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ORGANIZATION AND CONDUCT OF BAHRAIN'S
POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS OF 1971

I. BACKGROUND

The Fifth Population and Housing Census of Bahrain was carried out between 3 and 24 April 1971. The purpose of the census was to obtain information on houses, households and persons constituting the households. The decision to conduct the census was taken for the following reasons:-

- (a) Application of a civil registration system in June 1970.
- (b) Adoption of an effective system to control manpower; and
- (c) Measuring the changes in the demographic and economic characteristics of the population.

The responsibility of organizing and conducting the census was delegated to the Statistical Bureau of the Ministry of Finance and National Economy.

II. PREPARATORY WORK (21 NOVEMBER 1970 - 2 APRIL 1971)

A. Census Calendar (21-26 November 1970)

The first preparatory step for the census was to prepare a calendar, or time table, indicating the sequence and estimated duration of each of the component operations of the census. The calendar was being revised every 15 days.

B. Administrative organization (1-4 December 1970)

The Statistical Bureau was expanded to meet the requirements of the census. The superintendent of the Bureau was considered the responsible official for the whole scheme. He appointed three assistants: one to look after the records, another for enumerating and field affairs and the third for editing and coding.

C. Mapping work (8-14 December 1970)

Bahrain was divided into 8 major municipal areas. Each major area was subdivided into smaller sections on the basis of the size and the number of houses.

D. Living quarters and households listing (15 December 1970 - 15 January, 1971)

Every municipality was asked to number all living quarters in every sector serially and to prepare lists of those living quarters. Such lists were useful for controlling the enumeration as well as for estimating the number of enumerators and the number of schedules and the other census material and for estimating the time required for enumeration.

E. Selection of topics (3-15 December 1970)

The Statistical Bureau arranged meetings with representatives from all the Government Departments to discuss the topics which should be included in the census schedule. The final meeting was held on 15 December and 22 topics were approved.

F. Tabulation programme (19-29 December 1970)

As soon as the census topics were approved, the Statistical Bureau started preparing the tabulation programme. The programme was presented to the data processing experts. On 29 December the programme was approved and forwarded to the programmers.

G. Questionnaire preparation and printing (18 December 1970-28 February, 1971)

As soon as the topics were selected, the Bureau started preparing the census schedule. After being revised by the data processing experts and approved by them the design was forwarded to the printer.

The census schedules were printed with a code number for each locality and a household serial number. The numbered schedules were bound in books of 50 sheets. Books were also made up of 25 blank schedules without code or serial number. These blank schedules were used for houses containing more than one household when the main household was registered on a numbered sheet and extra household or households were registered on blank sheet upon which were written the house serial number with the addition of a different number for each separate household.

H. Plans for data processing (3 January - 2 April 1971)

The plans for the processing of the data had been completed before the enumeration began so that processing could start immediately upon receipt of the completed schedules. The data were processed in Bahrain by a 360 IBM computer.

I. Preparation of the books of instructions to enumerators and editors (5 January - 5 February 1971)

During this period the Statistical Bureau completed and duplicated the booklets of instructions to enumerators and editors (22 pages). It contained the basic and necessary information for collecting the data according to specific definitions and instructions.

J. Staff recruitment (7 - 27 January 1971)

The necessary arrangements had been taken early to secure the proper number and type of personnel required for each of the various census operations. Every secretary of each municipality was made responsible for enumeration of his area. Twenty four supervisors were appointed and each one was responsible for enumeration in each sector. Each supervisor was assisted by sufficient enumerators to perform the census in the sector for which he was appointed. The number of enumerators ranged from five to nine in each sector. In addition to that 25 editors and coders were appointed. The staff were selected on the basis of past experience and locality.

K. Publicity (1 February - 24 April 1971)

The Information Department arranged the publicity for the census to secure the interest and co-operation of the public. Publicity started two months before the enumeration and gradually intensified until the enumeration was completed. All available mass media such as radio, posters, post stamps were utilized. A competition with prizes was announced for the most accurate forecast of the total number of persons in Bahrain to be revealed by the census.

L. Staff training and census tests (4 February - 30 March 1971)

Training sessions were held two months before the census day. First the supervisors received training and subsequently each supervisor was asked to train his enumerators accordingly. Later, the superintendent of the Statistical Bureau trained the editors and coders, himself. All training was conducted under the supervision of the Bureau in order to ensure that enumerators were fully conversant with their work. The results of the trial census conducted one month before census day, were analyzed to detect any weakness. Finally, a general meeting of supervisors and enumerators was held four days before the census day to discuss the results of the trial census.

III. ENUMERATION (3-24 APRIL 1971)

A. Method of Enumeration

The enumerator method was used in collecting the information from households, that is: the information for each individual is collected and entered on the schedule by an enumerator designated to perform this operation in a specific area. The persons who were recorded in a census schedule were those who were normally resident in a household (*de jure*).

B. Enumeration stage (3-24 April 1971)

Enumeration in the urban areas where there is adequate lighting was carried out between the hours 7:00-9:30 p.m. six days each week. Villages were visited between 4:30 p.m. and sunset which gave enumerators approximately three hours each day for enumeration. Each supervisor was instructed to see his group of enumerators at least twice during each working period. At the end of a day's work the enumerators handed in completed schedules to their supervisor who was responsible for recording the number of schedules and making a preliminary check on them. Having done this, supervisors delivered the schedules to the Central Office.

IV. DATA PROCESSING (16 APRIL - 5 AUGUST 1971)

A. Editing and coding (6 April - 5 May 1971)

The Central Office included a team of 24 editors and coders who worked every afternoon for three hours. The editors checked each census schedule to see that it was completed and that the facts recorded were consistent with the schedule as a whole. The coders were responsible for inserting the code for those questions which had not been pre-coded. When the schedule lacked data or wrong information had been recorded it was returned the following day to the enumerator for completion or correction.

B. Data processing (8 April - 15 August 1971)

After editing, schedules were ready for processing by the Bahrain Petroleum Company. Processing, in fact, began five days after the census had commenced. A further check on the accuracy of the census schedules took place at the Bahrain Petroleum Company and, when schedules were rejected, they were returned to the Central Office, or the schedules were returned to the enumerators for completion or correction.

As the processing of schedules was completed they were returned daily to the Central Office. Records were kept of all the sheets returned to ensure that every sheet completed by the enumerators had been processed. After checking, schedules were classified to areas and then stored.

- (3) Not economically active comprise the following functional categories:

 - (b) Students: persons who attend any regular educational institution for systematic instruction at any level of education.
 - (c) Income recipients: persons who receive income from property or other investment, royalties or pensions from former activities.
 - (d) Others: persons of either sex, not economically active, who are receiving public aid or private supports, and all other persons not falling into any of the above categories, such as children not attending school.
