PREFACE

It also aspires to conduct cyclical updating of these abstracts whenever and wherever financial means allow. Notwithstanding the difficulties, the process of updating provides a useful tool to measure the changes which are taking place in the Occupied Territories.

## INTRODUCTION

This statistical abstract is constructed from a small portion of the non-agricultural and non-agrarian data gathered as part of a regional development study of the north Jordan Valley undertaken by ALMULTAQA (Arab Thought Forum - Jerusalem) during 1983. The census conducted by ALMULTAQA covered the villages of Bardala, 'Ain al Beda, Marj Najeh, Zbeidat, Jiftlik, Frush Bet Dajan and 'Ain Shibli. In making this data available, al Multaqa hopes to provide reliable quantitative data - on population, living conditions, housing, literacy, education and the general employment pattern - which might be of interest to development field workers, researchers, academics and Palestinian institutions.

The material presented in this abstract covers data produced from sections A, B, C and G of the north Jordan Valley regional census undertaken by ALMULTAQA during 1983. Section A took the form of a demographic census sheet which was administered to all adult household members (15 years plus) and solicited information on village, sex, age, marital status, clan, education, literacy and work. Section B was a census sheet designed to collect information on family size, birth rates and infant mortality rates. This census sheet was administered to all women members of the household with children. Section C was a housing census sheet which was designed to gather data on housing conditions, sanitary conditions, house ownership, domestic supply of electricity and water, and the ownership of consumer durables. This section was administered to the female head of household. Section G was a census sheet on work history designed to solicit information on the work sector, work category and length of time worked in each sector. This section was administered to all members of the household engaged

in waged employment.

The questionnaire was pre-tested in the village of 'Ain Dyuk in the Jericho region of the Jordan Valley. Because of time constraints, the questionnaire was post-coded and the field survey was undertaken during April to May 1983. The interview response rate was exceptionally high at 99% and only four households in the whole region refused to be interviewed.

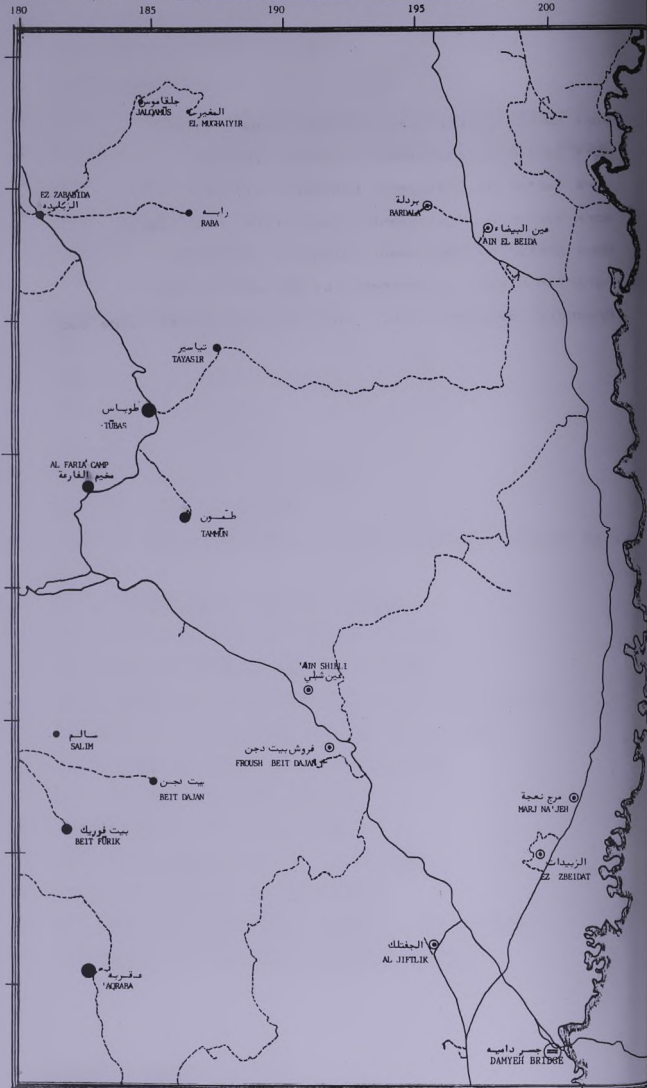

## المقدمة

لقد جرى بناء هذه الخلاصة الإحصائية من جزء مفصّل من المعلومات فسر الزراعة التي جرى جمعها كجزء من دراسة تنموية إقليمية للغور الشمالي قام بها الملتقى خلال العام ١٩٨٣. وقد غطي التعداد الذي قام به الملتقى قري بردلة، عين البياض، مرج نعجة، الربيدات، الجفلك، قروشيت دونه، وعين شبي، وفي نشره لهذه المعلومات يحسن الملتقى التي توفّر معلومات موشوقة ذات عفا كمية (السكان، الأحوال المعيشية، السكن، معرفة القراءة والكتابة، التعليم ونمط العمالة العام) تحقّق باصتدام العاملين في مجال التنمية، والباحثين والأكاديميين والمؤسسات الفلسطينية.

إن العادة المقدمة في هذه الخلاصة تغطي المعلومات التي جرى استخراجها من الأقسام (أ، ب، ج، ز) من التعداد الإقليمي المشار إليه. وقد اتخذ القسم (أ) شكل نموذج تعداد ديموغرافي جرى إمراره على جميع أفراد وحدة السكن البالغين (١٥ سنة فما فوق) وتم من خلاله جمع معلومات عن القرية، الجنس، العمر، الوضع العائلي (متزوج أو أعزب)، المحوّل، التعليم، معرفة القراءة والكتابة، والعمل، وأما القسم (ب) فقد صمّم لجمع معلومات عن النساء في العائلة مع الأطفال، وكان القسم (ج) استبياناً تعدادياً عن السكن جرى إعداده لجمع معلومات عن أحوال السكن، النظافة الصحية، ملكية المسكن، توصيل الكهرباء، والماء للبيت وملكية الأجهزة الاستهلاكية المعصرة. وجرى تطبيق هذا الاستبيان على الأثنى ربة المائلة فقط في وحدة السكن، وجرى صياغة ورقة من قسم (ز) حول تاريخ العمل بغرض جمع معلومات عن قطاع العمل، نوع العمل وطول فترة العمل في كل قطاع، وقد جرى تطبيق هذا القسم على جميع أفراد وحدة السكن العاملين في نطاق العمل المأجور.

هذا وجرى اختبار الاستبانة في قرية عين الديوك في منطقة أريحا في غور الأردن، وبسبب ضيق الوقت فقد تمت فحصة الاستبانة وتم إجراء التعداد خلال الفترة من نيسان (أبريل) إلى أيار (مايو) ١٩٨٣، وقد كانت الاستبانة للتعداد عالية بشكل استثنائي. فقد وصلت النسبة إلى ٩٩% من المجموع، ولم يتخلف عن الإجابة على الأسئلة المعطوطة إلا شاذلي أربع وحدات سكن.

## تمهيد

يعرّف الملتقى الفكري العربي - القدس باعتزاز المجموعة الأولى من الجداول الإحصائية التي قام بجمعها وضمها عن منطقة الغور الشمالي في القلعة الغربية لشهر الأردن، ويستبع هذه المجموعة بمجموعات أخرى تلقى الضوء على الوضع في تلك المنطقة.

يأمل الملتقى أن يسهم بعمله هذا في بناء قاعدة معلومات موشوقة ومناسبة عن الأرض المحتلة توفّر الأساس الموضوعي لصياغة استراتيجيات تنموية ملائمة لظروفها، وبناء على ذلك فهو يأمل بأن تتاح له الفرصة لتوثيق خبرته التي اكتسبها من تجربته في الغور الشمالي للقيام بمسوح إحصائية مماثلة في مناطق أخرى من الضفة الغربية وقطاع غزة.

وأيماننا من الملتقى بقيمة ما يوفّره التحديث الدوري للمعلومات الإحصائية التي ينشرها من مساهمة هامة ومفيدة في قياس التغيرات التي تحدث في الأراضي المحتلة، فإنه يأمل باستنجان هذه المهمة كلنا وجد التشجيع وتوفرت لديه امکانات العالبة التي تسمح له بالقيام بهذه المهمة.
