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During the World Peace Council meetings convened in Sofia from the 16th to 20th of Feb, 1974, the Council condemned the military invasion launched by the Iranian forces against the liberated areas of our homeland.

Meanwhile, the Arab countries delegations taking part in the meetings strongly condemned in their speeches the Iranian Regime and its aggressive and expansionist policy in the Arab World, and in particular, in the Arabian Gulf.



## Qaboos Confesses Iranian Invasion & Shah Insists On MORE INTERVENTION

### Gulf Regimes Desperately Attempt to Mask Their Yielding Attitudes

### PLA Confrontation Intensified While Enemies Resort to Barbaric Acts Against People

Statements by the officials in the Gulf regimes followed during the recent period following the Iranian Military invasion of Oman uselessly

want to clear the responsibility of the regimes for plotting against the Omani people and for backing the puppet regime in Muscat and in other words to put their hands in the hand of the Iranian invader against our people.

...The chain of such statements started with a statement by Abdul Aziz Hussein, Kuwaiti Minister of State. In reply to a question by the patriot Deputies in the National Assembly on whether his government knew the Iranian invasion of Oman, he replied: "My government does not know about the invasion and that it does not approve an Iranian invasion of any Arab country."

His Government does not know about the invasion at a time in which a military spokesman in Muscat announced that the Iranian forces are taking part in the campaign amount to 1,500 soldiers and officers equipped with thirty helicopters and military frigates.

The government of Abdel Aziz Hussein, thus, does not approve any Iranian invasion of any Arab country and we do not know if it regards Oman as an Arab country or not?

If Oman is an Arab country what the Kuwaiti Government did to oppose such invasion?

As to the officials in the Federation of Emirates against whom the charge was directed of taking part in the crime as it became known that the Emirate States brought parts of their forces to inner Oman to protect the background of the mercenary army and Abu Dhabi supplies the Sultanate with assistance amounting to 25 million dollars in 1973. These officials who regard themselves as Omanis found themselves inside the cage of accusation because they are taking part in a huge operation aiming at destroying the will of the

Omani people and occupying their territories through the biggest foreign force.

For this reason Seif Al-Ghabashi, Minister of State for Foreign Affairs in the State of Arab Emirates, made a statement in which he said:-

"Our assistance to Oman is confined to the fields of education and real building. As to its political affairs, these do not concern us."

How can we believe that the political affairs of the Sultanate do not concern the State of Emirates? Then, why tens of Omanis who were arrested by the British intelligence in the Federation were handed over to the reactionary authorities in Muscat, And why the Federal Army entered Adhahirah area during the campaign of arrests and terrorism in December, 1972 and the beginning of 1973? And why the army of Zaid

came into the Western Region to catch the revolutionaries and place the chain in their hands?

Also, why non-interference in the political affairs of the Sultanate becomes a theme in the light of Iranian interference? Does silence not indicate to such interference?

It quite blesses it and contributes practically in slaying and killing our people and smearing the soil of the homeland of which we regard this State as part of it.

The political imposture exercised by the officials in the State of Emirates and other Gulf States and the bid to wash their hands from the blood of the Omani people will be of no avail.

They are deeply sunk in national treason and have sold their homeland cheap to the Iranian invaders and

The mine was planted by a group of the engineering unit of the People's Liberation forces operating in the Central Region.

1) On 23rd January, the enemy advanced from his positions in the north to the "Morban Wazik" highlands in the Red Line. # What are the Bahrain's Regime Aims Behind Arrests of Workers?

## American Planes For Iran, Saudi Arabia & South Vietnam

It is understood from an official source in Washington that the United States of America will start with effect from this February to introduce fighter planes of the F5E type to Iran, the Saudi Arabian Kingdom and South Vietnam. Iran will also buy during the next few months more than two hundred American fighters of modern manufacture. All these three countries will secure a total of 330 of the F5E type and MATCH 6,1 which is named TIGER 2, which is the developed type of the F5A which was given to more than fifteen friendly countries by the United States of America during the past years. Iran will get 150 TIGER 2 planes. Iran officially asked from the United States of America last month to be supplied with thirty fighter planes from the naval aircraft of the F14 type which are equipped with rockets of the Vinks type.

It is understood from the same source its intention to buy about 53 planes of the F15. It is understood that the cost of thirty planes of the F14 type amounts to 900 million dollars and that the 53 planes F15, swing-wing, will cost more than one milliard dollars.

It is worth recalling that these two planes, which are signified by air supremacy, and have a super-sonic speed, will have the American naval air force and the American air force supplied with huge quantities during the forthcoming years. Iran will also start to be supplied with such type of aircraft after that by several months. While waiting for such shipments the Iranian airforce will receive about 140 Phantom F-4 planes, the fighter planes used by the American air and naval force for several years.

The Saudi Arabian Kingdom asked

for about thirty F-5 aircraft amounting in value each to 1,600,000 dollars. The date of the contract concluded in this connection goes back to before the October war at a time in which the United States of America was thinking of selling TIGER 2 and F-14 aircraft to the Saudi Arabia.

But the opposition of the American Government to obtain such aircraft

on sale for a foreign country was fixed at thirty aircraft of the F-5-E type which is the number sought by Saudi Arabia and submitted to the American Pentagon. As to the 150 of this type of aircraft it has been decided to supply South Vietnam with the same number of F-5-A aircraft.

## ARRESTS & TRIALS OF WORKERS IN BAHRAIN

It was supposed to hold on Wednesday 6.2.74 the trial of fourteen of our brave workers in Bahrain on the charge of obstructing traffic. The trial was adjourned until another date.

Two weeks ago, workers demonstration came out to ream the streets of Manamah against unemployment which is being suffered by more than 3,000 workers and against the worsening living conditions lived by our working class. The demonstration also demanded suspension of tracing the workers by the authority and to allow the workers to form trade unions for them to defend their interests. The government allowed the workers to demonstrate after they have submitted a request to it. After the demonstration, the government launched a campaign of arrests on the ground of disturbances caused by the workers and obstruction of the traffic during the demonstration. The government promised to submit the workers responsible for such acts to trail. Of course the authority did not find an excuse other than this.

Other wise how it will justify its barbaric acts which tally with its democracy.

The Sultanate cannot abandon its repressive role against our Bahraini masses and in particular the workers, and it can exercise it in one way or another under its fake democracy. It allows the demonstration and then it follows and creates weak reasons in order to launch an arrest campaign and to use its democratic institutions to approve such barbaric acts under weak excuses. Therefore, our workers must not be deceived by this authority and its democratic institutions because they are the institutions of the authority - the colonialist authority - aiming basically at redressing the breaking of the masses and serving their imperialist masters. They will remain so whatever shapes and democratic forms it tried to give to itself through the establishment

of corporations such as the National Assembly. It is the same authority that broke the workers uprising in 1938 and the uprisings of our people in 1954, 1956 and in March, 1965 March 1972 and in 1973 but in another and better form.

The authority aims behind the latest arrest campaign against workers at wresting the labour leadership at this stage and throwing the leaders of the workers in prisons in the name of the democracy invented by the authority through its institutions prior to establishing during the forthcoming days the workers unions it deems fit. The workers unions appear weak and this is what the authority wants to realise behind the arrest of the workers.

## INDIAN OCEAN THREATENED BY AMERICAN DOMINATION

The United States of America is continuing its provocations against the security and safety of the peoples living around the Indian Ocean by planting more military bases in this ocean. Recently, the United States concluded a deal with Britain providing for hiring the "Samoa island" belonging to Britain and situated in the Indian Ocean. It will be used as a base for the Seventh Fleet which is reaming in this ocean in heavy manner. The base will cover submarines of the Polaris type equipped with nuclear-guided missiles. .... Such heavy military presence is regarded to be directed basically against our homeland and threatens the peace and security of our peoples in addition to threatening the security and peace in the Indian Ocean and the entire world.

The United States is working continuously to challenge the will of freedom and peace-loving forces in the world which called for the necessity of leaving the Ocean free from any bases or colonialist presence.

## 8000 IRANIAN SOLDIERS IN OMAN

The British officers working in the Qaboos mercenary army affirmed that the strength of the Iranian military forces in Oman amounts to

eight thousand soldiers from the infantry supported by armoured, helicopters equipped with rockets and military frigates.

The officers said: "The Iranian forces taking part in the fighting and constitute the spearhead in the operating at present taking place in the Red Line, are estimated at 3,000 soldiers reinforced by the armoured, heavy artillery and helicopters equipped with rockets.

The special forces also confirmed that the forces of the Federal Emirates are at present stationed in different parts of the Sultanate of Oman to protect the background of the mercenary army of Qaboos and to detect any activity that might be carried out by the People's Front in other areas in Oman.

However, the Shah of Iran confirmed once again his complete preparedness to respond to any request for help by the reactionary authorities in the Gulf in the event the security of these regimes face danger like the danger now suffered by the Sultanate of Oman.

This confirmation came in a statement made by the Shah of Iran to the British Daily Telegraph and quoted by the Agence France Press 8.2.74.

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## WITHOUT COMMENT

"Our Omani armed forces recently opened the road between Thamreet and Sallalah", statement by the Ministry of Information of the Sultanate on January, 1974.

"We extended to the Sultan of Oman the aid and assistance required by him. The Iranian infantry realised glory when they opened last month the road of Dhofar lying between Sallalah and Muscat of which the rebels and insurgents were occupying part."
