# MILITARY REPORT FROM MILITARY COMMUNIQUE NO. 468-478/73 ISSUED BY THE FORCES OF THE PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ANNY

### DHOFAR REGION

During the period between 5th October to 12th November, the forces of the People's Liberation Army and the People's Militia launched several successful operations on the centres of the colonialist and reaction ry enemy and his positions in the outhern Region of Oman(Phofar). These operations concentrated on al-Mammar and the Wester, Eastern and Central Regions during which our forces inflicted upon the enemy heavy losses in life, positions and military installations. The following are details of these operations:-

### LL-MAMMAR:

On 12th November, our forces shelled the energy positions at Abu Khuseifa in al-Mammar using artillery for thirty five minutes during which they destroyed for positions of the energy. The energy was seen evacuating four casualties between killed and wounded. Our forces returned safely to base.

### WESTERN REGION - NORTH SARFEET

On 2nd November at six thirty in the morning our forces launched an attack on the positions of the enemy in North Sarfeet using medium and light weapons reinferced by nortars for half an hour during which three enemy positions were destroyed and a number of enemy members were killed and injured. Our forces saw during the attack the enemy members escaping from theirpositions as a result of the greatness of our blows. The following day the suiping group of ours managed to snipe six enemy members between killedand wounded in North Sarfeet. On 9th November at eight thirty in the morning our forces shelled with artillery the enemy positions in North Sarfeet for half an hour during which they destroyed six enemy positions and injured several enemy penbers not assessed yet. It nine in the morning on the same day the sniping group managed to kill two enemy members while carrying out a sniping operation against the enemy members in the same position. The group returned safely to base.

### EASTERN REGION:

### BRAVE MARTYRS SALEM MOHAMMAD ATTAMEEL AND SAMED SUHALL AZM'S PERATION:

On 7th November at nine in the norning our forces operating in the Eastern Regionlaunched an attack on the enemy centre at Shirkh using morters and heavy artillery and machine-guns from all directions for half an hour. British planes carryied out a bid during the attack to check off the attack of our revolutionaries. These aircraft combed the nearby area indiscriminately resulting in the burning of wide grazing areas. Inony losses during this attack included the destruction of two positions completely and the death and injury of five members.

Cur losses were none.

### CENTRAL REGION:

In the CentralRegion our forces carried out seven successful operations on the enemy centres athshiralth and hadabet Asheikh. 6a 5th 13th and 14 October our forces launched four attacks on the enemy centre at hiralth north of the British air base at Sallalah using machine-guns and nortars. Our forces managed during these attacks to destroy several enemy positions and to injur a number of enemy nembers. From our side no casualties were incurred. On 8th and 13th October our forces launched three attacks on the enemy centre attached a sheik using light and medium weapons for an intermitent period during which our forces managed to kill and ound nine enemy members. In view of the heaviness of our blows the enemy centred the area with his incendiary and destructive bombs resulting in the burning of some grazing places. But there were no casualties on our side.

### TOTAL ENEMY LOSSES:

- 1) Death andinjury of 32 enemy members
- 2) Destruction of fifteen positions completely
- 3) There were some casualties which were not assessed yet.

Our Losses during these operations:

1) Burning of wide areas of grazing places.

### EIGHTH INTERN TICNAL UNION CONFERENCE CONDEMNS SAVAGE ACTS BY BAHRAINI GOVERNMENT

The Fight World UnionConforence which was held in Varna in the People's Republic of Bulgaria addressed during the period 15th-22nd October, 1973 a message to the Council of Ministers in Bahrain which contained condemnation by the conference of the repressive acts exercised by the reactionary Bahraini authorities against the unionist and denocratic militants and declared its solidarity with the working class and people of Bahrain.

The message also asked the release of the members of the constituent Committee of the workers and all detaineds immediately and to bring back the exiled to their homeland and to give due respect to the World Labour agreements and restoration of the union freedoms and rights to the workers of Bahrain.

### OPEN MANOUEVRES BY PIECES OF AMERICAN FLEET IN BAHRAIN

After the declaration by the pupper Govern ent of Behrain to abolish the agreement for the hire of al-Jufeir base to the Seventh Fleetof America, the American fleet carried out open maneuevres. Command vessel "Lassal" left the Base to the Gulf on 26th October, 1973, while arriving on the same day to "ulciman port the rocket carrier "Miksendles" where it stayed for six days. After its departure a destroyer carrying the No. 1630 arrived. After that "Lassal" came again to take up position beside this destroyed at Sulciman port.

## PRESS STATEMENT ON ALLEGATIONS BY SULTANATE'S DEPUTY DEFENCE MINISTER

Puppet Fahr bim TaimourDp. Defence Minister in the Sultanate of Oman held a press conference in which he alleged the following:-

- 1) That an aircraft of the air force of the People's Democratic Republic of Yemen raided centres belonging to the puppet Sultanate,
- 2) That the artillery of Democratic  $^{\rm Y}$ enen shelled Sarfeet centre which lies in the borders of Cman from the town of Hoff which is situated in Democratic Yenen.
- 3) That the forces of Democratic Yenen take part with the forces of the People's Front against the forces of the Sultanate in Dhofar.

Iny observer having the slightest fraction of objectivity, need not discover the contradiction between the talk of the Deputy Defence Minister of Sultanate and his reactions in the face of the objective facts.

- 1) The western Region of Dhofer, like other rural areas which were completely freed by the People's Liberation army, lies under the control and authroty of the Feople's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian Gulf and the Sultanate has not but a military controbesieged in Sarfeet. Therefore the talk about the attack by a Yemeni plane is a mere allegation hiding behind it pre-planned aggressive intentions.
- 2) The forces fighting the British invading forces, the mercenaries of Qaboos, the special Iranian forces and the Jordanian officers are the fighters of the People's Liberation 1. rmy and the People's Militia in accordance with the admission of Qaboos himself on more than one occasion. These fighters were always described by him as rebels whom he specified on several occasions as minor individuals. The latest official statement by him with this meaning was that made to the presence in London in the beginning of September. So how the lumps of communists as admitted by Qaboos and the British Defence Secretary Carrington in the British Parliament turned into regular forces of Democratic Yenen.
- 3) The Sarfeet camp, which it established, is a centre directed against the nationals and citizens whether Yemeni or Cammi as admitted by the British officers themselves who work in the camp when they had an interview with the British television. The officer, who served in Northern Ireland, said in reply to a question on the difference between Treland and Sarfeet, that in Ireland there exists friends for the British army while no friend exists in this area. So we open fire in all directions and any one visiting Hof will see the practical results of such operations existing in the shelling of houses of Yemeni citizens in Hoff and its surroundings.

These false allegations are nothing but justifications for lounching a new attack on the Feople's Democratic Republic of Yemen. Such talk is not mere speculation but it is depending upon provious experiences and follow up of the aggressive behaviour of the British officers who lead such aggressive war.

The savage aggression on Hef and the nearby reas on 18th May, 1972 by the British directft and the barbaric shelling by the long-range artillery of the Sultanate and the naval floots of the Sultanate which it bought fromSouth Africa and which carry out daily provocative acts against Democratic Tenen, were preceded by similar allegations.

We expect, after the defeats received by the Sultanate's Army and Pritish officers repeatedly at the hands of the People's Liberation Army and the People's Militia, that the Pritish and their puppet Qaboos are to Launch a new attack on the Yemeni territories.

Morecover, the submission of a complaint by the Sultanate against the People's Democratic Republic of Yenen in the United Nations and the Arab Deague is only a nanouvere behind which it hides in order to launch an attack on the Teople's Democratic Republic of Yenen.

The People's Front for the Liberation of Oman and the Arabian ulf draws the attention of the Arab and world public opinions to the seriousness of such statements and regard them as preludes for aggressions against the People's Democratic Republic of Yomen. Therefore, the People's Front asks the forces of progress and peace in the world to firmly confront and expose such allegations.

### NEW MINISTERIAL RESHUFFLE MADE BY BRITLIN IN MUSCAT

The colonialist authorities in Muscat made a Ministerial reshuffle in the puppetQaboos government. Under such reshuffle two new Ministries were created. The cabinet was also entered by three new puppets. Two Ministries were Information and Development were established. The Cabinet was entered for the first time by three Ministers. They are Karim Ahmed al-Harmi, who is appointed as Minister of Development, Feisal bin Ali, former "mbassader of the Sultanate in Washington, appointed as Minister of Education and Qais "bdul Moneim Azzawawi was appointed as Foreign Minister in place of Fahd bin Mahmood who was appointed Minister of Information and Tourism.

Such Ministerial reshuffle is regarded as a victory for the Tareq wing who was removed from the Premiership as he was representing the current of neo-colohialism and the forces of American imperialism and West Germany. The return of such men to such current is regarded as a result of the failure of the policies of the wing of Qabous. It also represents victory for the American plan which will make all parties of imperialism get their share of Oman and use the psychological warfare and reforms to pull the carpet from under the revolution.

#### NEW AMERICAN PLANES FOR BAUDI ARABIA

At a time in which the UnitedStates of America established a huge air bridge with the task of supplying Israel with nodern and griking weapons to compensate, as it was said, the heavy losses incurred by it during therecent war, and a t a time in which it was said that Saudi Arabia dropped its political, economic and military weight in the battle against Isr el, and at a time in which it stated that Saudi Arabia stopped the pumping of oil to the United States of America, it was announced that the American air force will deliver jet fighters of the "F5B" to the Saudi Arabia. What does this mean?

# BRITISH INTELLIGENCE TRAIN GROUP OF TUPIETS TRICK TO TAKING THEM INTO THE INTELLIGENCE MACHINERY

### FORMATION OF COMMITTEE IN SUPPORTOF REVOLUTION IN CMAN AND AR BIAN GULF AND YEMEN IN AMERICAN UNITERSITY IN BEIRUT

- 6) To take part in exhibitions.

To collect financial donations through the sale of the front magazines and literatures and collection of medicines and medical equipment etc. The committee went to the asses of the students in the university in order to understand the cause and issue of the revolution in Yemen, Oman and the Gulf and to heighten activity for backing it through activity for the consolidation of the armed revolution and extension of constant and effective aid in all fields as well as to give prominence to its victories and successes realised by the revolution during the confrontation of imperialism and reaction as well as to expose and reveal the foreign interference in the area and its storges including the area reactionary rulers and to expose the terroristic and repressive compaigns and the campaigns of arrests consecutively carried out against the citizens in the arena of Yenen, onan and the Gulf.

### PRES INTERVIEW - Cont'd from last Issue

- Q3) What is the echo left by the armed revolution which is led by the People's Front in the progressive centres in Lebanon and in particular and the Lebanese masses ingeneral?

of the organisational tool which is the People's Front, this tool which is equipped with the revolutionary theory is the success of the revolutionary movement which is being realised and realised every moment victory upon another.

The most honourable revolution waged today in the world and in the arena of the ...rab bomeland is the revolution which is represented by the leople's Front inDhofar and which is represented by the national liberation movements waged by all revolutionary forces in the countries of the Third World which suffer from subjugation and oppression from imperialism, and its allies and stooges including feudalist and reactionary rulers. ### STATEMENT ON AMERICAN PEACE CONFERENCE

Our Militant Masses,

The Arab National Liberation Movement topped by the Palestinian revolution is facing these days an imperialist attack through the extensive American novements and proposals coupling them that may lead in the event of their acceptance to imposition of a state of a surrender on the Arab peoples and negligence of the rights of the Palestinian to liberate completely their homeland and establish the democratic PalestinianState. This means imposition of a merican control over theArabeountries.

It was clear since the be inning that Americanimperialism aims at spreading its influence on this strategic area which is rich with oil and to tighten the insubordination of the Arab countries to American imperialism by the imposition and protection of reactionary and puppet regimes on them. There was no need to proof that the basic enemy of the peoples, the rab peoples, is American imperialism and that what is needed is the mobilisation of all naterial and human resources in order to confront the imperialist enemy and his tools in the Arab area and to prepare the popular masses and to equip and arms them in order to wage the long-term popular war against the -merican enemy and his bases and stooges in the area. It was proved during the recent war that the UnitedStates considers Israel as its thick stick with which to beat the Arabpeoples and to obstruct their procession, uplift and progress. The United States is extending to its base all military, political and economic needs and it is impossible to separate between the struggle against the Israeli aggression and the Israel sectarian entity and the struggle against the American imperialist presence as it proved through thewar that the brave Arabarnies and the hereic ralestinian resistance are capable of directing huge blows to the Israeli enemy and realise glittering military victories over them and destroy the legend on its supremacy. The Arabmasses also proved their completely preparedness to accept all required sacrifices for waging the long-term popular war whose aim is not to disturb the state of no-war andno-peace and not to submit and move the issue to the .mericans for their comment, but sins at destroying the imperialist interests and causing fundamental change in the balance of power in the interests of the ...rabnational liberation movement through which it is possible to impose condition on the imperialist enony as it happened in viotnam. But the imperialist circles which want to abort the Arab national liberationnovement and to massacre the Palestinian resistance as well as to spread up their influence in an extensive manner in the arch area, moved swiftly submitting proposal after proposal to prove that the Americans are the sole lever capable of forcing Israel to withdraw and that to open the doors widely for them and to throw confidence in them, will make them press on Israel to withdraw from theterritories occupied in 1967. Such a locsing bet is not at all separate from the lessons of the past six years but prove the extent reached by some irabregimes.

The People's Front for the Liberation of Uman and the Trabian Gulf pointed out that the imperialists do not want any good for curArab peoples but want to impose their influence on our countries and to continue to loot our oil wealths and to establish the positions of their merctionary allies and Zionist tools in the Arab area. It also clearly pointed out that the Americans want to control the Arab oil and have complete influence on it and for this they push Israel towards launching an aggression after another in order to create more mercentry armies to fight the progressive regime inDemocratic Yenen and intimicate their stooges inTeheran, and Jordan to send their armies to Muscat for

fighting the armed revolution in Oman. The nature of the Arab interests and their contradiction with the interests of the Arab masses call upon us to wage a war against the aggressors in our honoland and those running after our wealths and it is impossible to surrender our destiny to the "moricans for deciding the nature of peace they want to impose on the Arab nation, but we hust strengthen and deepen relations with the friendly forces and countries which stood by the side our our just struggle in all crises.

Frunhere enanates the seriousness of all settlements, and projects laid down by the Americans for imposing their peace on the area through the conference proposed to be held next month. We see that the proposed conference cannot at all be a conference for peace but will be a conference for surrender and a start for implementing all imperialist projects to liquidate the Falestinian issue. Its effects will have and serious on the armed revolution in Onen and the progressive regime in Democratic Yenen and all revolutionary and national forces and the national Arab countries hestile to American imperialism. The area will witness a great increase in the reactionary attacks backed by the Americans to spread up their influence on the Arab area taking advantage of their cil potentialities and the political tricks they exercise on other Arab regimes.

The conference which the emericans want is only one of the rings of the American plan in the area and if its dangerousness to the Palestinian issue is appearing clear to the eyes, we wish to point to its dangerousness to the armed revolution in our honeland and the liberation movement in the Arabian Peninsula. The imperialists and reactionaries are now moving at the level of the Arabian Peninsula teliquidate the positions of the revolution there and to east the Saudi reactionary influence on the entire area. The pupper Qaboos regime wants to distort the masses and make them pull away from the revolution by appearing in the form of the person eager about the Palestinian question through his information support which is supervised by the nercenaries of the Jordanian regime in order to hide the increasing imperialist penetration in Oman and his increasing reliance on the Iranian throne and permission to the foreign countries to interfere in the internal affairs of Oman to protect his collapsing throne. At the same he is escalating his military campaigns and barbaric shelling on the liberated areas aiming at liquidating the revolutionin the southern region and tightoning the fence of enslavement on the entire Omani people.

However, Saudi reaction is becoming active to occupy advance positions through financial aid and its oil role to establish the position of the reactionaries in the other Arab countries and to chase the national and progressive forces and to liquidate them so that the political map of the Arab countries is attached to the Saudi Arabia or close to it.

When it failed in the field of political tricks, it recruited armies and mercenaries to thwart the progressive regime in penceratic Yenon and exercises an ugly policy to confront the notionalist and revolutionary forces in the north of Yenon and reinforces its positions in the emirates of the irabian fulf. Studi reactions now trying to convince its American masters of its ability to play a great role in the irabian fulf area instead of Iran. To explain the dangerousness of the emerican plan in the southern ir bian reminsula, the colonialist authorities in Muscat hint on an aggression against Democratic Yemen under false allegations and at the same time Saudi irabia recruits thousands of mercenaries to attack Democratic Yemen.

### AMERICAN PEACE CONFERENCE - Cent'd.

In the face of such plans, the People's Front for the Liberation of Cman and the Arabian Gulf sees that the phasical tasks are as follows:-

- 1) The revolutionary and nationalist forces and the Arab national regimes are to reject the American surrender conference and the results obtained from this conference which will not at all be in the interest of the Arab national liberation movement.
- 2) The revolutionary and nationalist forces and the arab regimes are to launch an extensive campaign to expose this plan and its aims and to nobilise the broad Arabnasses for rejecting the emerican solutions and to launch further politica, military and massive struggles in order to foil these imperialist plans.
- 3) To affirm that the armod Palestinian resistance is the sole and legitimate representative of the Palestinian people and that the revolutionary and nationalist forces and the rab national regimes are to consolidate the resistance and pretect it against the criminal plans which are being weven against them for liquidating them and to open the Arab fronts for it to continue the armed struggle against the Israeli racial entity.
- 4) To affirm that the American solutions do not aim only against the Palestinian issue but also the Arab national liberati movement as a whole, and in other words needs strong cohesion and unity between the groups of the Arab revolutionary movement in order to check off the imperialist attack andnot to allow the Saudi reactionary attack to realise its greeds which serve the American imperialists.

#### Cur Militant masses.

The imperialists, reactioneries and Lionists want to liquidate the gains of the historical stage entirely and to realise what they have failed to realise throughout the past quarter century and to place the arab masses under the emerican, Zionist and reactionary trustoeship. In other words we are required to be alert and greatly aware of this and not to be deceived by such plans and to work swiftly and actively for foiling these plans. Since all reactionary and submissive regimes work to isolate the arab masses from this issue, the nationalist and revolutionary forces are required to mobilise the broadest masses and put them in the struggle against such plans.

Let the unity of the revolutionary and nationalist forces be consolidate and let us struggle to push out the peace of the Americans and Zionists.

### SHECTING DOWN AN ENEMY HELICOPTER.... ENEMY GIVES FALSE EXCUSE

The client enemy spkesman confessed through Balala Radio on 14/11/73 !he shot down of one of the army helecopter and the death of its British pilot and his assistant to the north of Beit Zarbeeg in The Mid Region.

Thee enemy spokesman reasoned the fall down of the helicppter due to mechanical fault.

the region in which the helicopter was shot is under the centrol of The People Liberation Army. This false excuse reminds us of a similler one; that is colliding with a mountain, which was given by Muscat authority as areason for the fall down of one of thier Strike-Master bomber, while The British Defence Minestry confered that the British pilot killed in the Shat servalue was due to the ground fire of PFLOAG fighters
