He added, "The experiment of the national struggle proves that the colonialists have changed their colonialnature into the neo- coloniallism form."

The NFPO Secretary General pointed out that the silence over the occupation of the e Omani isles and the utilization of the Iranian military troops to carry out that criminal scheme is considered as the highest national treason. He called upon the Arab and international public opinion to mediate to hold up that burtal invasion He also emphasized that the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen which successfully passed through the national lib-

eration epoch shall never forget their comrades still fighting for liberation and independence.

Comrade Secretary General went on:"Our support for the armed revolution in Oman and Arabian Gulf is stemming from the 14th October revolution principled attitude in backing the national liberation movements."

In another speech delivered by Comrade Mehdi Abdulla Saeed, President of General Confederation of workers, he stressed the full support and firm stand of the Yemeni working class to the side of t h e Omani masses struggle led by the PFLOAG.

Comrade Mehdi Abdulla saeed emphasized on the joint Common targets of the 14th October revolution led by the NFPO and the June 9th revolution counter to the puppet Qaboosite regime, the Iranian reaction and imperialist influence. He spoke on the move and conspiracy of imperialist and reactionary forces aiming at surrounding the revolution and said, "disregard to any attempts, the revolution during the nine years realized several successes on the way to liberate t h e areas."

He denounced the Iranian reaction interference saying that such invasion move discloses the colonialist and reactionary alliance against the revolution of Oman and Arabian Gulf and against the progressive regime in PDRY.

Likewise, Comrade Ahmed Abdul Samad, Member of the Central Executive Committee of PFLOAG, delivered a speech in which he made it clear that the people's protracted war, which was and is being waged by our people and which is full of successes and sacrifores, has adhered the revolution to a mass solid ground

and has strengthened the principles and objectives of the revolution in the minds of the broadest toiling masses in a way that the road is cut in the face of any colonialist and reactionary tricks. He added: "The colonialists and reactionary forces reject to have our people enjoy its freedom and independence and control its homeland wealth."

He went on that the revolution, which proved to our people that the way to freedom, dignity and independence cannot be presented as a gift on a golden dish, cannot be proceeded whithout sacrifices and sacred blood as a cost for the ever dear freedom.

Summarizing the achievements realized by the revolution, Comrade Abdul Samad added: "We have liberated wide area of Dhofar up-country and, as a result, the people's power was set up through People's Coun-cils in these areas. We also built up people's militia and the people's liber-ation a r m y, educational institutions, literacy centres and other c e n t r e s to furnish medical services. to drill water wells, to construct dams. In addition, social laws are enacted for the interest of the widest sector of our people." Our people could, as well, wage extensive political uprisings against the puppet regime and its colonialist masters.

"The revolution is continuously widening the gap of its freinds on both internal and external levels and is always meriting the respected broad support of them", said Comrade Abdul Samad. He also stated that the revolution will not allow the imperialists and reactionary forces plotting schemes to easily pass and achieve their dreams. He added: "We see in the Iranian invasion danger a threat to the Arab national in general and, thus, we are convinced that confronting this enemy is a nationalist question which necessitates the firm stand of all patriotic Arab forces to defend an inseparable part of its nation against the foreign intervention.

In conclusion, Comrade Abdul Samad warmly greeted that brave attitudes of PDRY towards the struggle of the people of Oman and Arabian Gulf and said that that support sincerely expresses the eager covetousness of this sister Arab country on the dangers entangling our revolution. He, also, greeted the honoured national attitudes of the Arab regimes siding the people of Muscat and Oman and expressed his deeply gratitude for all the international peace-loving and democratic forces in their support and solidarity with the revolution.

The representative of the National liberation movement in the N or th e r n part of the Arabian Peninsula, addressing the r al 1 y, expressed tribute to the struggles and r e s i s t a n c e of the PFLOAG. He confirmed the r o l e of the reactionary Saudi Arabia to undermine the armed revolution in Oman and Arabian Gulf by colluding with the puppet Qaboosite regime and the Iranian reaction.

He condemned the repressive actions of the Saudi ruling family a gainst the liberation movement in Northern part of Arabian peninsula and said that man y of the militant fighters detained in the Saudi ruling family jails are tortured to death. He appealed to Arab and world public opinion to mediate to hold, up the criminal barbaric campaigns carried out against patriots and militants in the northerm part of Arabian peninsula, the so-called Saudi Arabia.

Handing Over Political Prisoners to British & Jordanian Intelligence in Muscat Never Mean Democracy For Abu Dhabi

Our Militant Masses.

At this delicate stage of the life of our Arab nation and in such difficult circumstances which are being lived by our people in Oman and the Arabian Gulf while facing the Iranian danger and confront it to defend the Arab nation and the Eas' ern frontiers, the Government of Abu Dhabi is handing over 52 Omani detainees to the rulers of Muscat.

The Abu Dhabi Government has arrested these Omani citizens a year and a half ago and intimidated against them the Jordanian and savage torture and did not forward them to trial or direct any charge against them. It even handed over the detainees in one lot after another to the traitorous government in Muscat, A while ago it handed over the first batch and later handed over militant Murad Abdel Wahhab only two months ago to the QaboosBritish intelligence. In the past few days it handed over the biggest batch of prisoners to the traitorous rulers of Muscat,

The abu Dhabi Government which is now beating the drums for the forthcoming democratic era wants to get rid of the political detainees by distributing them to the other traitors in the areas of Oman and want to impress people that it released the detainees and that it holds not even a single political detainees as well as to forecast the signs of Zaid's fake democracy which is guarded by the Jordanian and British intelligence all over the arena of North Oman. The People's Front for the Libliberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf sees that this step is another part of the imperialist plan to re-arrange the conditions of the puppets in order to stabilise peace and stability of the oil monopolies in the Arabian Gulf area.

It now wants to get rid of all opponents and all militants by sending them to Kot al-Gallali in Muscat so that the rest of the cartoonist dummies in the states enjoy peace and stability.

The People's front for the liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf condemns such criminal act and holds the Zaid government basically responsible f o r any crime committed by the traitorous rulers of Muscat against these detainees. We also warn the Qaboos clique and their masters the British against committing any other crime against these honest citizens whom it alleges will be forwarded to trial to mark the passage of one complete year 2

last year against ten Omani militants.

We appeal to all popular organisations, democratic forces and peace-loving forces in the Arab homeland to interfere and to perform their duties for the release of these detainees.

We also appeal to all peace and democracy-loving forces

on the crime committed by it and corporations which kept on their shoulders the task of defending the human rights to interfere to save the lives of these citizens from the executionists of Qaboos, the Svac and the puppets of King Hussein as well as the British colonialists.

CENTO PACT THROWS ITS WEIGHT TO IMPEDE OUR TRIUMPHANT REVOLUTION The CENTO Pact supported the military interference played by Iran in the Sultanate of Oman.

This came in the statement issued by the CENTO meetings held in Washington and published by the Iranian newspaper Keihan issued on 26th May. The forces of the pact, which includes America, British, Iran, Turkev and Pakistan, will stage huge Military manouevres following the meeting of the Ministerial Council of the pact in Washington

The newspaper quoting diplomatic circles in London, to safeguard the pact at this period in particular is an important thing to Iran more than any other member-State.

FRENCH LE MONDE REFERS TO IRANIAN INVADING FORCES FAILURE

The French Le Monde newspaper said that the Iranian military landing in Oman did not cause any anxiety the Arab leaders who usually hasten to condemn any foreign interference as they have not adopted any attitude on the Iranian interference with the exception of Colonel Qaddafi who expressed his dissatisfaction by the opening of an office for the extreme, according to the Le Monde, PFLOAG Organisation in Tripoli. This came in a report prepared by the newspaper on the Iranian military interference in Oman which was published under title "Iran's role in Dhofar."

The Le Monde added: "The important Arab press circles from cairo to Riad kept quiet over this incident which proved that Iran is the guard of the Gulf. " The newspaper said that this strange silence encouraged Teheran and Muscat to show the cooperation and express it openly during the official visit

which was made by the Sultan of Oman to Iran in the beginning of last March. The newspaper added that the participation of the Iranian forces in the war now going in Dhofar was the clearest evidence for this cooperation.

The Le Monde said tha: Sallalah-Thamreet zone - Red Line was the basic target for all military campaigns which took place in the past three years. The newspaper confirmed that all previous campaigns, the last of which was the October - November, 1971 campaign carried out by the Red Devils, have failed.

The Le Monde continued to confirm that since the beginning of 1972 it was certain that the (Omani) army whose number was raised from three to twelve thousand soldiers in less than two years is unable to repress the rebellion and Arab State was prepared to send its

forces for taking part in the war in Dhofar.

USSR, AS A MAJOR WORLD PEACE FORCE, EXPRESS ITS ANXIETY TOWARDS **IRAN ARMAMENT**

The leaders of the Soviet Union expressed indignation and enxiety over the aggressive attitude followed by Iranian reaction in the area of Oman and the Arabian Gulf.

The Agence France Press. which published the report. said that observers see that the criticism made by the Soviet Union against Iran through the Pravda, organ of the Central Committee of the Soviet Communist Party, are regarded as serious warning to the Iranian Government.

The agency France Press adds that Soviet Prime Minister Kosygin notified the Iranian officials during the visit made by him to Iran in March last year his government's anxiety toward the huge arming of Iran by the United States.

World Solidarity With Our People's Revolution Demonstrated

So, our people raised the arms several times since the first moments in which the British landed in muscat and stationed their presence and turned it into a British colony spreading in it their bases and having control over everything. Our people were also realising thoroughly well the closer link between the traitorous al-Busaid family and the British presence.

This family has opened to doors of Orran for the grees of the colonialists and smash against the wall its history and the ambitoins and wishes of the Omani people and stood reluctantly against their wishes. This stirred the anger and wrath of all masses and the Omani national movement laid down on its shoulders the task of toppling down the al-Busaid family whose history is linked with the occupation and national subjugation and the sale of the Omani soil to the occupationists and the link of the struggle against the colonialists with the struggle for toppling down of the al-Busaid family to an extent that they cannot be separated.

The revolution of 9th June clearly expressed these national tasks since the first moments in which it started the struggle and declare that it will not abandon the arms before realising these legitimate objectives

Masses of our militant People, The British colonialists tried to confront the revolution of Gebel al-Akhdhar in 1957 and to end it with iron and fire and s o recruited thousands o f mercenaries and waged hundreds of military battles in DHOFAR. But the determination and insistance of the people to wrest victory from the colo-nialists camaged and destroyed a littlese bids and military getting out of the embarrassment in which they fell other than to carry out some repairs in Muscat and lay down new tactics for aborting the revolutionary current and pulling

away masses from the revolution.

In this way, a new hero was born for a stage play oftenly repeated in more than one area in the Gulf and British laid down the military, political and economic plans for repressing the Omani people and ending the armed revolution in Dhofar.

After the Qaboos stage play the foreign companies investments poured and the country was widely opened for the foreigners and the American and European oil companies were given extensive concessions for control of the fish and oil and looting the fish and agricultu-ral wealths. The military circles laid down many of the military plans for hitting the revolution from the inside and outside through the secessionist campaign in September, 1970 and the campaign of October-November 1971 to the campaigns of alammer and the Central and Western Regions. But the determination of the revolution to continue the struggle and to expose the Qaboos stage play as to heroically confront the military campaigns have all foiled these plans and placed the colonialist circles in a critical position.

We in the ninth anniversary of the revolution and after the failure of these plans and following the heroic confrontation by our people of Iranian invasion, we confirm and stress on the right of onr people to reject this puppet rule and the foreign presence and their right to raise the arms and continue the struggle against this puppet family and the British and Iranian presence.

The rulers of Muscat who did not hesitate to call the British fleets for hitting the fortresses of the revolutionaries of Oman throughout their black rule and did not hesistate now to recall the Iranian army after the Brit[‡]sh have failed to face the revolution proving to the entire world that they betraying the national soil and are prepared to committ national treason in order to safeguard their narrow interests and protect their collapsing rule.

We hold Qaboos and the traitorous clique in Muscat fully

historically and nationally responsible for the entry of the Iranian Army into the Omani territories and we see it part of our national and patriotic duty to fight for toppling down their rule and establishing a national regime protecting our sacred soil and safeguarding its prestige and independence. Our people reject all false allegations which justify the occupation by Iran of part of our homeland and the march of the Iranian army on the southern region of Oman and throw responsility for this criminal act on the revolution We regard this claims as a submissive and traitorous call aimed at forcing our people to bow to British colonialists and their servants in Muscat and an exposed justification for the national crime committed by Qaboos and his clique and which cannot be done except by the forces eager in the first place to crush the wish of our people and their ambitions and help the puppet regime in Muscat.

Our country is facing real danger at these decisive moments in its history more than any time before. The arena of Oman and the Arabian Gulf is dear to the imperialists and their monopolistic companies and to their pockets which are full of the wealths of our people and are very eager to stick to it and are ready to undertake extensive typical forfeitures and to establish weak councils in the Arabian Gulf States in order to str-

engthen these reactionary regime and legalise the conflicts in the area as well as to guarantee the Monopoly of oil and its marketing and play with the oil prices in order to gain imaginative profits.

The imperialists are working to re-arrange conditions i n these States. They established national councils, in these states at a time in which they were holding tens of detainees in the Bahrain prisons and in a state of emergency. They are now re-arranging conditions in North Oman at a time inwhich puppet regime in Abu Dhabi hands over the best Omani militants to the British intelligence in Muscat prior to holding new constitutional reforms in this artificial entity which was cut by the imperialists from Oman and established in it feudalism for the reationary sheikhs.

The increased importance of this area and in particular at the oil level, made the Americans give it increasing attention and plant in it and around it extensive nuclear military bases.

Moreover, the increase of the revolutionary activity in Oman and the failure of the British to face it, made the American peep their heads more increasingly through puppets in Teheran. In this way came the Iranian campaign under planning from the CENTO PACT circles and under direct supervision from the American Centrel Intellig-ence Agency and with full cooperation from the British circles in Muscat.

If we realise the basic enemy who faces our people and the peoples of the Middle East area, and resembled in the imperialists topped by American imperialism, we confirm the imperialist shape and role undertaken by Iran in our homeland and the extensive greeds to occupy more islands and territories and the despatch of more forces from its armies to the area in order to annex the Arab territories to the empire of Shah of

Iran and to deface the national entity of our homeland.

We discard all allegations and distorted defence undertaken by the puppet regime in Muscat to defend its Iranian masters as the Iranian army which occupies the Omani towns and camps in many descrt Areas in Dhofar, did not come to establish some of the development projects, nor did it come in the form of military experts or for performing certain tasks after which it will leave as it claims and some of the traiters claim in Muscat, but came as an invader and aggressor on our homeland and people and as part of an extensive plan of which the Shah of Iran dreams in order to kill and slay our people and liquidate their revolution.

Therefore, we regard the duty of our people to defend their homeland in the face of the British and Iranian aggression and to continue the struggle until the invaders are cleared ut and the national objectives of the people are realised.

The Iranian invasion and the Iranian greeds in the Arabian Gulf area aroused the enthusiasm of all national and progressive groups and aroused the enthusiasm of all national countries and the friendly countries which found in the Iranian step a danger threatening peace and security in the Arabian Gulf area and an interference rejected and refused by a 1 1 international laws and rules in the domestic affairs of our country.

The Arab League found that its national duty is to interfere to find our facts on the internal conditions of the al-Busaid Sultanate and the size of the foreign interference. So it sent a committee in this respect to Muscat.

We see that the basic task of the Arab League and the Arab countries is to work for checking off the Iranians and British from Oman by helping the revolu^tion and by regarding this help as a duty and national duty dictated by the supreme Arab interest. We also see that the Arab League has to expel the puppet regime from its galleries and to openly stand by the

Omani people. We refuse mediation with the traitorous regime in Muscat and affirm that the Qaboos clique is not but a tool in the hands of the British colonialists and their American allies who are administering the affairs in Oman. If we had fought thro-ugout the past years for realising objectives, national and democratic aims of our people the Iranian invasion then has added to our previous responsibility which we will not hesitate to confront whatever the sacrifices be and whatever be the difficulties to be faced by 115

Freedom Loving Forces Full Support Liberated Areas

Working Class Enemies Disguised As Defenders of Its Interests

The labour and mass movement is waging an inreasing sirruggle against the unions of the medieval ages and against their deeply-rooted reaction which worked to obstruct the lebour movement by giving way for side issues; such as mingling, the right of sects and the like; which inperial'ism was brilliant in using in more than one area in the world.

During the few weeks, contraclications sharply appeared within the ranks of the reactionary camp and t h e tribal authority as follows:

1) It appears that the general line followed by the Bahraini authority is guided by the instructions and recommendations brought by Amin Nakhla, delegate of the American Central Intelligence agency in 1972, as he recommended that the nececessity of absorbing the revolutionary labour movement through a reformatory plan based on reformatory and young elements from the ruling family and by depending upon a group of intellectuals marching in the American orbit. The American intelligence showed crown Prince Hamed bin 1ssa who i s these days paying visits to every labour strike and dstiributing free promises and introducing himself for opposition provided he adopts its projects. and agrees with it there are forces and elements which must be removed so that Bahrain marches on the plan of American renovations.

Since the Americans have the basic influence over matter of affairs through many corporations created by it after and before independence and as they have clearly laid down the thesis that they are cherishing peace and security in this very sensitive area, they are pushing things towards the grant of certain abdications and closure of aid to Bahrain so that it can absorb the labour wrath and uproot the negativisms of the British stage.

2) In confronting this current there appears the deeply sunk reactionary elements which played a filthy role against the massive movement and under the curtain of adhering to the Islamic religion and fighting imposterity and the like of such posters which the colonialist circles have been clever in giving prominence to These elements launched a campaign against the American attitude and perhaps those prominent men behind such reactionary attitude are Khaled bin Mohammad (who burnt the uniform of the National Scout of the Higher Executive Board in 1954) and Mohammad bin Salman who is staying at his headquaters at

Rifa with the aim of increasing the number of lands, horses and camels in his possession.

This reactionary attitude is depending upon the Saudi family which does not like any development of conditions in this Peninsula and fears from its effects on the eastern area; it is necessary to pay attention that there are wide contradictions inside the Saudi family, the deeply-sunk reactionary here enters into alliance with the deeply-sunk reactionary there.

3) The reactionary current inside the family finds its prev in the reactionary elements who include religious men and in particular some of the elements which were successful in the elections. These forces were astonished by the extensive uplift realised by the labour movement and the expansion of the class struggle and participation of extensive groups of the masses which take part in the race of the political activity. In the face of this uplift, numerous forces have entered into alliance which is made of the reactionary elements of religious men facade behind which it hides its distorted attempts to hit the labour movement and at the same time to safeguard the procession of the authority In such way, the reactionary attitude laid down the project of non-mingling in order to distort the labour movement and deviate the attention of the masses from the basic issues by stirring reactionary traditons planted by the Tukish and Brit-ish colonialism When this group found its failure in effecting the passage of such game, it organised roudy demonstrations with different trends with the misguided peasants.

Undoubtedly, such contradicions with in the ranks of the family and within the ranks of reaction must be exploited in order to expose position of the deeply-rooted reactionary forces so that the deeply - rooted reactionary attitude is defeated and the masses are freed from it. But this is connected with the ability of the national forces to understand the extent of the imperialist plan and the class and social forces upon whon it depends. Moreover the circles of imperialism do not work on the front of its allies only but also works to break the labour and mass movement at a time in which the need strengthens for unity and cohesion.

Perhaps the attempts or bids serving the plans of the authority is to create more than one trade Union organisation for the labour movement in the working utilities and distribution of charges against the revolutionary sides as well as to spread distortions amidst the labour ranks. Such a situation will be exploited by the authority more than any other thing for the following:

 When the majority of workers discover that a sharp conflict inside its ranks might abort the gain of one stage completely, not any reason but for an individual trend possessed by some national groups, in order to make many of the labour gatherings abandon to work.

The authorities will take from such bids a justification for not responding to the demands of the trade unions on the grounds that the workers are unripe.

3) Many of the elements of this authority will infiltrate inside

the labour movement in order to deepen contradiction o n completely union questions to ensure its control over this movement. We will not be revealing a secret if we say that the British intellingence sent a number of its elements on labour courses in order to become its tools in future inside the union movement.

The real understanding of the requirements of the current stage in Bahrain calls upon us to stand firmly against the deeply-rooted reactionary tide and to stand firmly against any secessionist bid inside the ranks of the labour movement. The matter requires the unity of the broadest masses and democratic forces in order to foil the plans of the puppet authority.

Iranian Fighters are Also Resolutely Resisting The Shah Reactionary Regime

The embargo policy followed by the Teheran regime and the huge efforts made by this regime for defacing the struggle of the Iranian people are of no avail any more as recently the Palestine news agency WAFA published reports on the military operations carried out by the Iranian revolutionaries against the Shah's regime.

The telephone cable between Teheran and the town of Creg was blasted up disturbing the business of the American factories in this area numbers a bout eleven.

As a result of this operation the factories were forced along with the Royal Sports Town to a telephone line temporarily replacing the blasted line.

— During the past two months, the revolutionaries carried out several operations for confiscating the weapons from the security and army forces. The operations ended with the death of some of the puppets and ensurance of weapons for the revolution.

— The revolutionaries managed during the repeated clashes with the regime's puppet to kill a number of police forces. Some of the militants were martyrised incling Youssef zerka (Asfahan) worker, Jawad Rabiee, worker and Ali Walli Boor (Teheran).

The importance gained by these operations is attributed to the fact that were carried out under very terroristic conditions and in a period in which the Savac and other repressive machineries are carrying out extensive repressive activities and are using methods of torture never known even in the prisons of fascism and in a stage in which the regime with all its weight and conspiracies, is being backed by its imperialist and zionist masters to knock down the struggles of the revolutionaries. For this reason, the puppet Shah-in-Shah regime brought modern equipment and started to use new methods of torture and terrorism, namely to catch hostages from the children and woman and aged people in order to force the militants to hand themselves over. To beat with whips every person suspected of sympathising with the revolution not to announce the arrest of the captive militants. There are many militants who were arrested a year ago and their relatives know nothing about their fate. Also, martyrdom under torture became something ordinary and the last to be martyrised under the savage torture faced by the militants included Shamaned Khastah, Khalil Tabatabai, Ride Dubiah and Dhia al-Haq. In addition, the Helmets covering the head so that the shouts of the prisoner are not heard under torture and reflect the shouts of the prisons back to his ears standing as another way of torture. These helmets are equipped with electrical instruments connected with the nose, ear and tongue and shake the prisoner with electrical shocks to pave for the abosrption of blood.

The Arab Press Comments On Arab League Comission Assignment

The Arab Press continued to newspaper said: The regime is will weaken the acceptance of analyse and comment on the assignment of the Arab League Commission for fact finding conditions in the Sultanate of the British.

On this topic, the Lebanese newspaper "Addiyar" worte in its of 20th May:

"The movement of the Arab League came after the failure of the Sultanate of Oman and Iran and the British forces to knock down the revolution. On the situation lived by the hireling regime in Muscat, the now living in an atmosphere of great failure which it suffered in spite of the British and Iranian aid. This is in a addition to its failure to sell itself to the Omani public opinion as a reformaory successor to its predecessor Sultan Said bin Tamour. The newspaper gathered that such weakness will make Qaboos accept what the newspajer called mediation, but the newspaper said: T h e insistance of Britain n o t to withdraw from its military basaes in the Sulanate of Oman Qaboos.

The newspaper warned the Arab League Commission from the tricks of the Muscat Regime and said: "the revolution which did not abandon the arms will continue to hurl its enemies with the Clashinkov rockets and other developed weapons which will exhaust the forces of the Sultan and the British and Iran in other areas to be added to the liberated areas"

The Lebanese al-Destour newspaper of 20th May also

wrote saying: Mahmood Riad. not knowing it before, was surprised at the airport and streets of Oman and Muscat with men adorning the military uniform but not related to the A r a b nation. He heard them talk the Iranian language a n d the Pakistani language and heard the others speak English. Uudoubtedly during his tour in Muscat and Oman he also heard those speaking the Saudi accent.
